The Primary Education Advisors (PEA), Cluster leaders, Co-ordinating Primary Education Advisor (CPEA) or District Education Managers were consulted in the completion of the questionnaires. The completion of these questionnaires was done by August 2004. This academic year EMIS collected 95% of the questionnaires sent to primary and secondary schools.

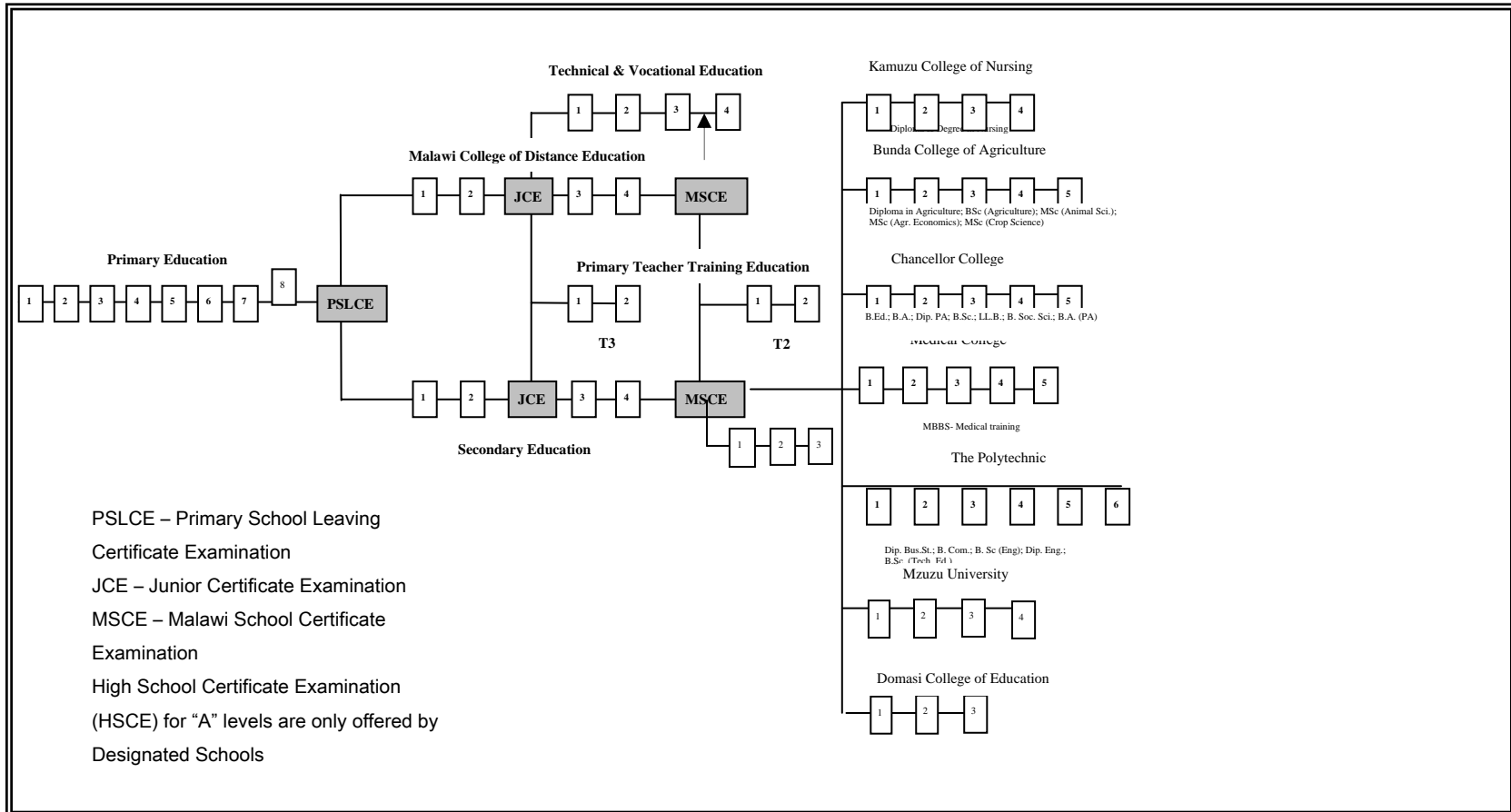
The Ministry assures users of this publication that all means have been pursued to make the information in this issue very highly valid and reliable.

Graph - 2.2c Pupils Teachers and Pupils Classroom Ratio by Districts

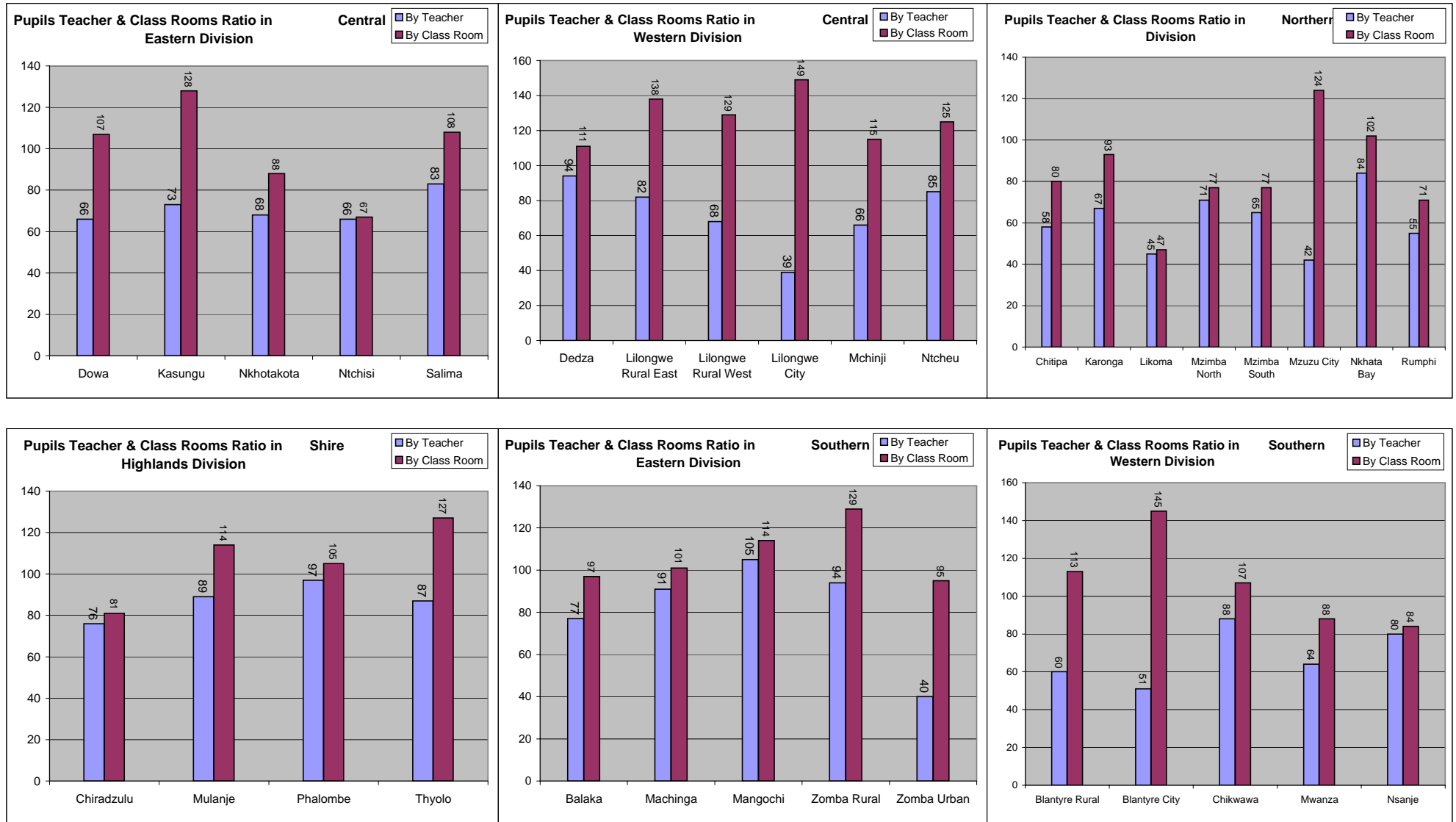

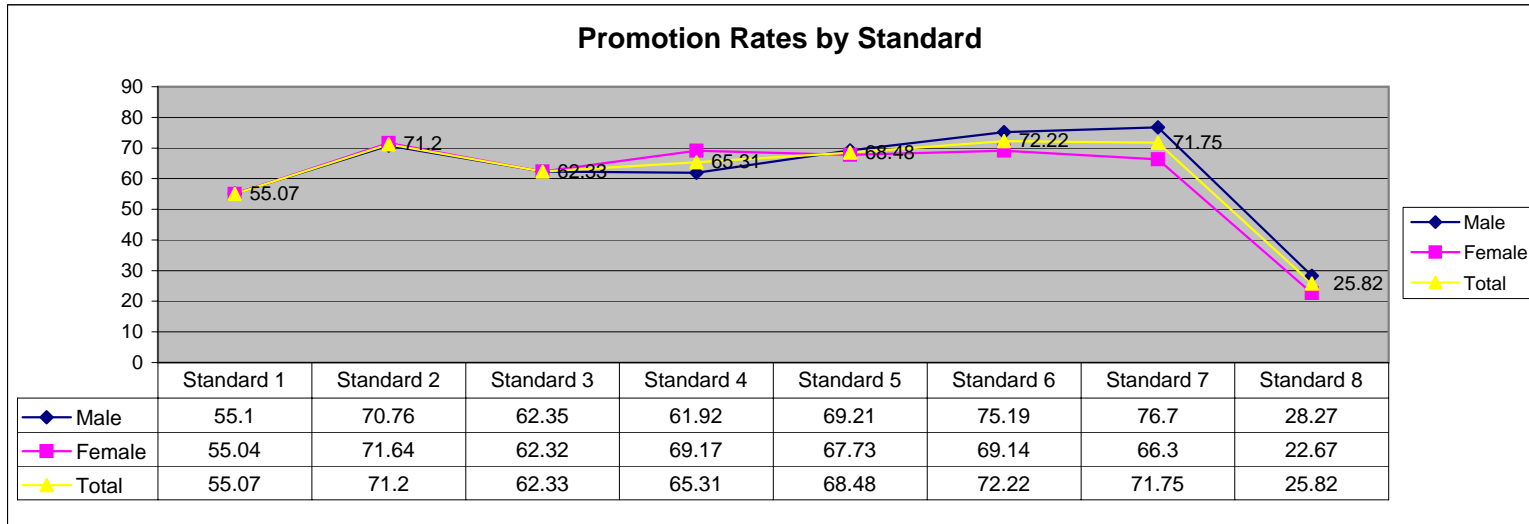

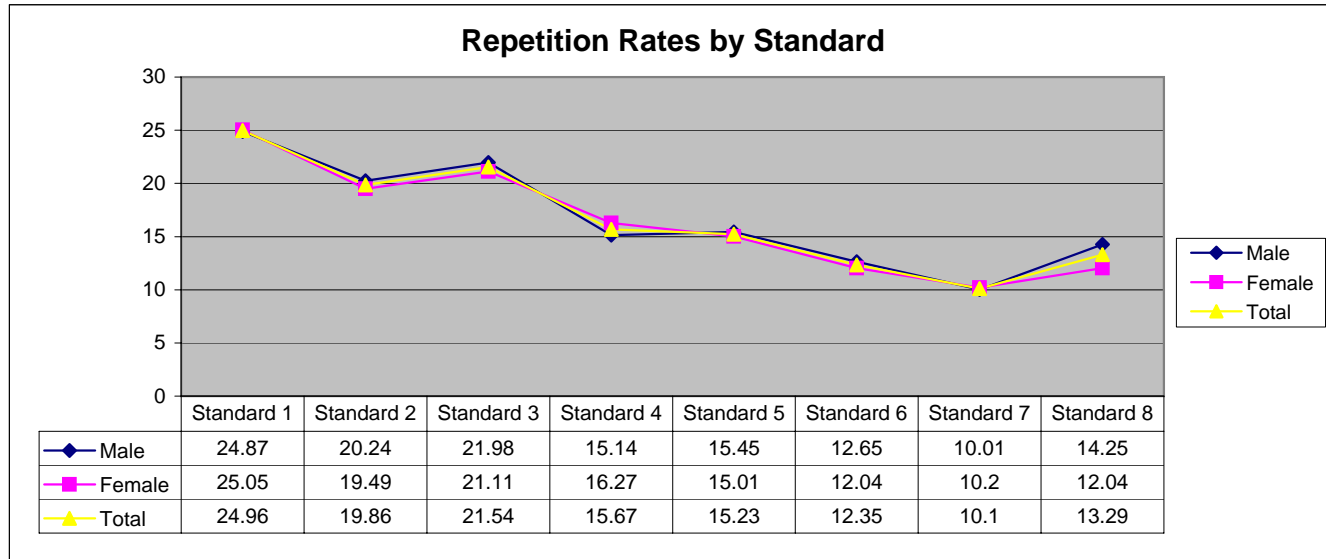

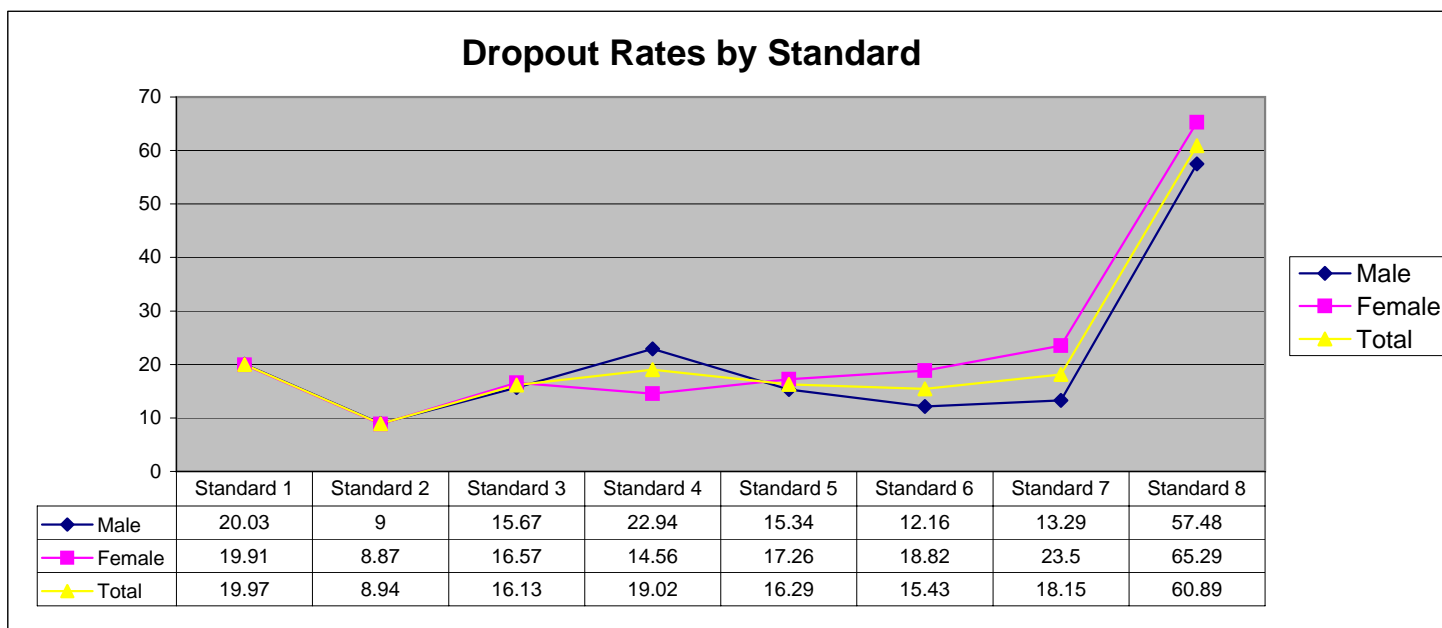

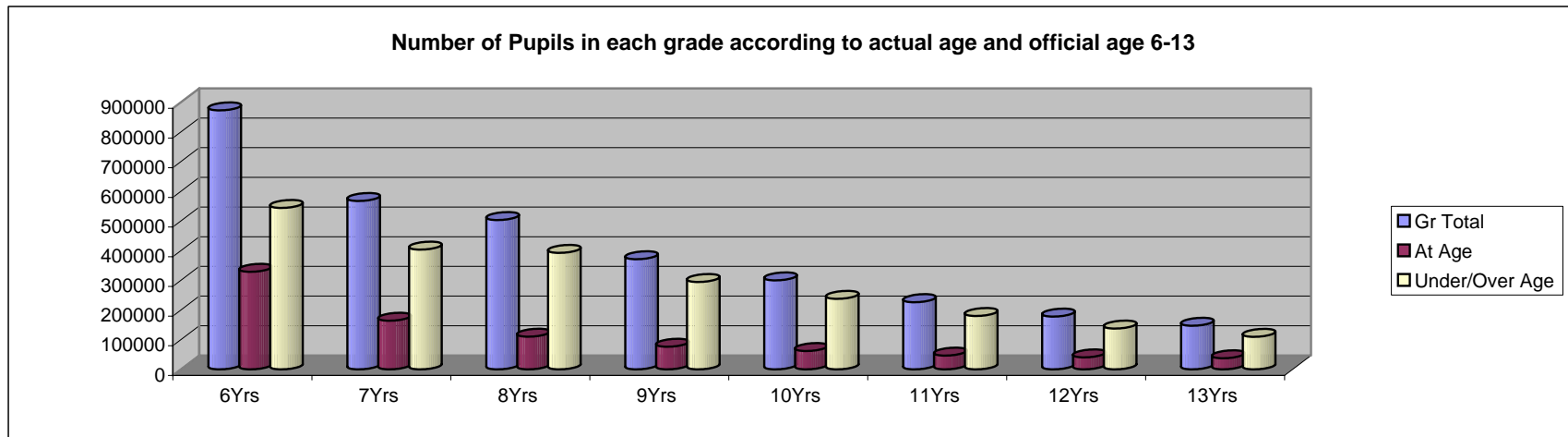

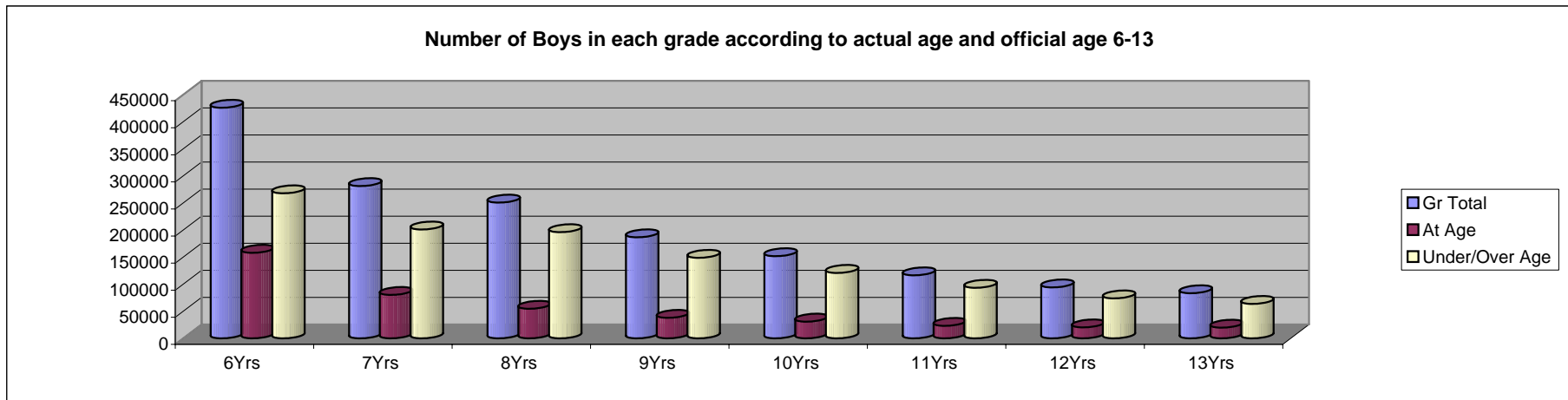

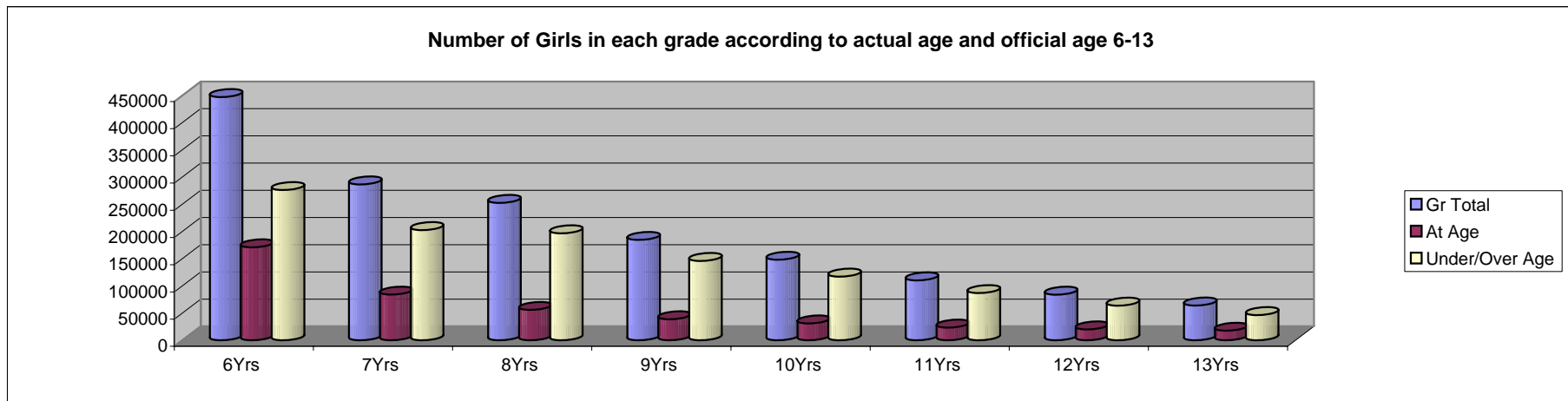

Graph 2.7a New Entrants to Standard 1 by Age and Sex/Division

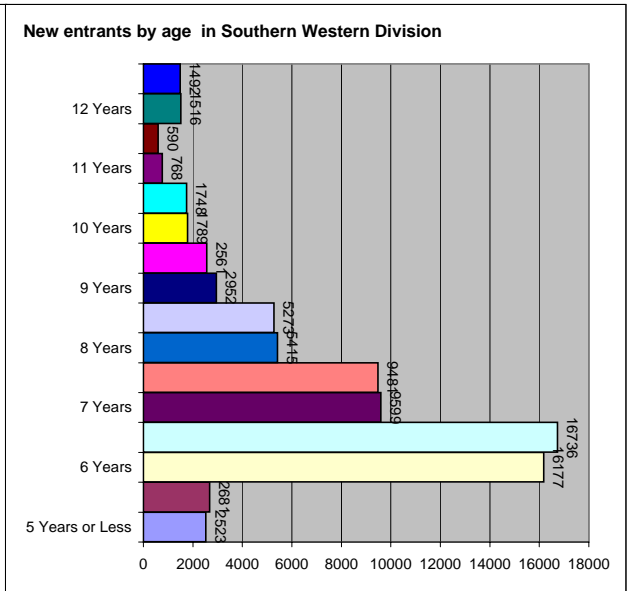
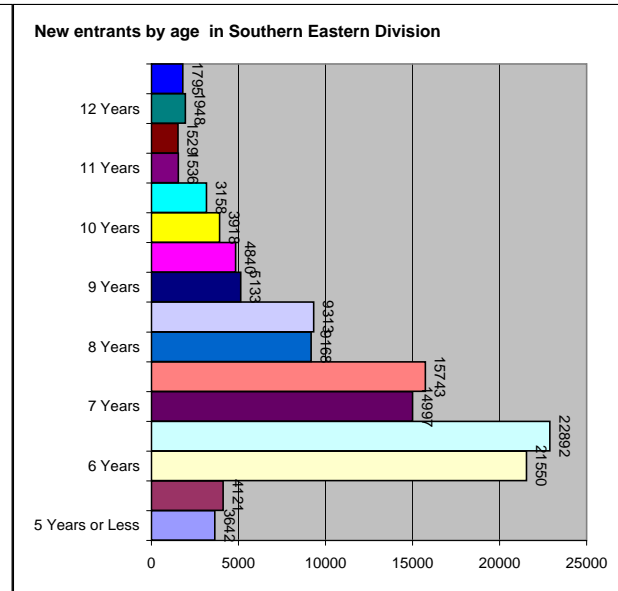
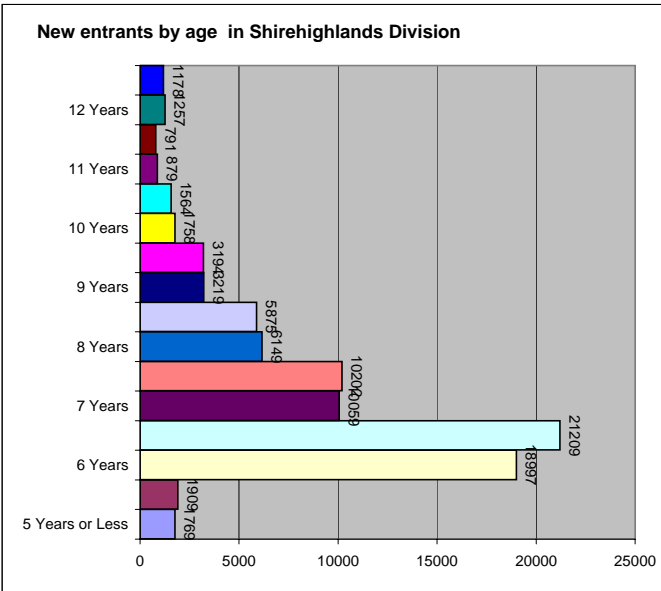
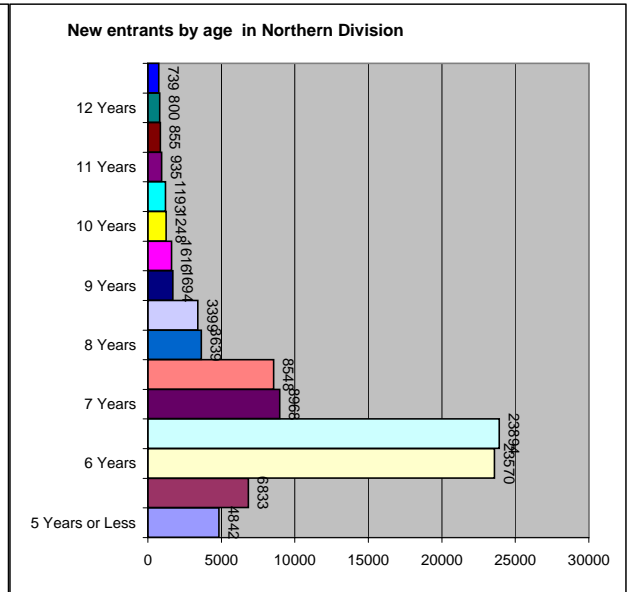
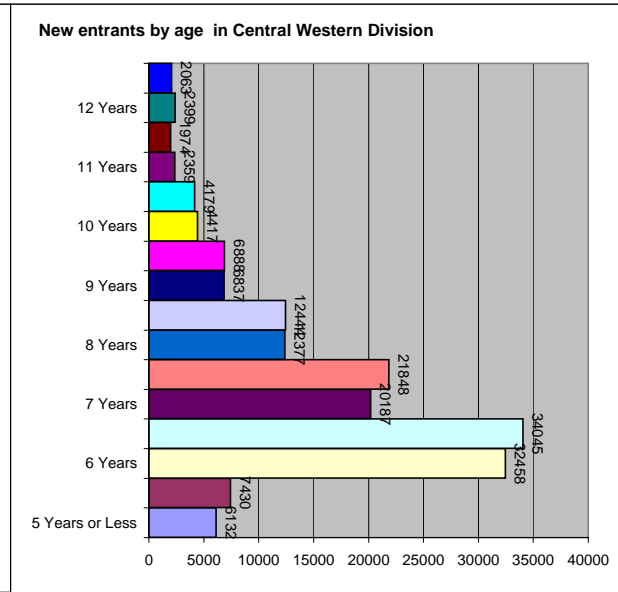
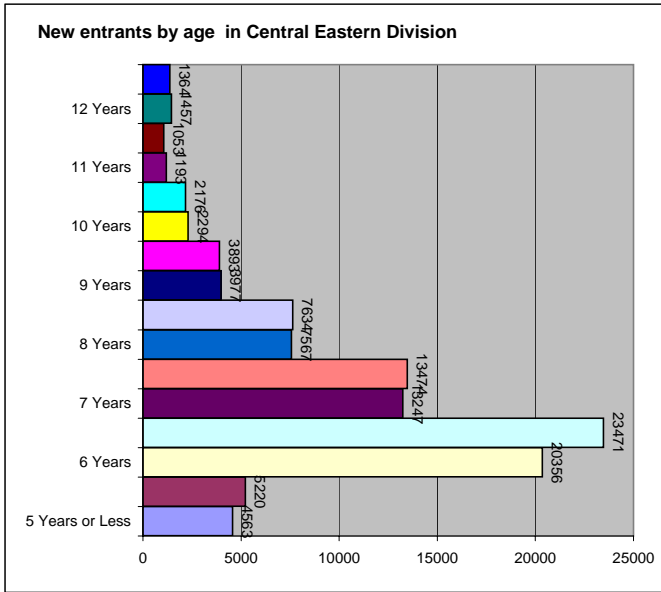

Graph 2.8b Number of Dropouts by Standard and Sex/Division

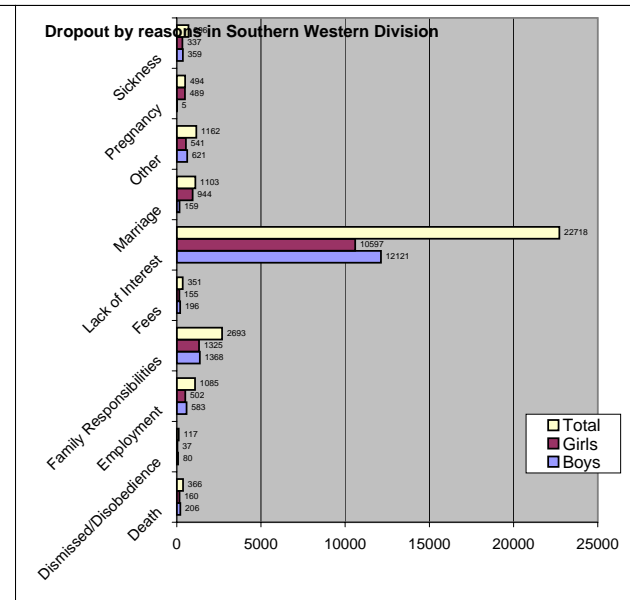
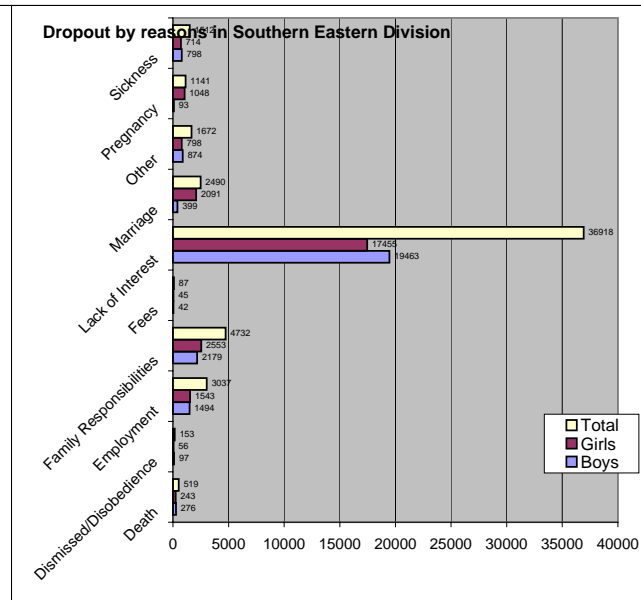
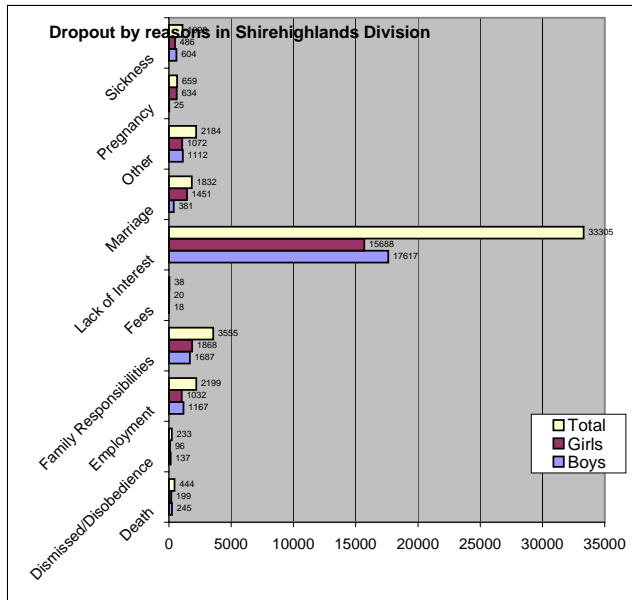
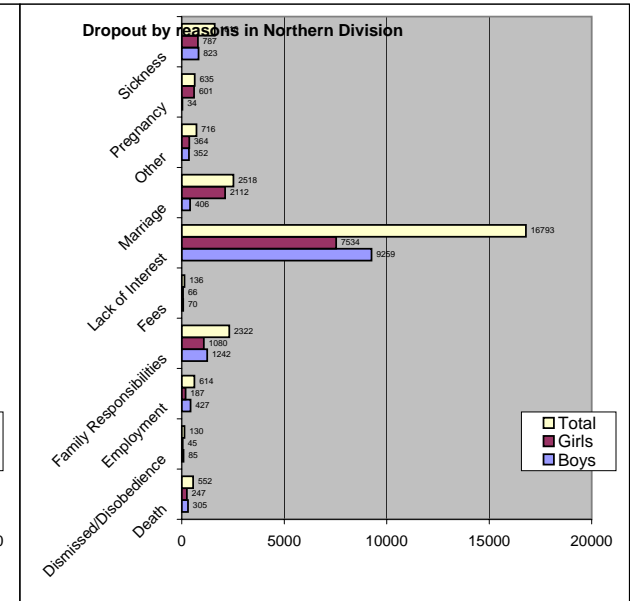
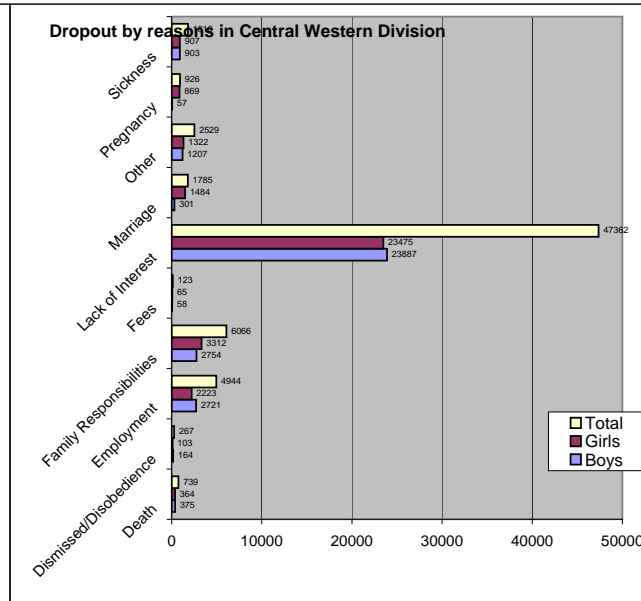
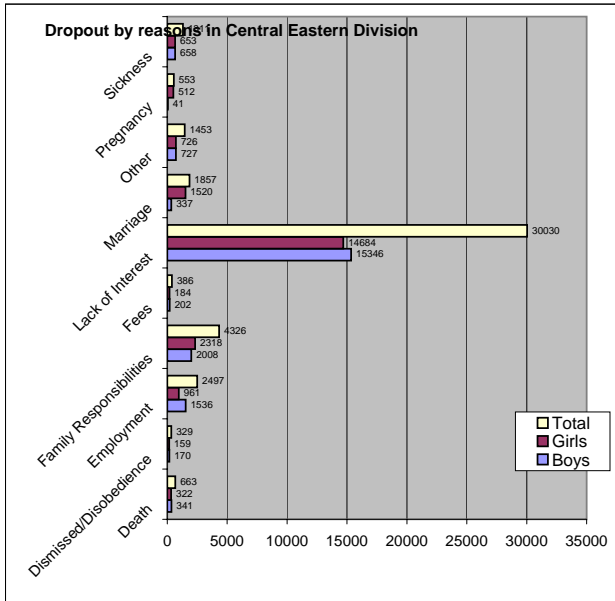

Graph 2.9a Number of Repeaters by Standard and Sex/District

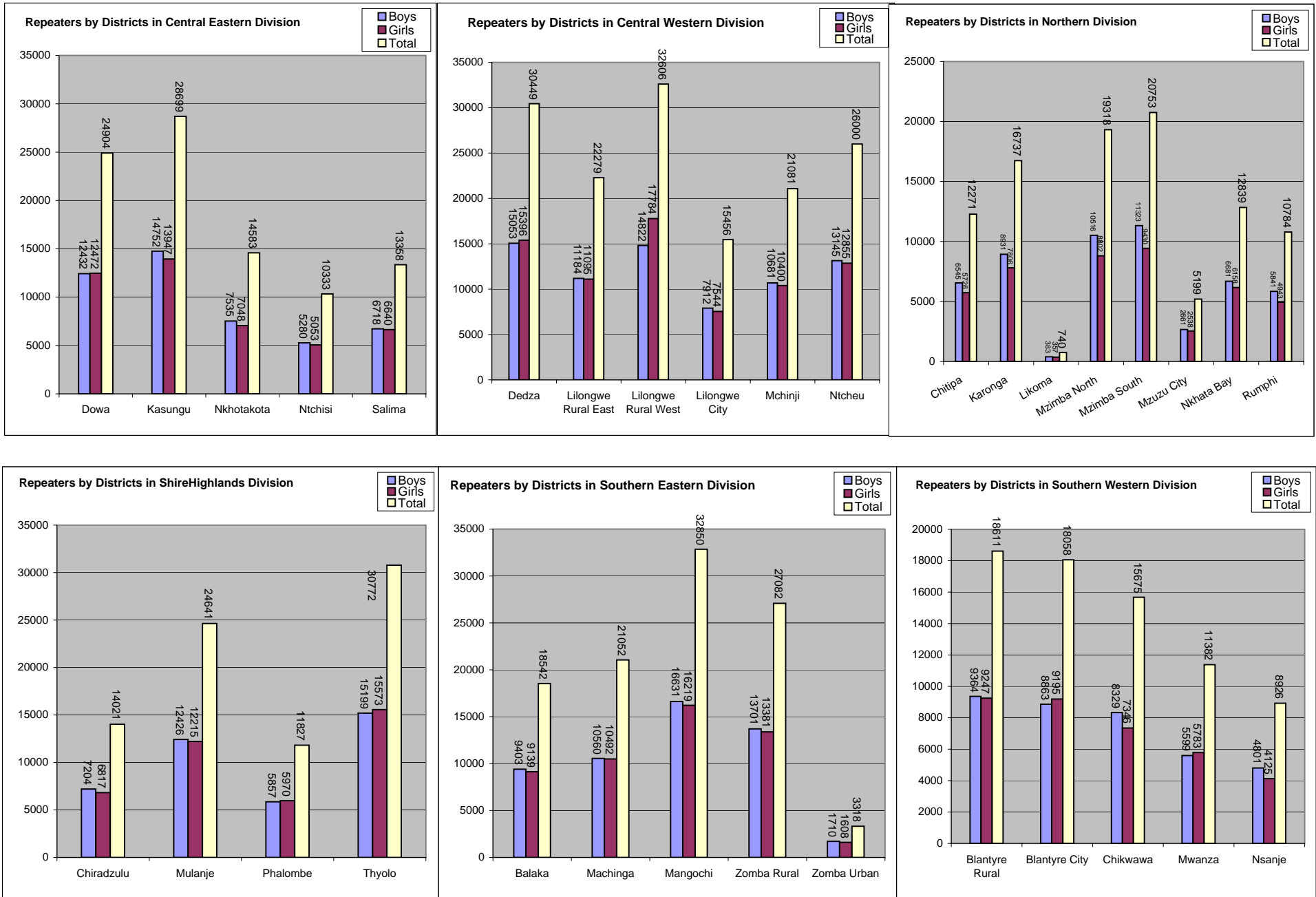

Graph 2.10a Number of Pupils transferred into and out of schools by Division and Sex

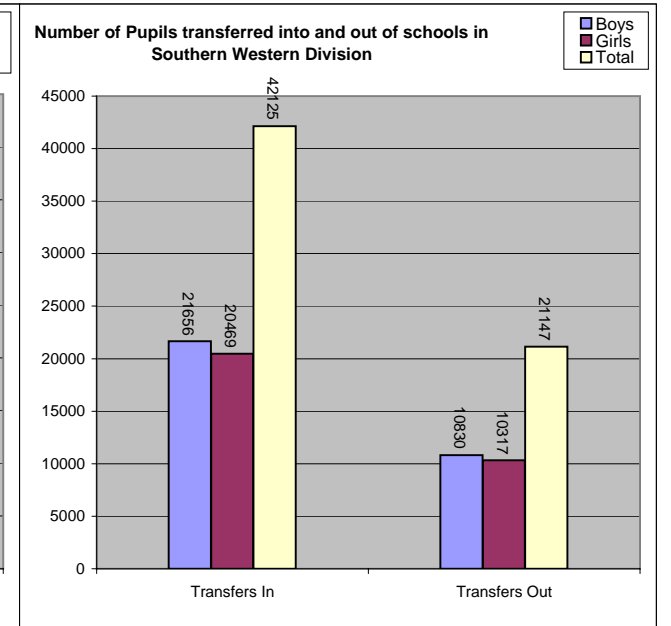
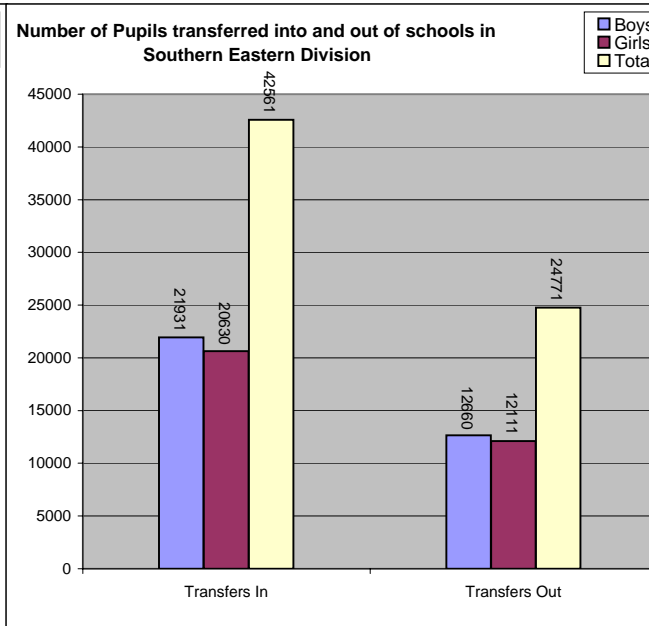
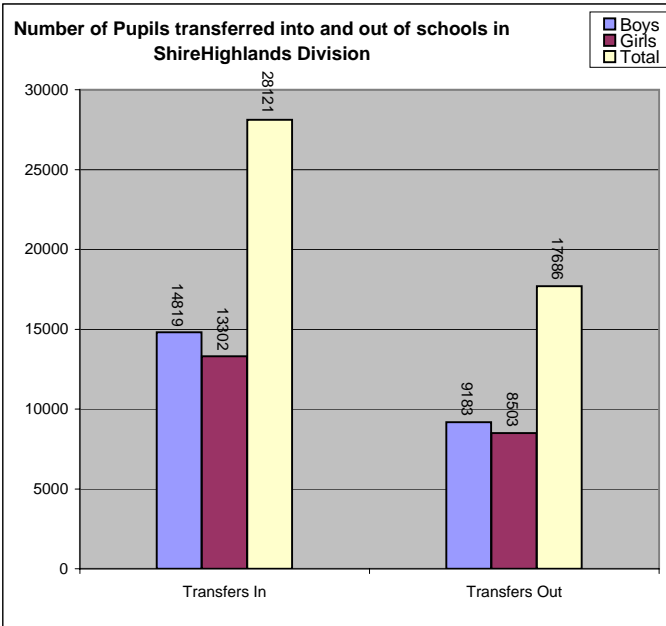
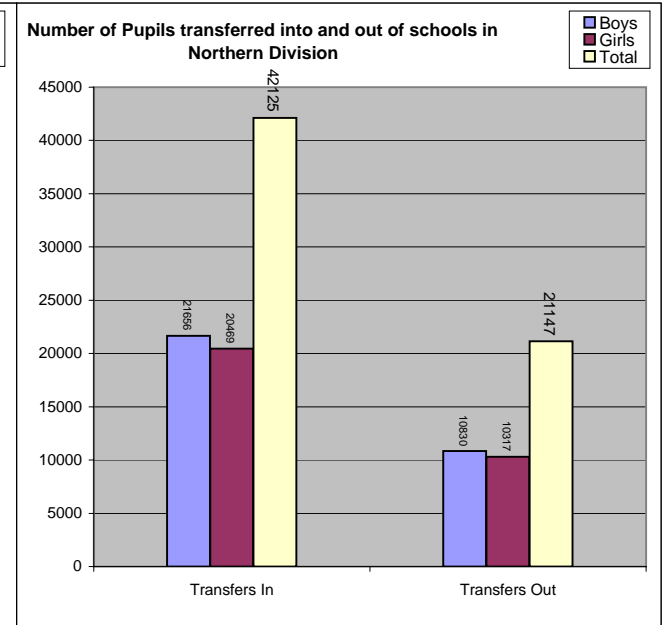
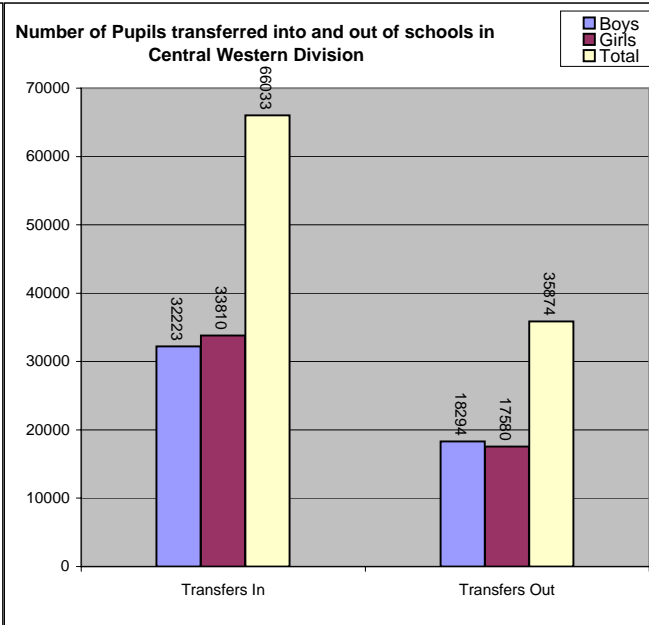
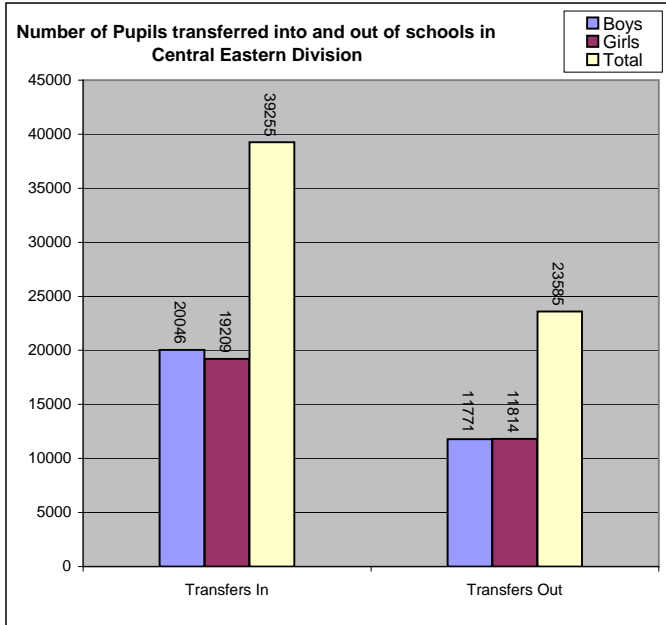

Graph 2.11b Number of Pupils with Special learning needs by Standard and Sex

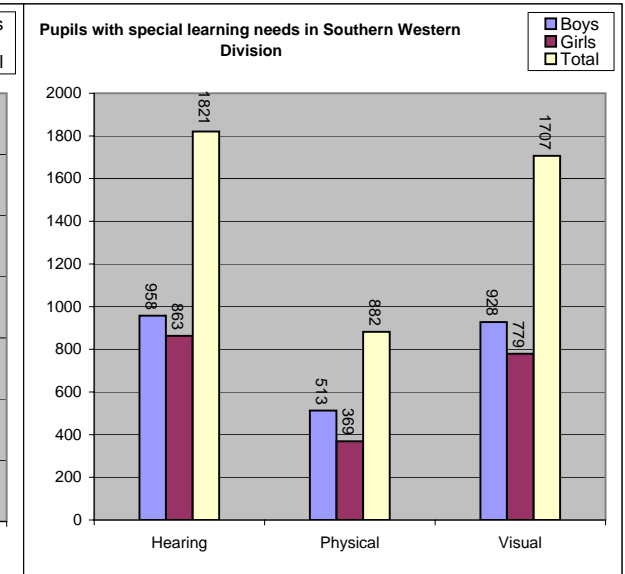
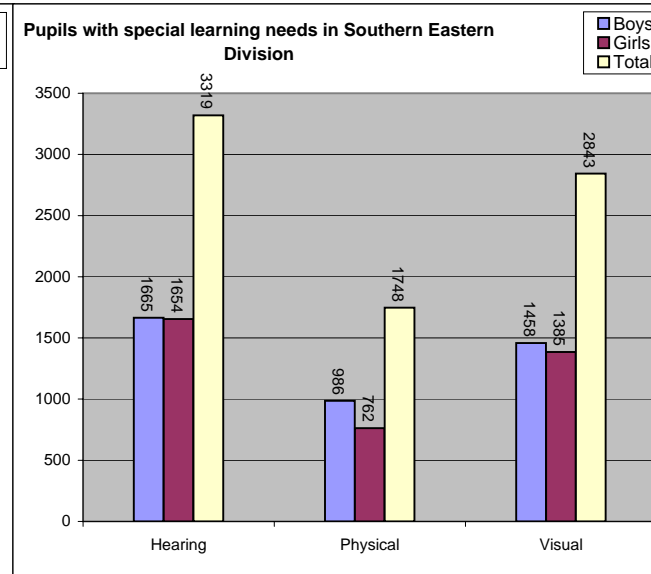
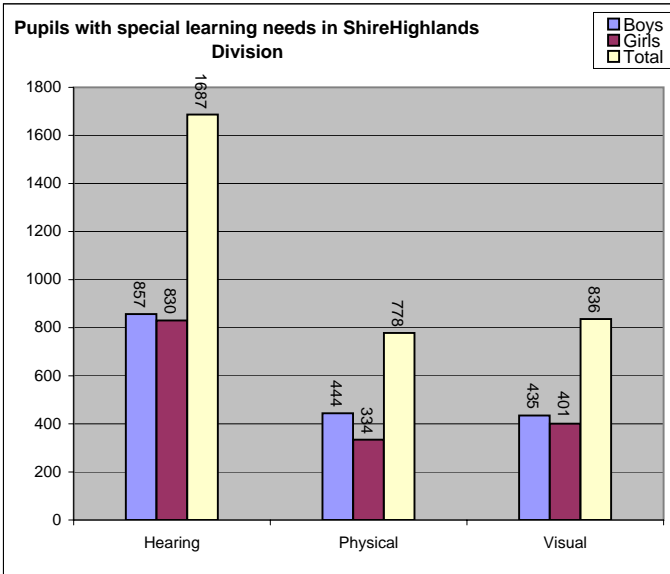
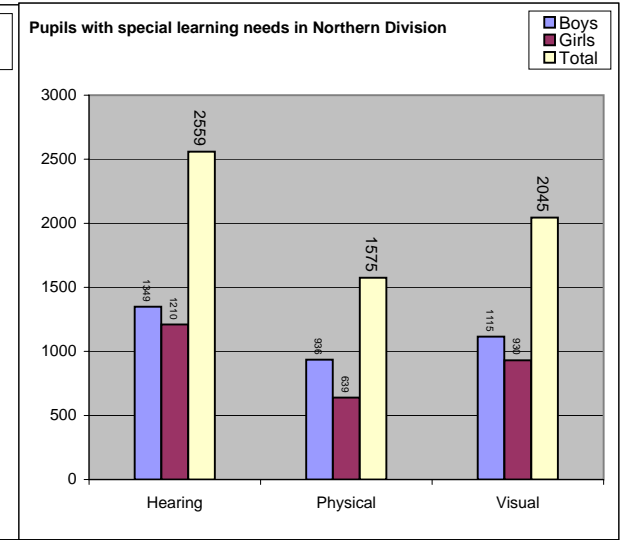
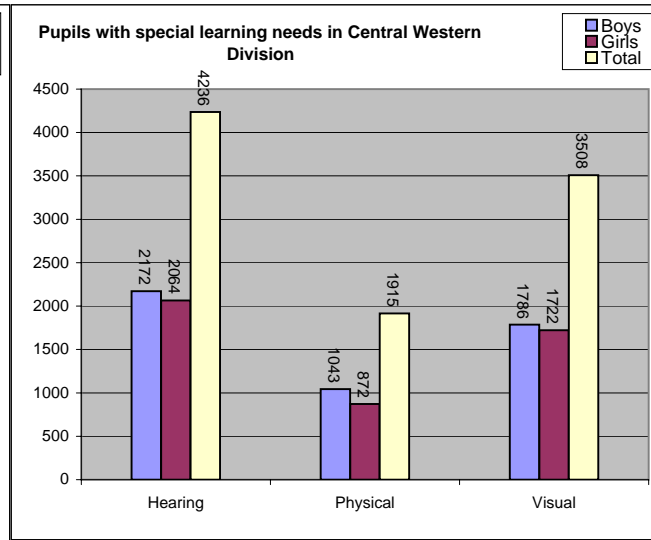
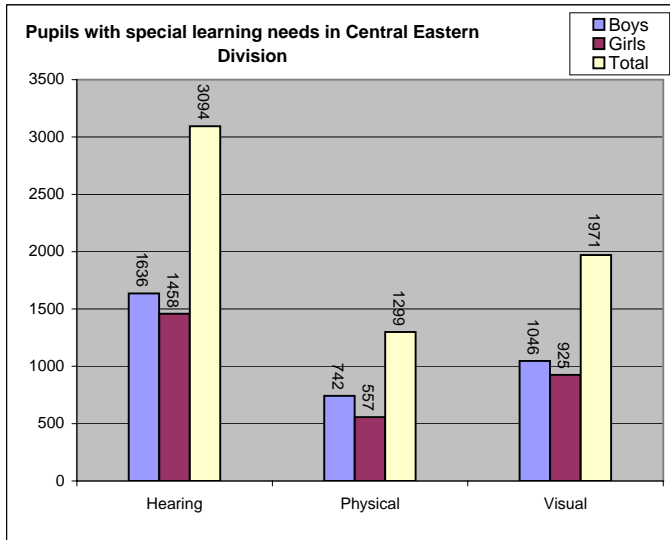

Graph 2.12a Number of Orphans Pupils by Standard and Sex/Districts, 2004

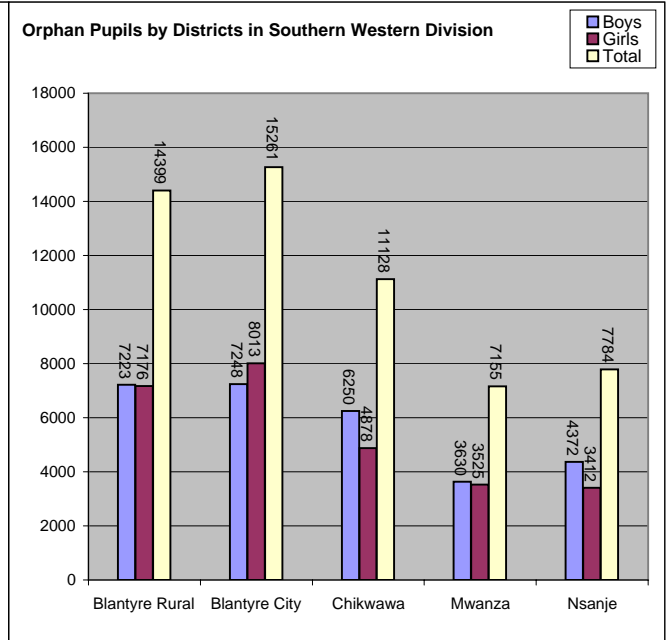
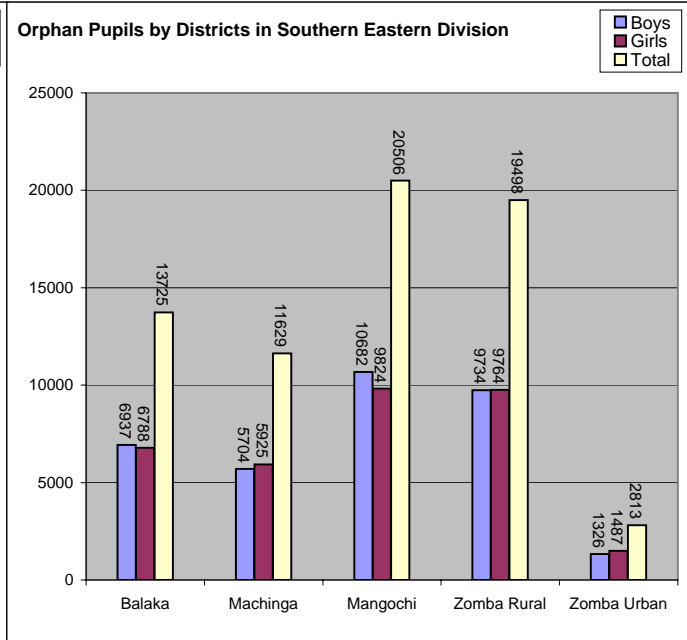
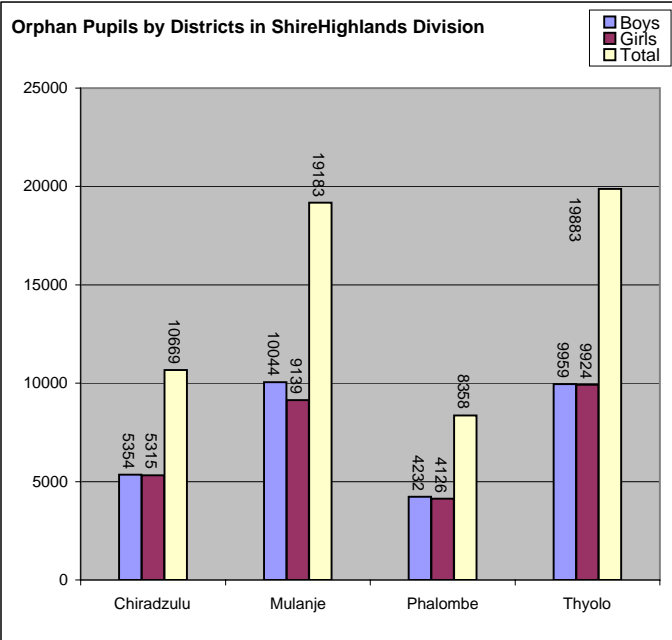
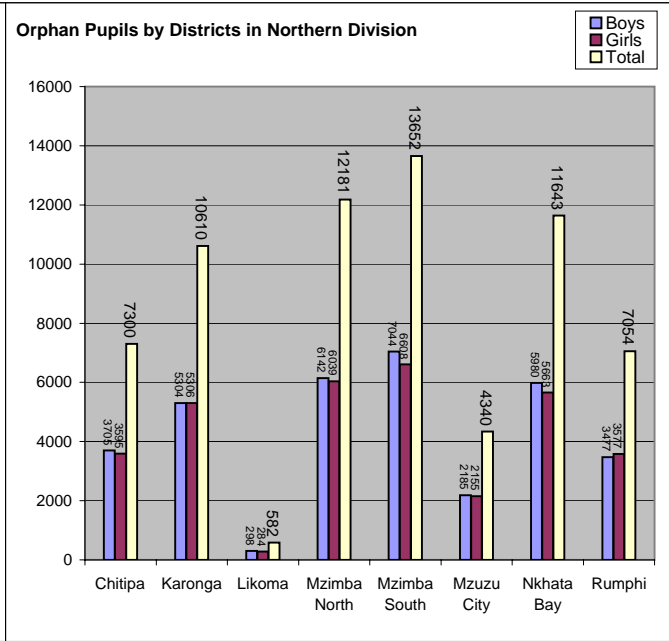
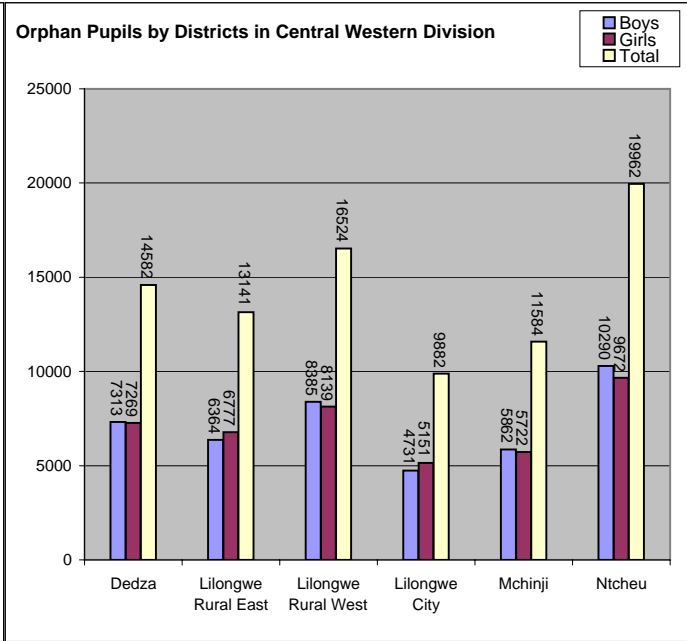
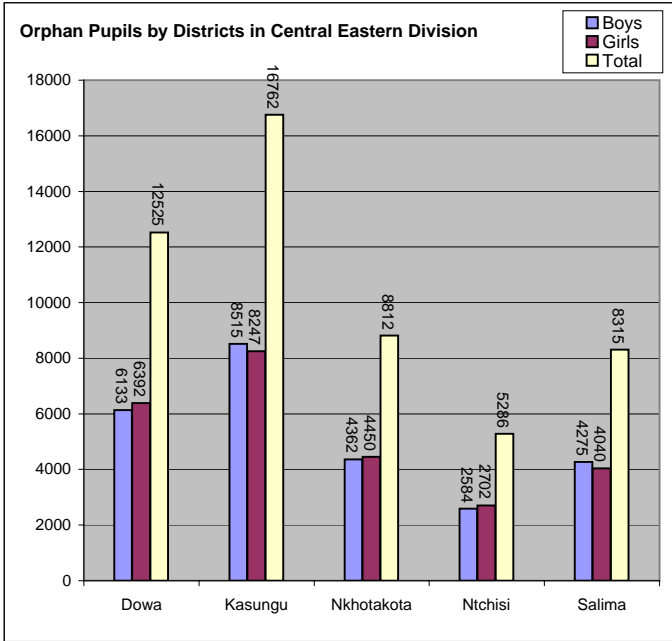

Graph 2.13b Number of Building (Rooms) by condition, and type

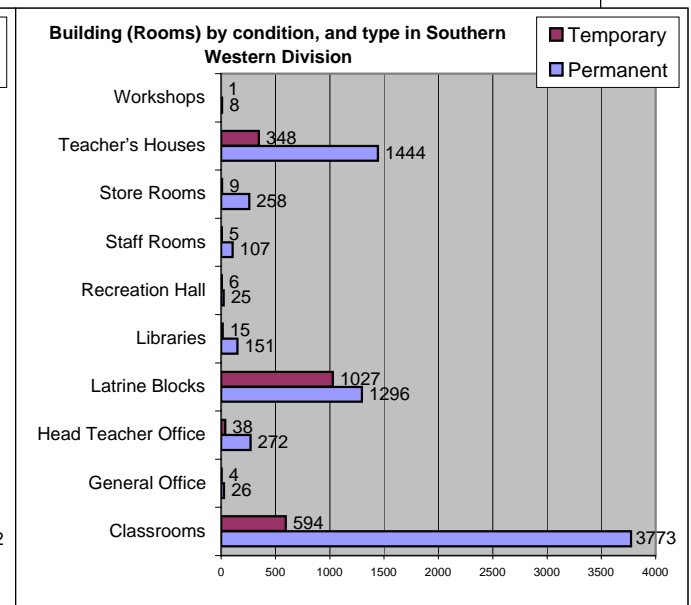
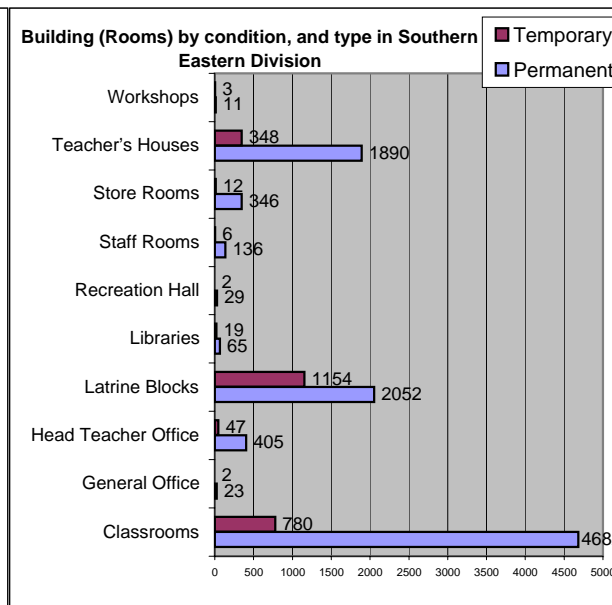
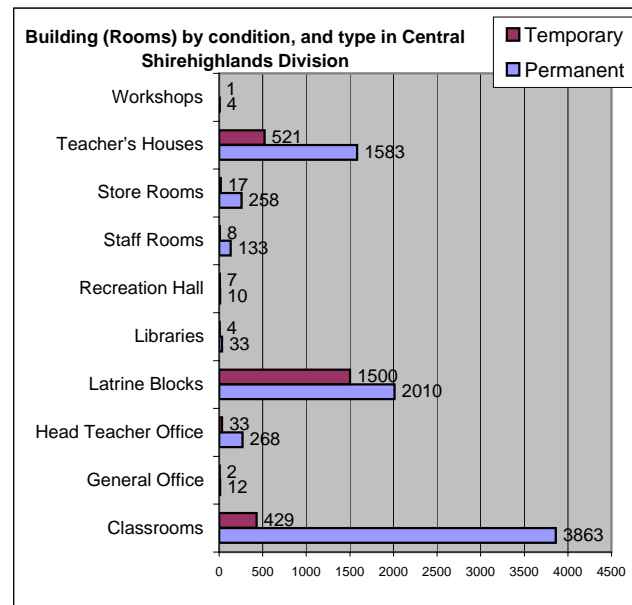
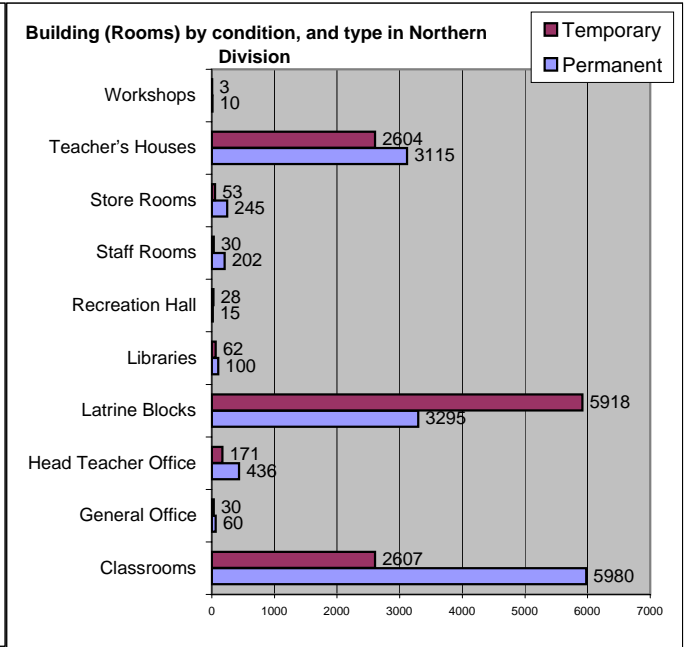
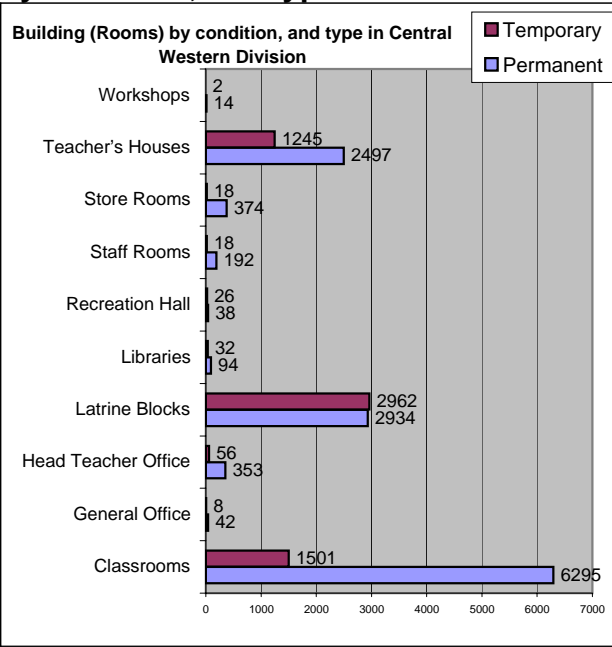
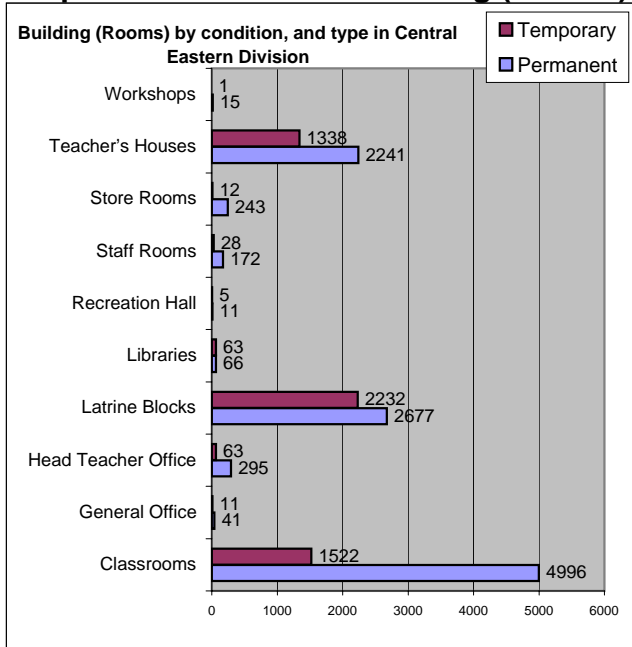

Graph 2.14a Number of Primary Schools, according to main Water Source and Electricity source, 2004

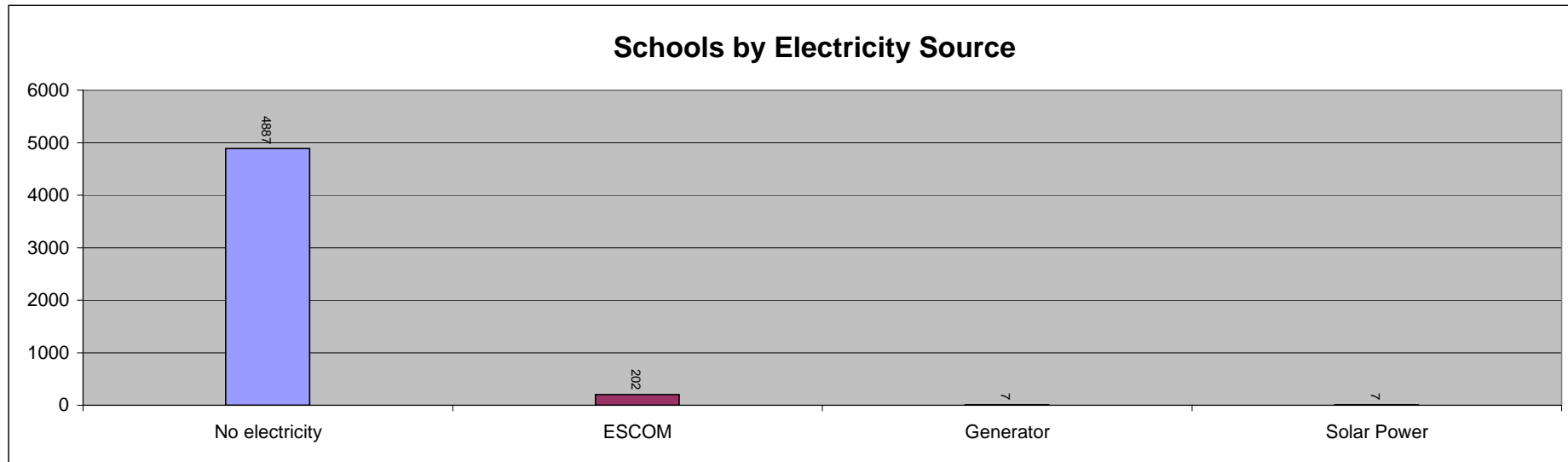
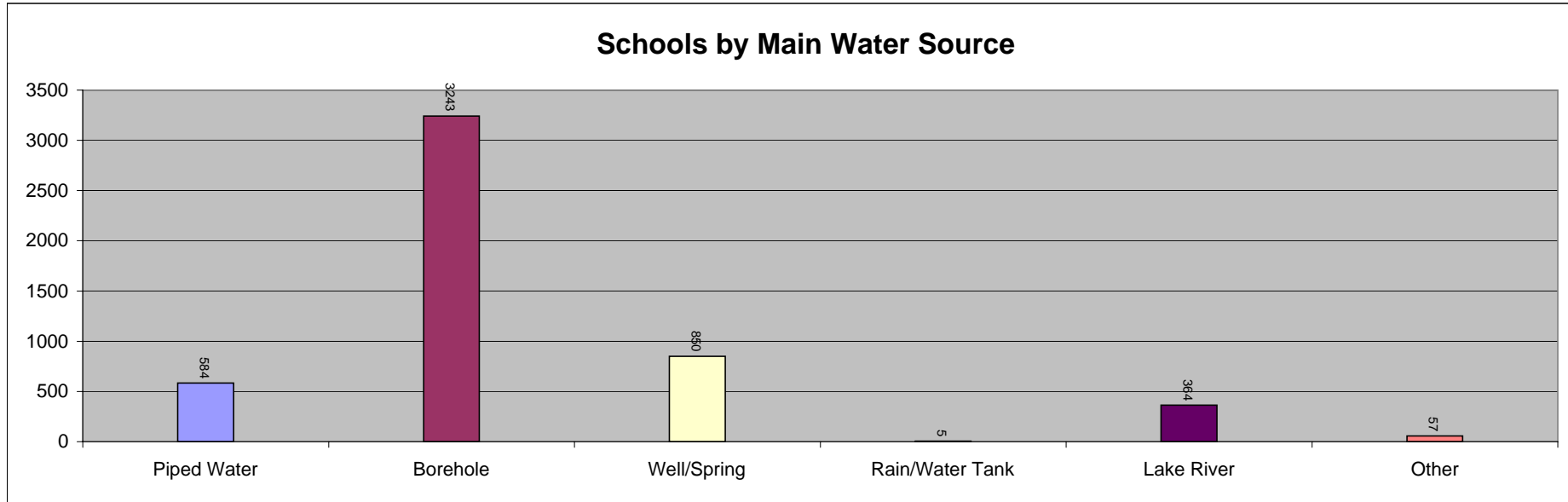

Graph 2.17a Teaching Staff Reason for leaving Schools by Divisions

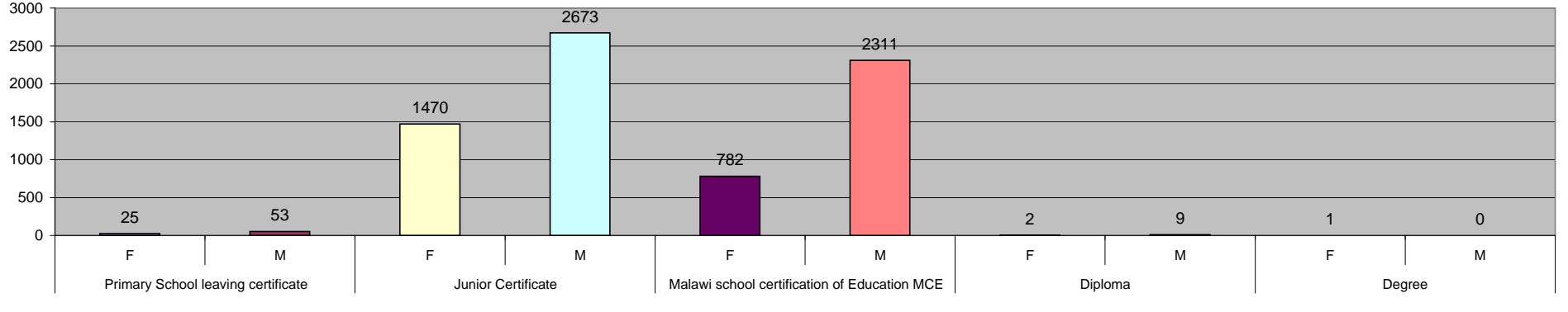


Graph 2.18a Teachers by Highest level of Education, Grade, and Training 2004

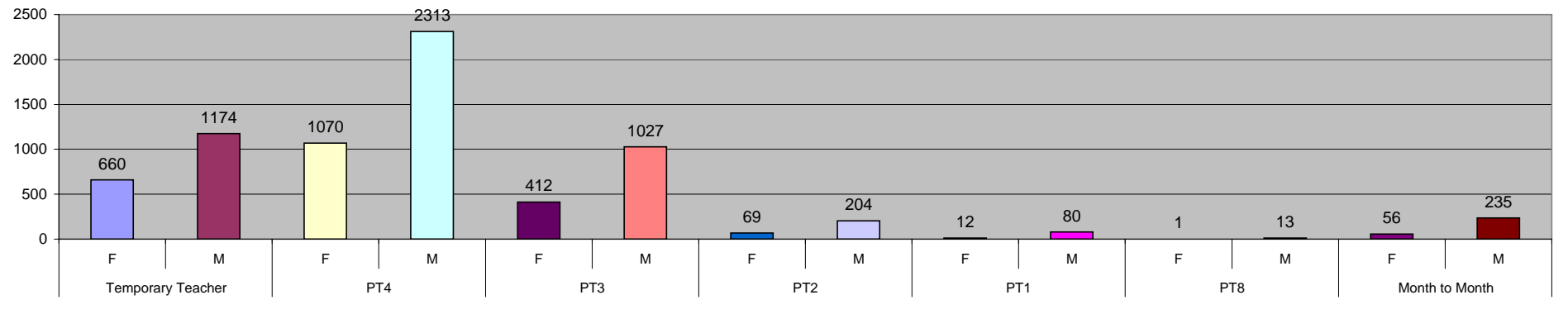


Graph 2.18b Teachers by Highest level of Education, Grade, and Training, in Central Eastern Division 2004

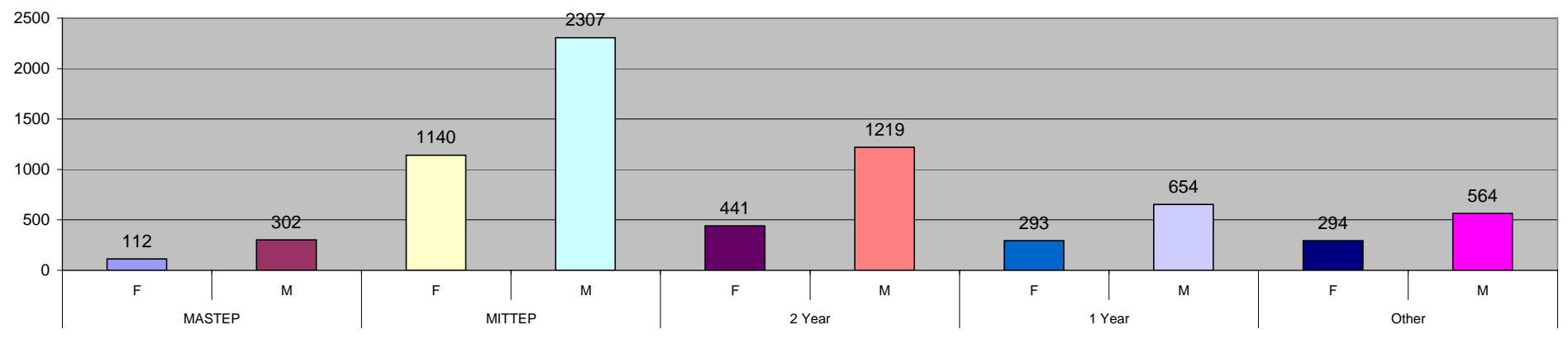

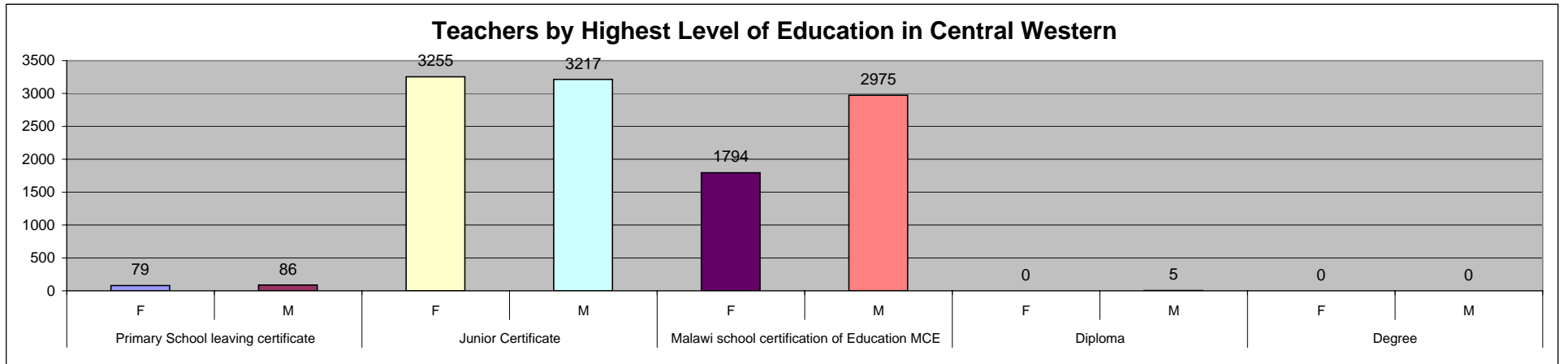

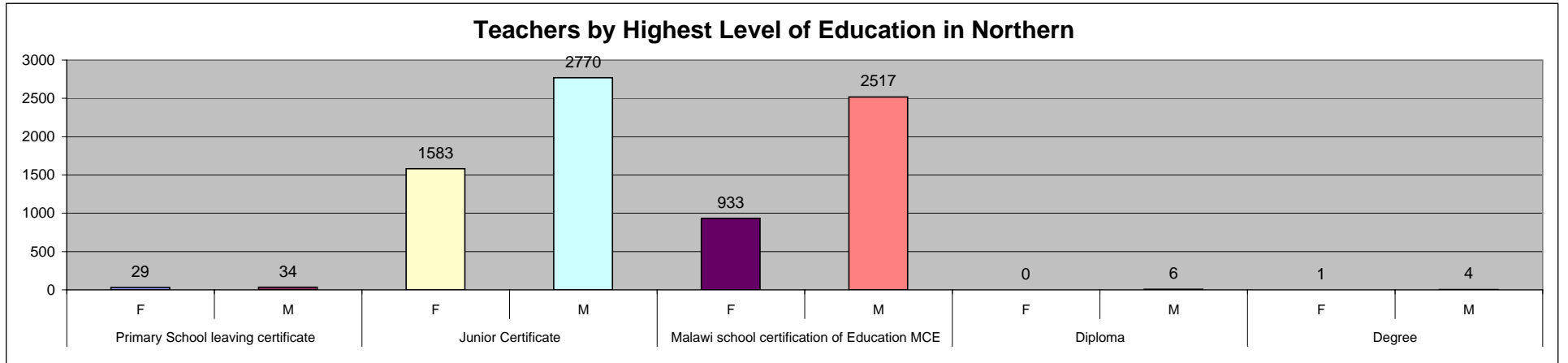

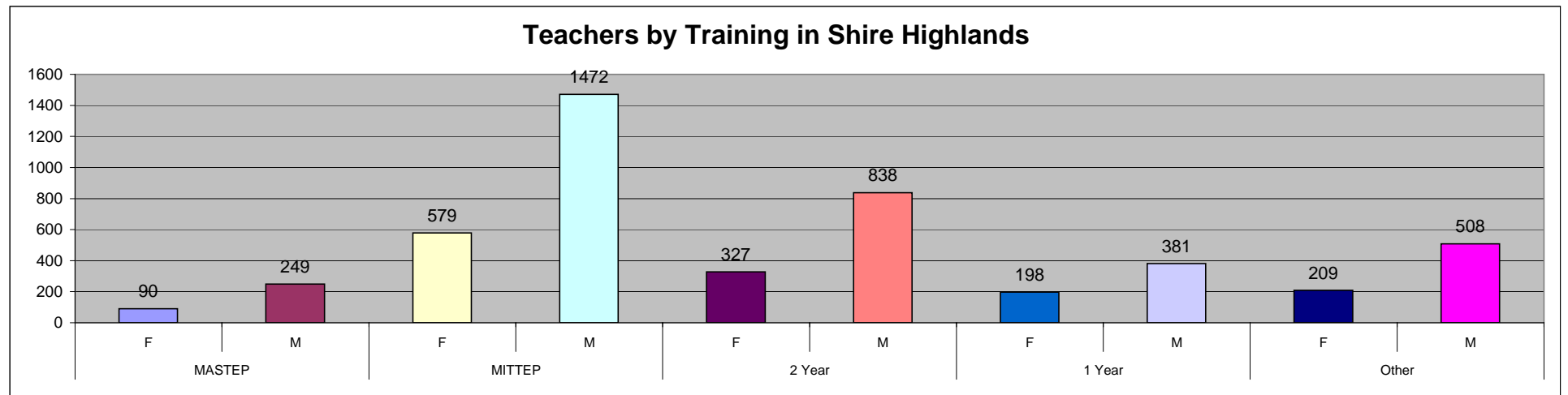
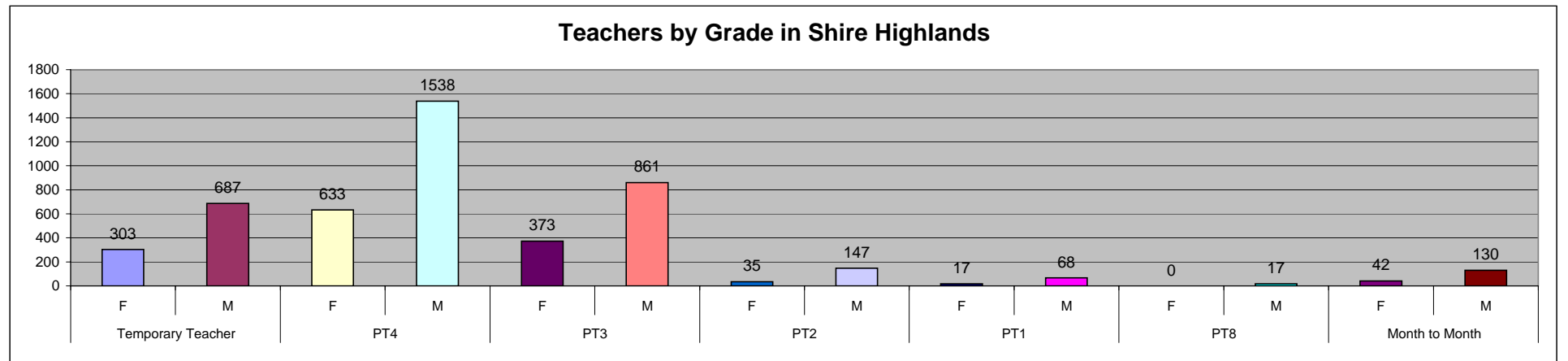
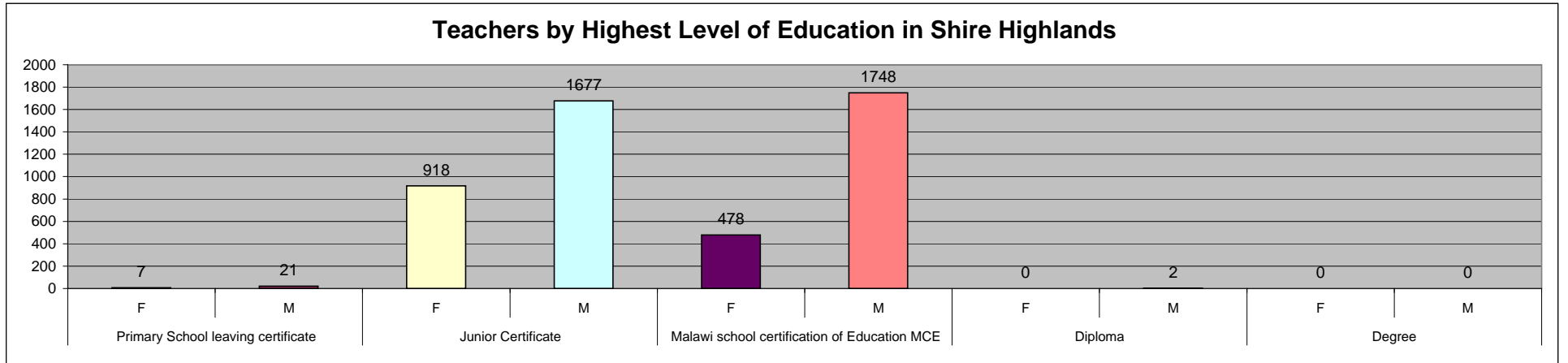
Graph 2.18c Teachers by Highest level of Education, Grade, and Training, in Central Western Division 2004



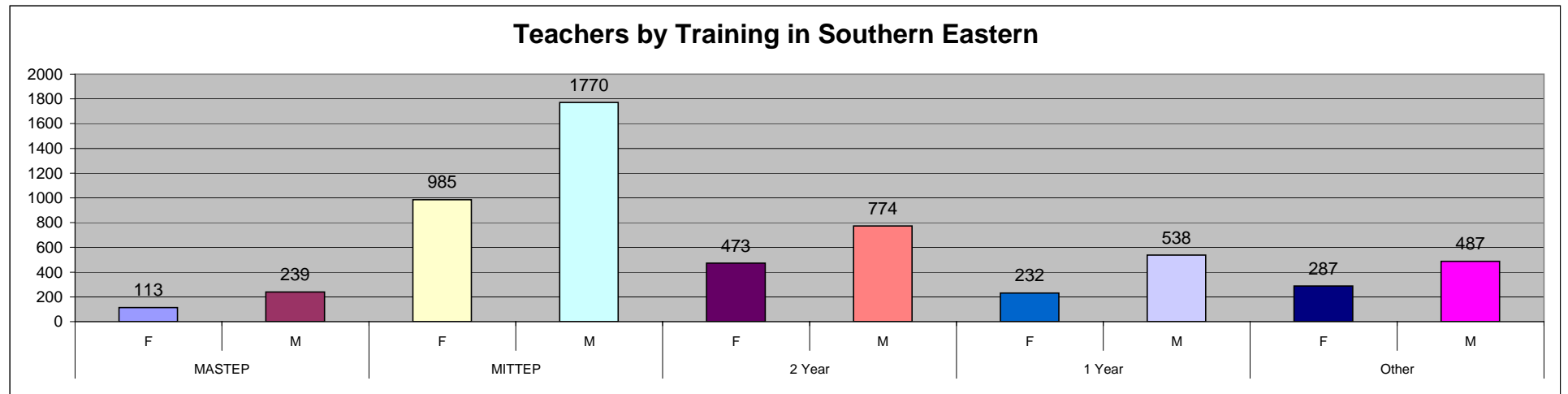
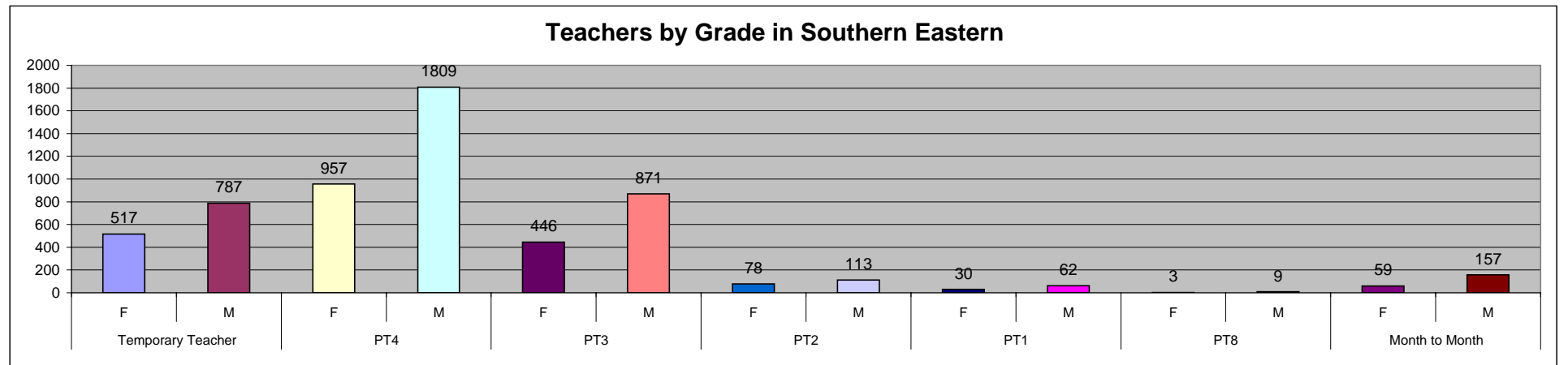
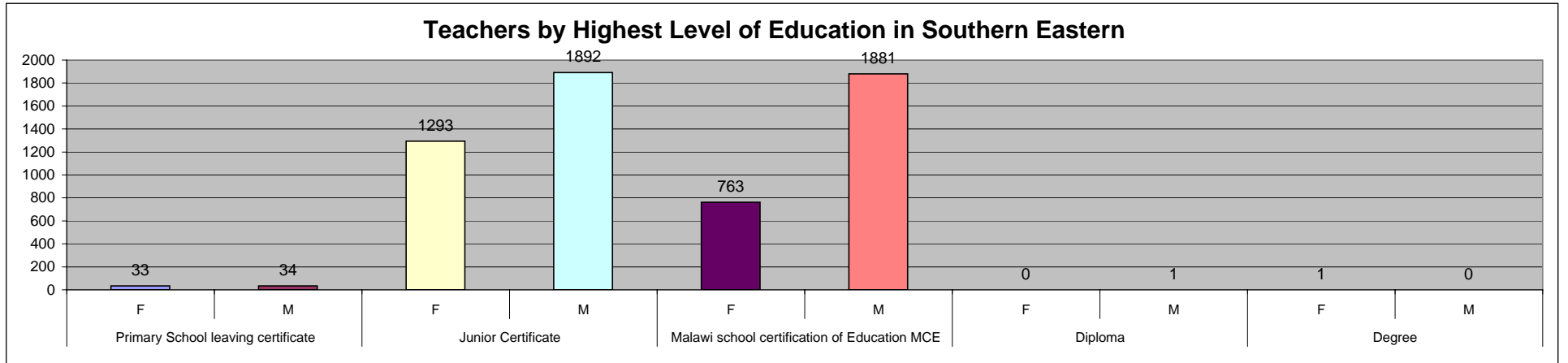
Graph 2.18d Teachers by Highest level of Education, Grade, and Training, in Northern Division 2004



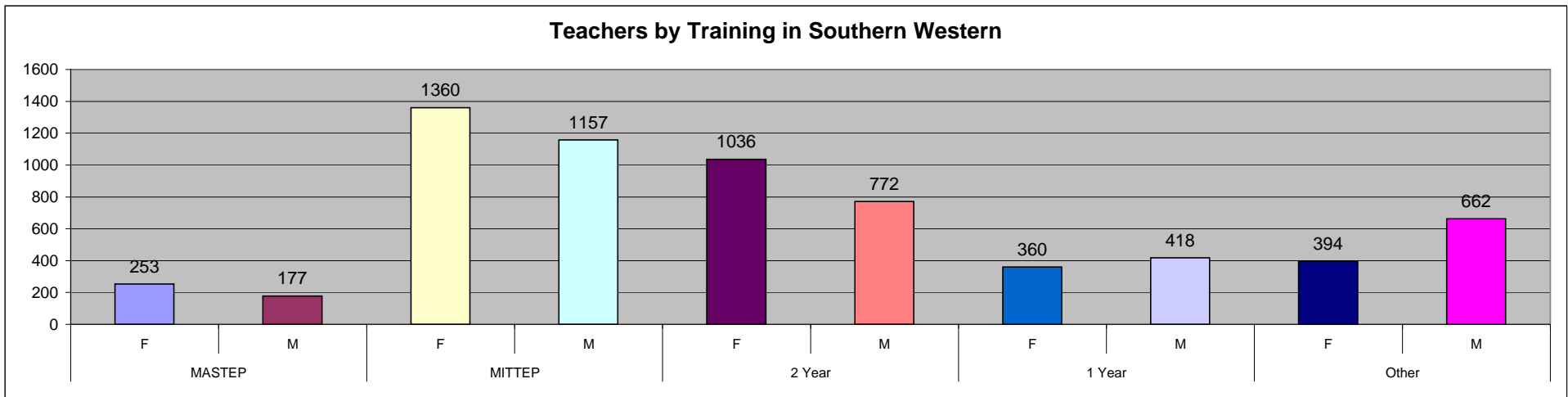
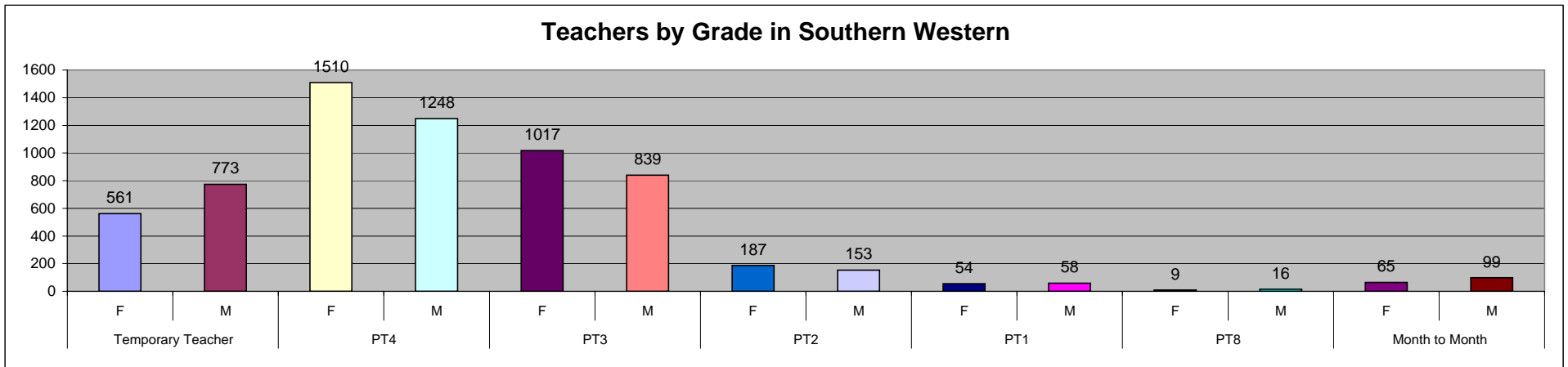
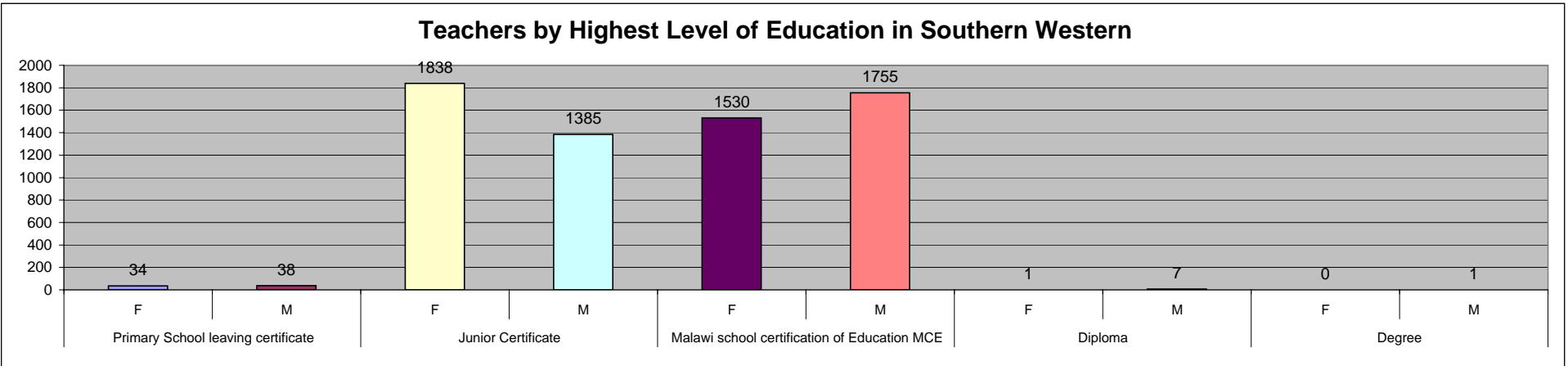
Graph 2.18e Teachers by Highest level of Education, Grade, and Training, in Shire Highlands Division 2004

Graph 3.2c Pupils Teacher and Pupils Classrooms Ratio by Districts

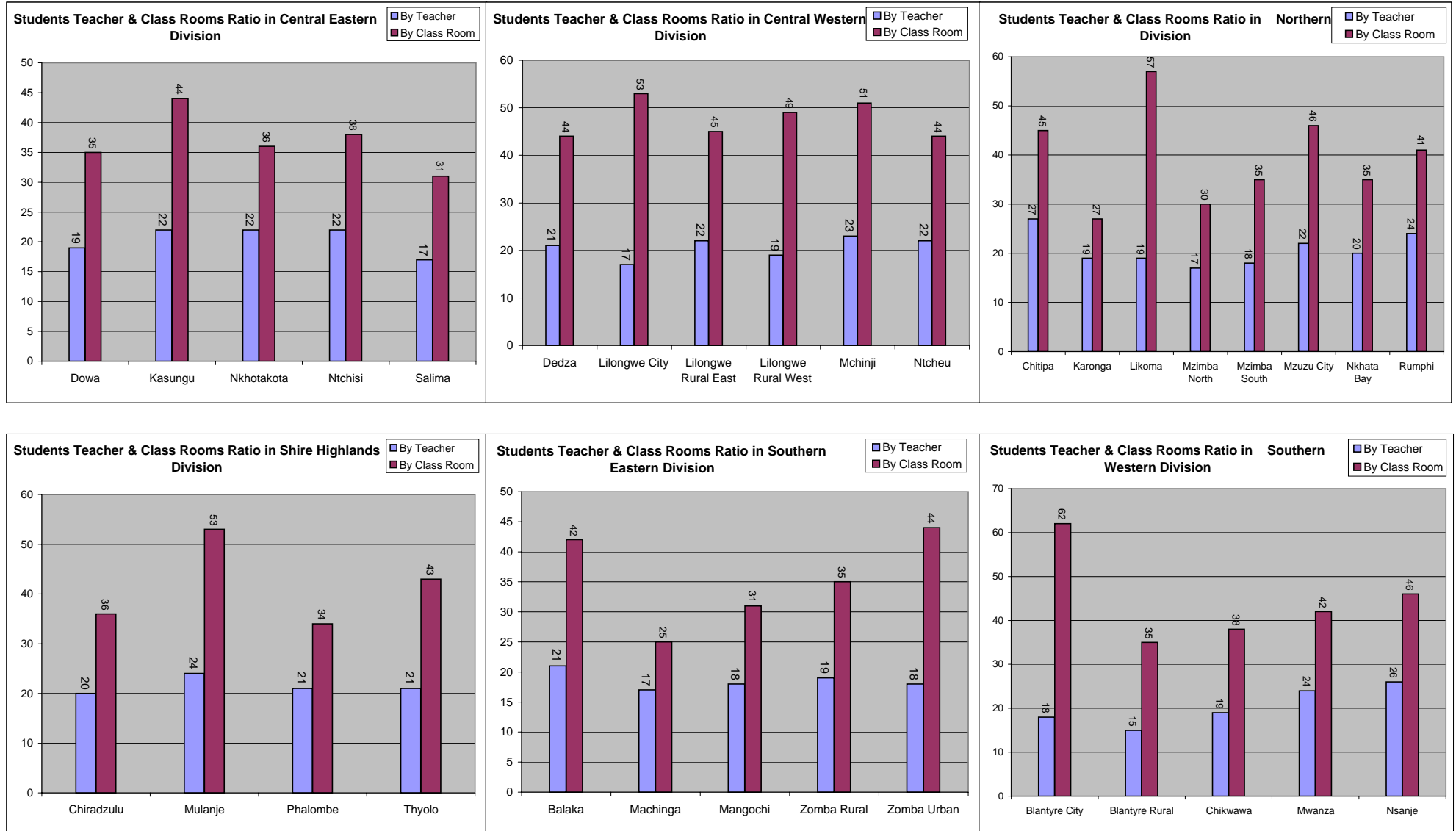

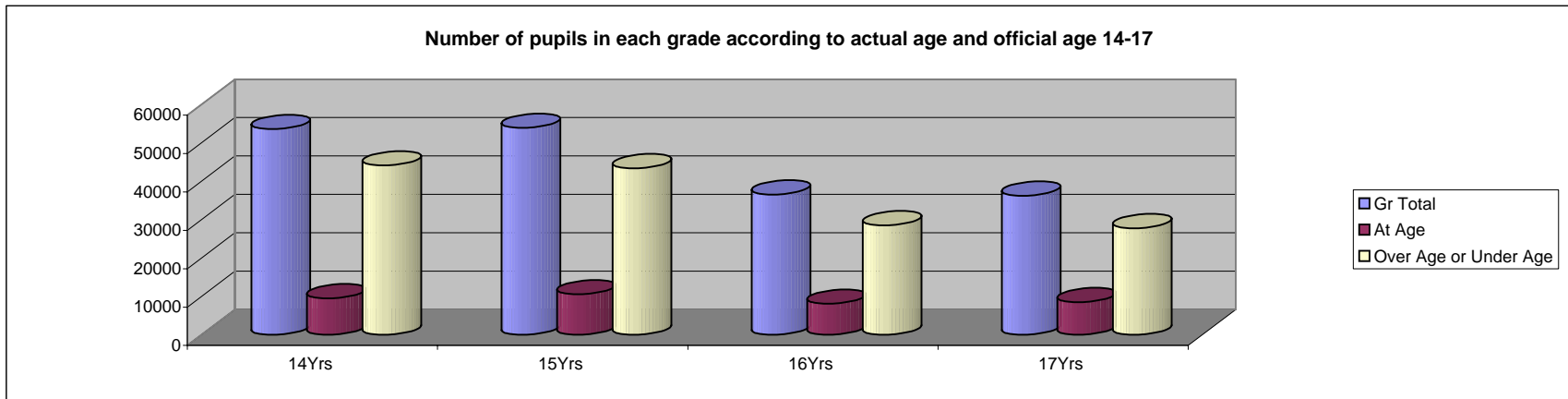

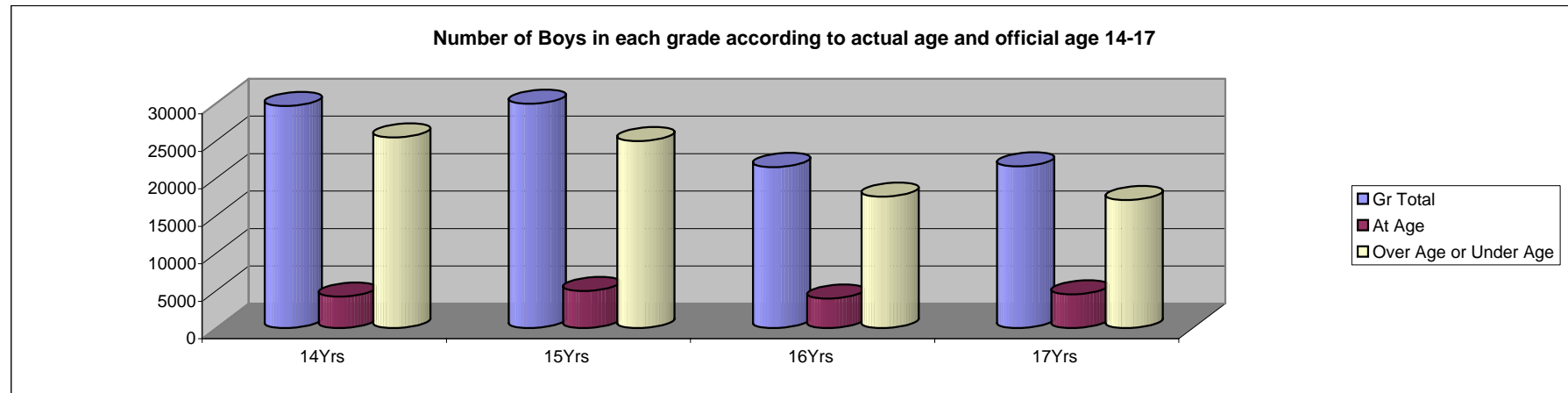

Graph 3.4a Number of Repeaters by Division

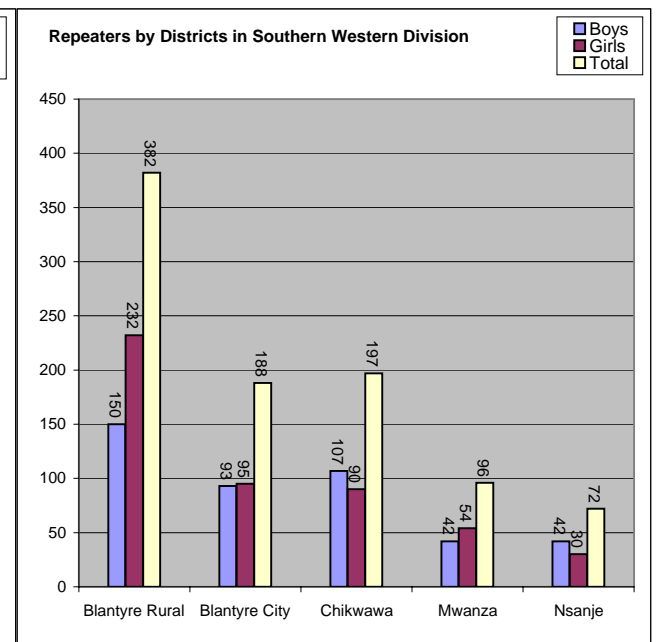
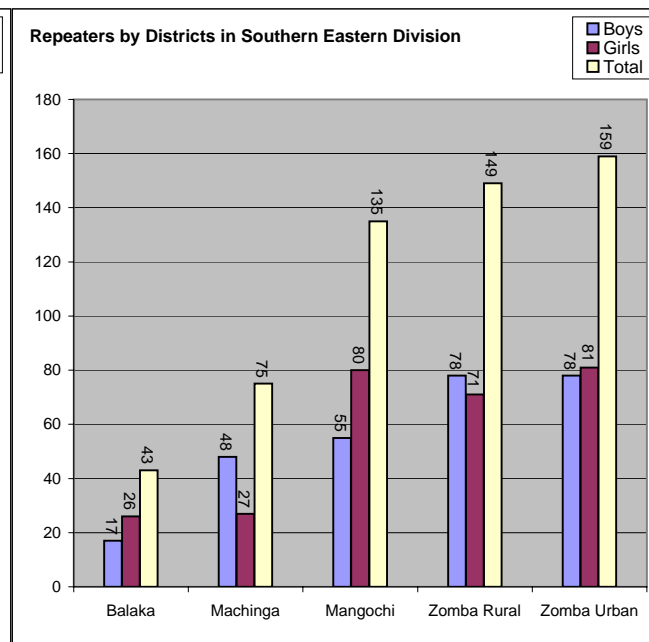
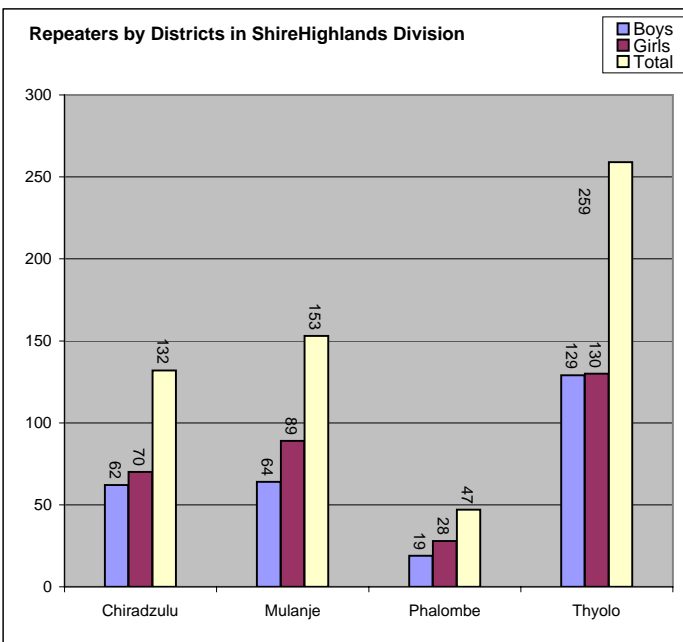
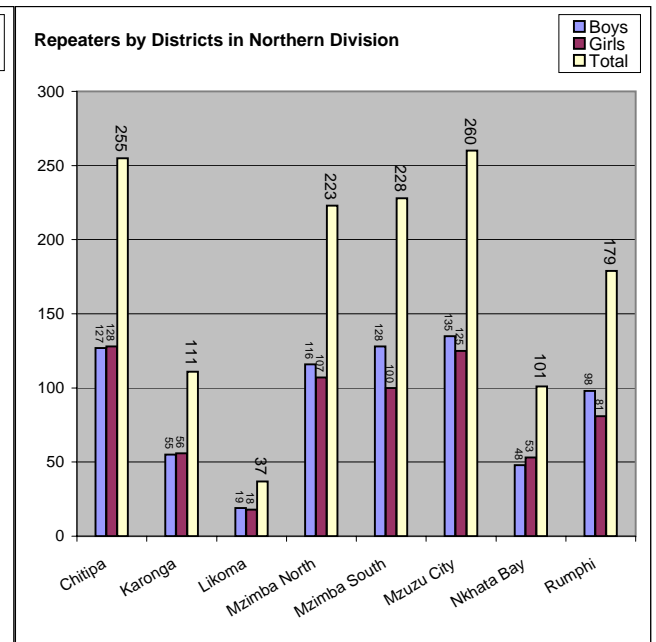
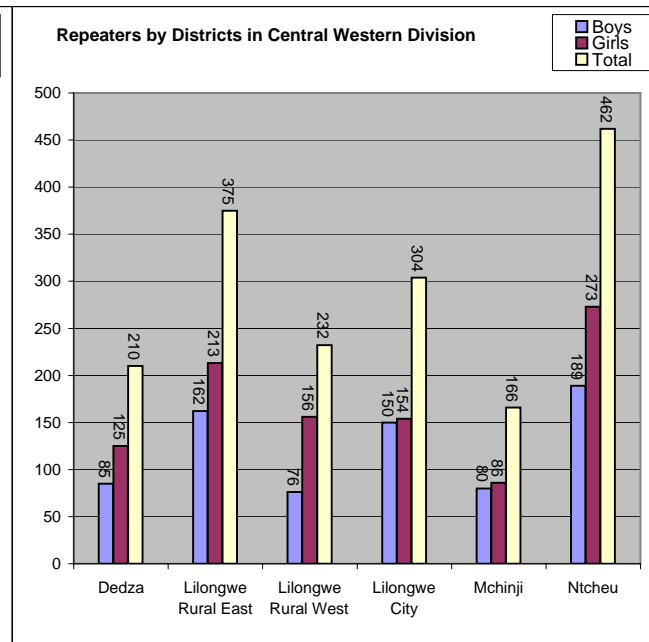
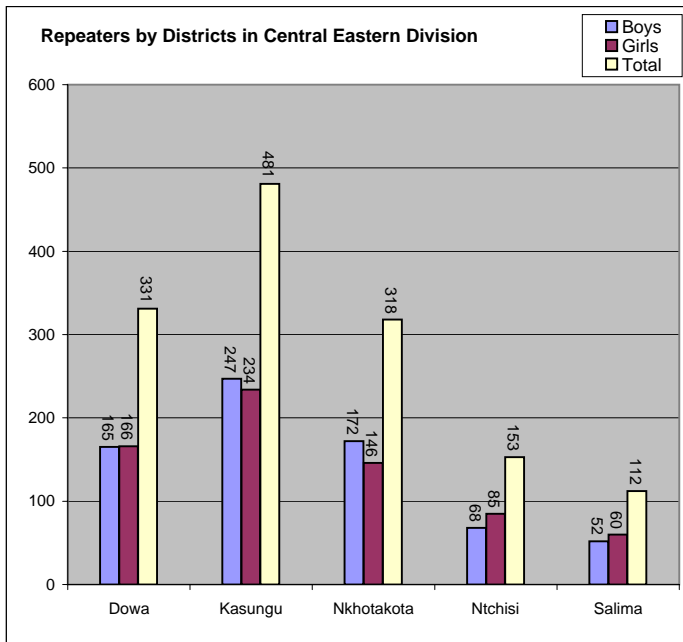

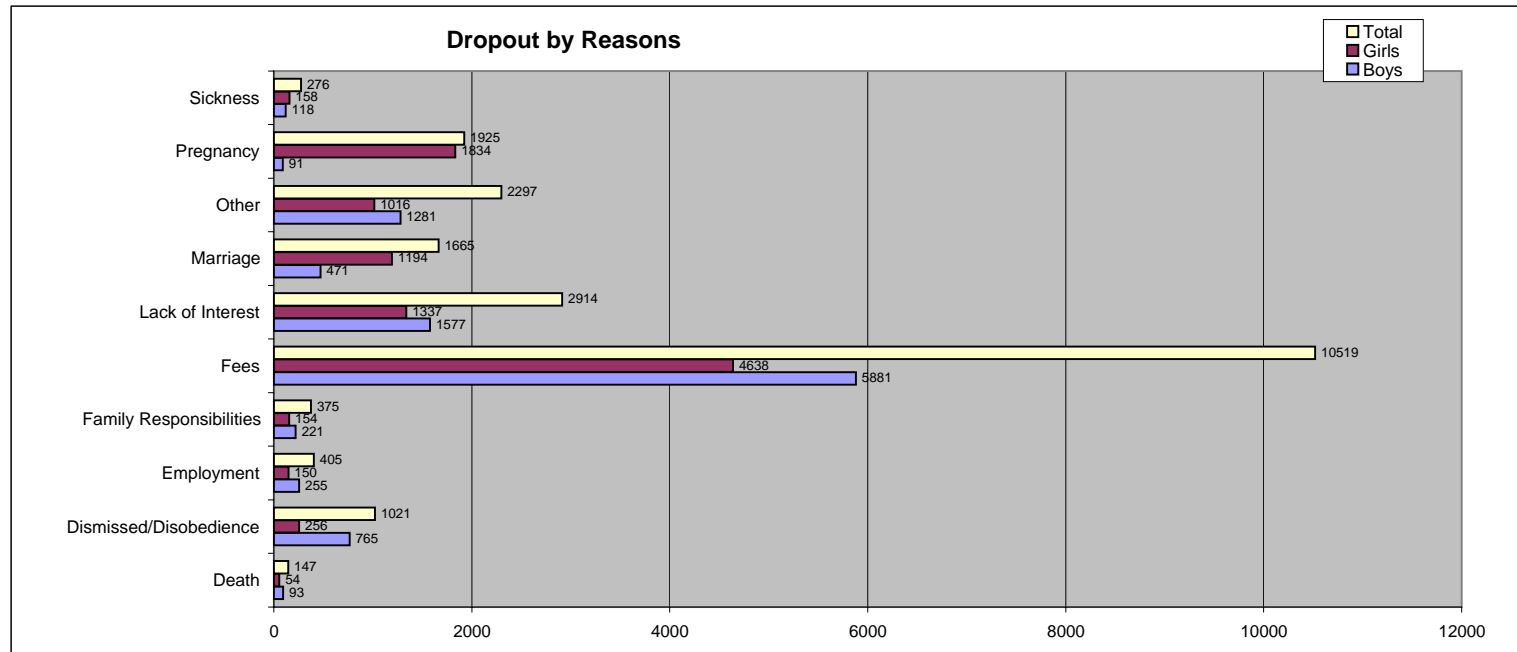

Graph 3.5b Number of Dropouts by Division/Districts

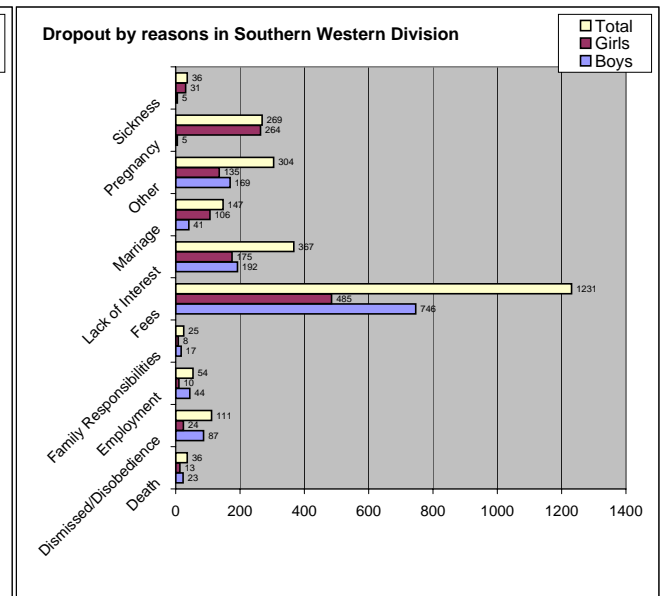
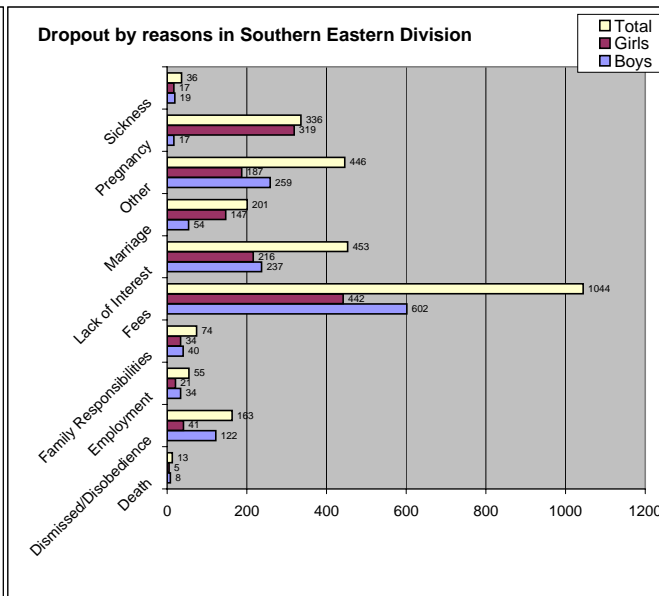
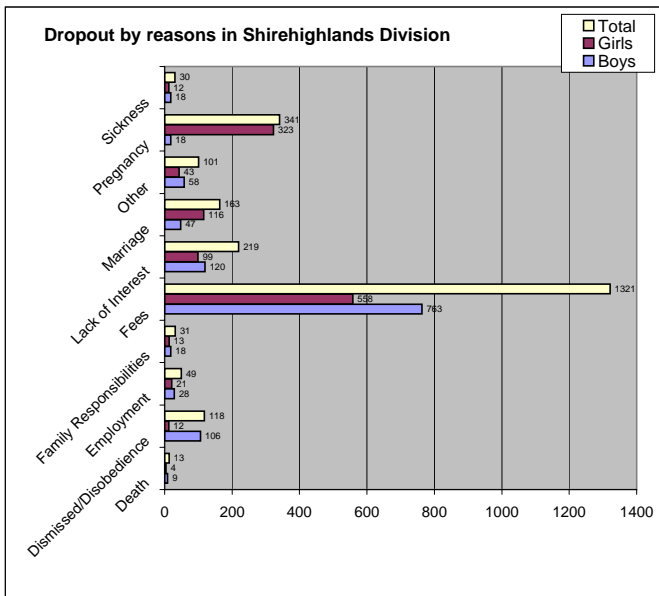
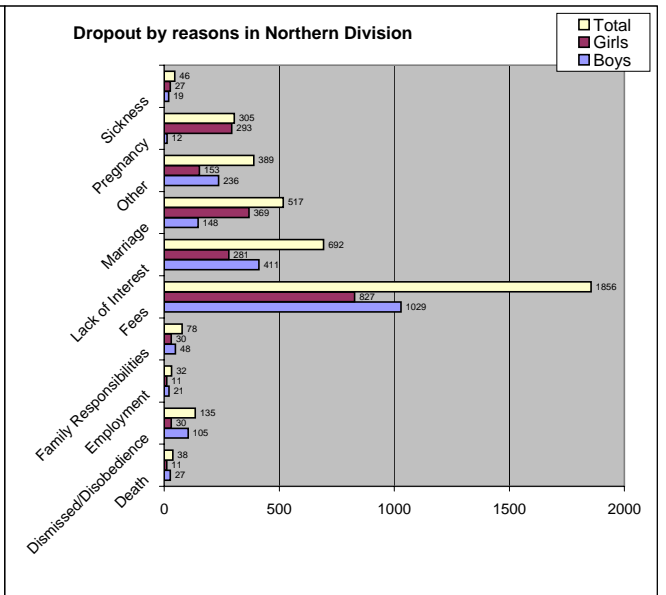
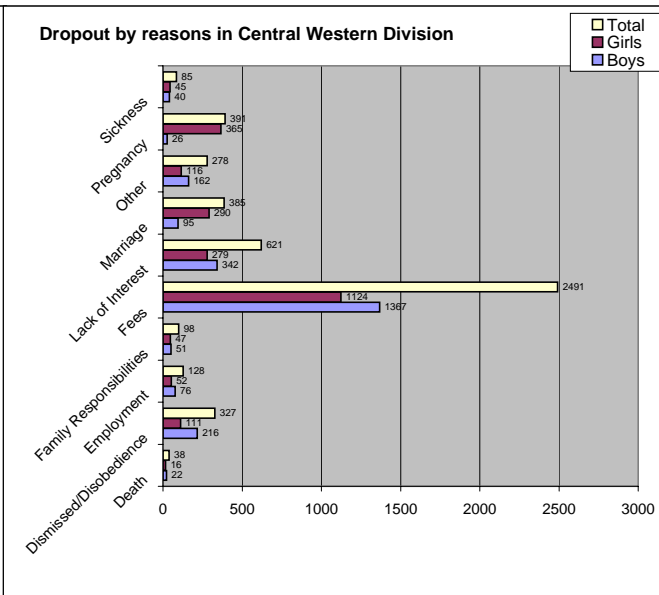
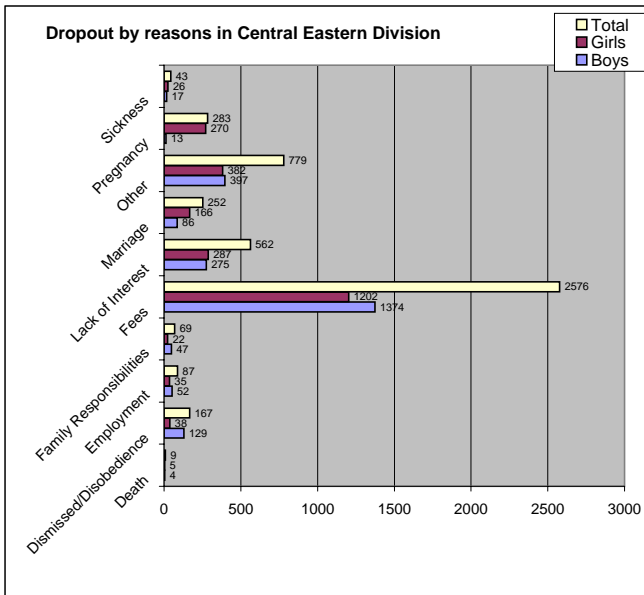

Graph 3.6a Number of Pupils transferred into and out of schools by Division and Sex

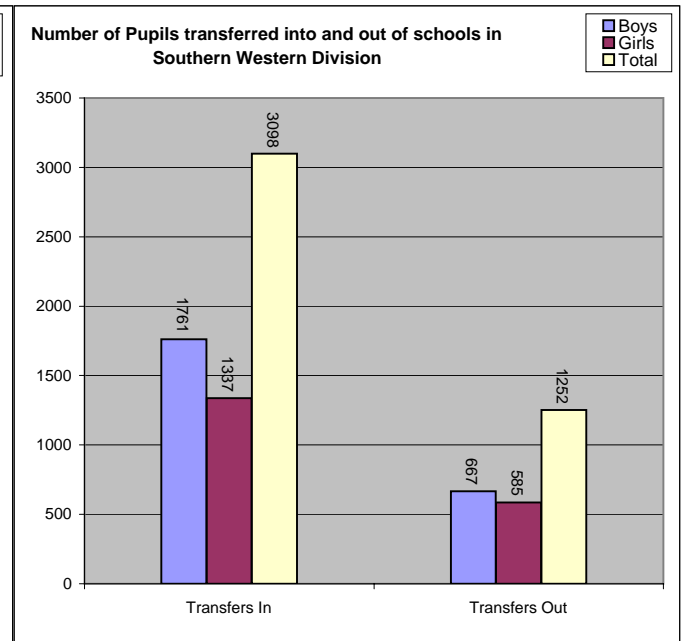
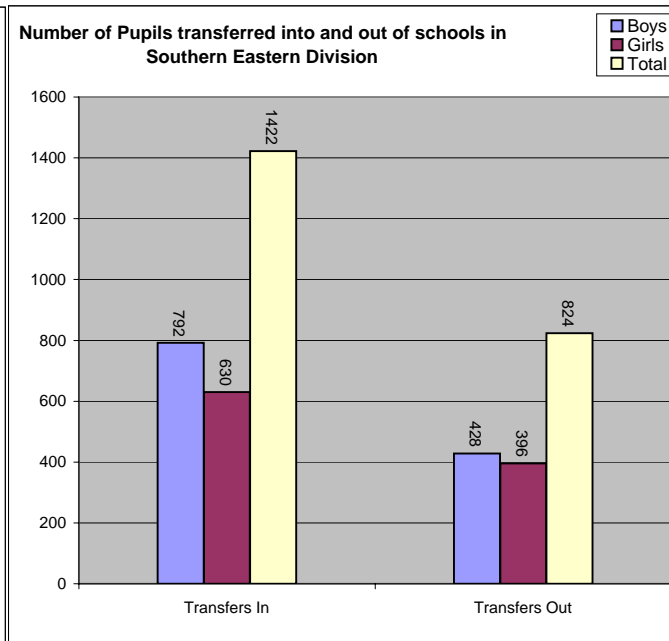
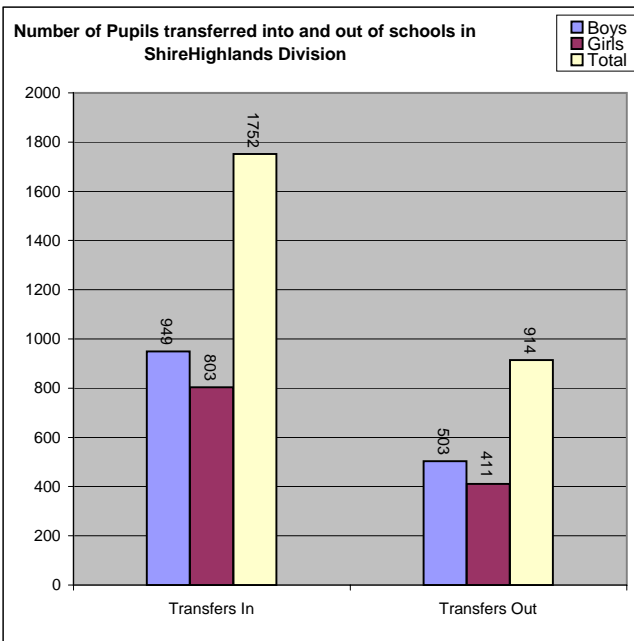
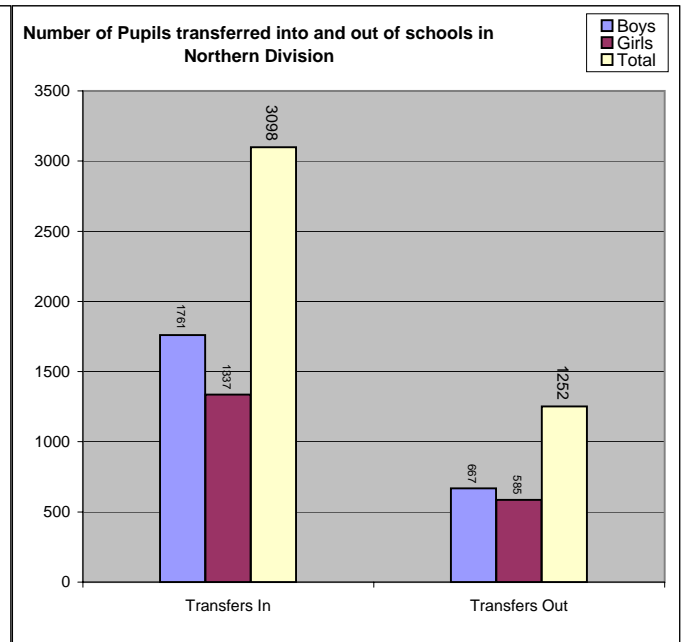
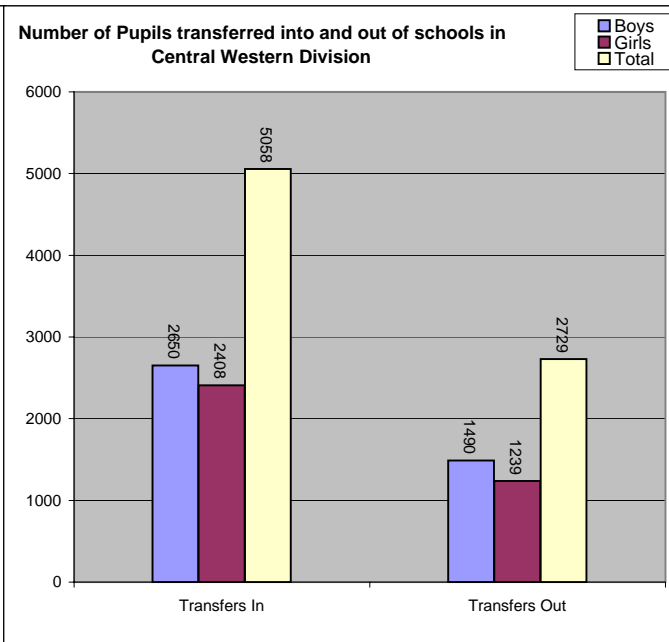
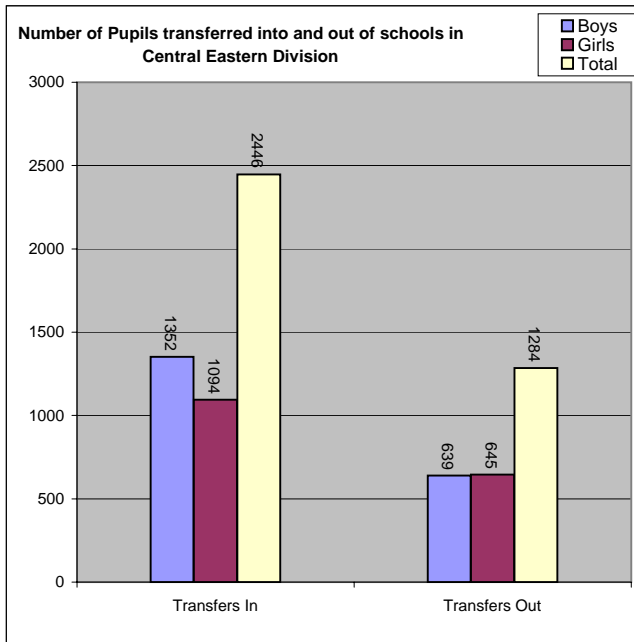

Graph 3.7b Number of Pupils with Special education learning needs by Division and Sex

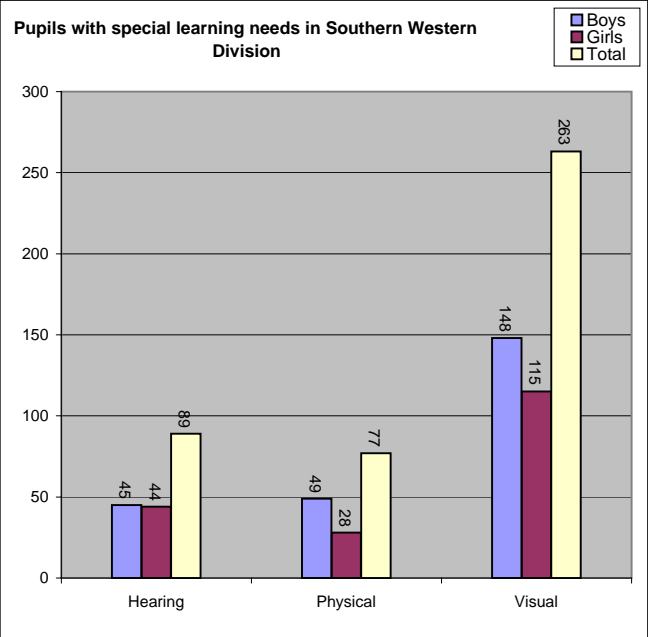
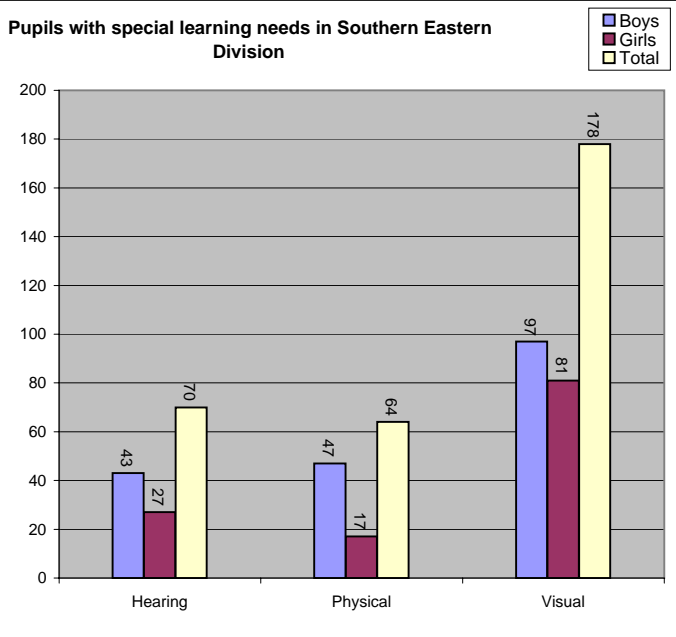
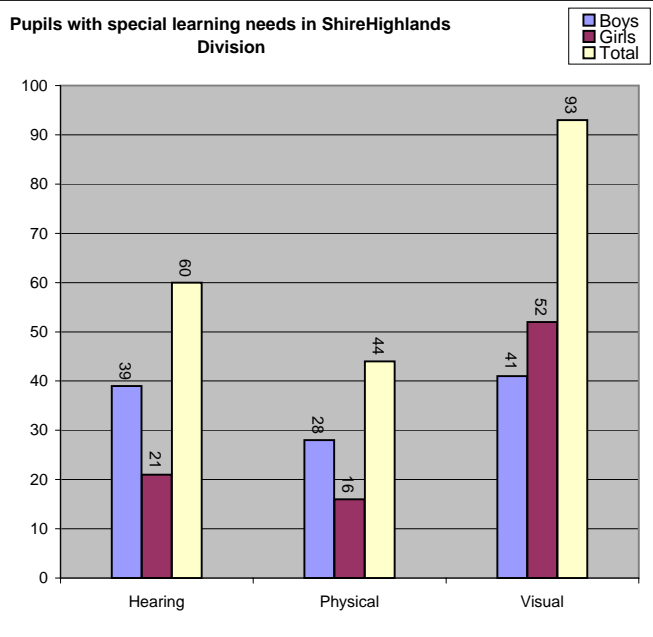
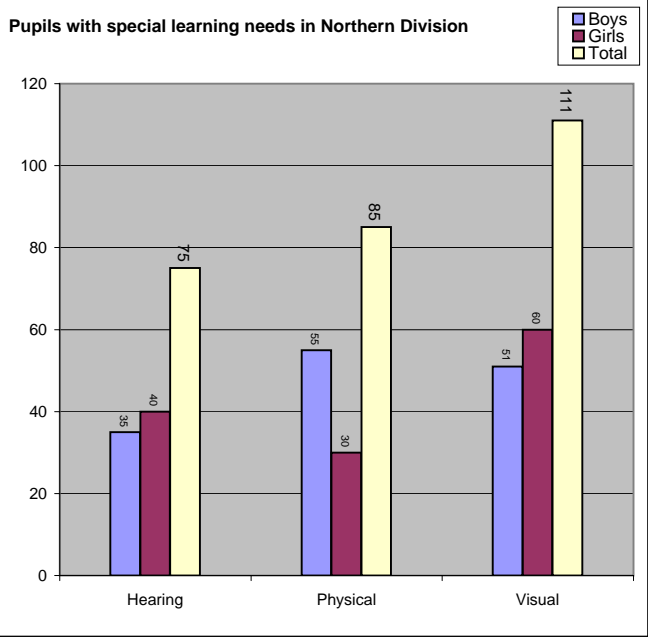
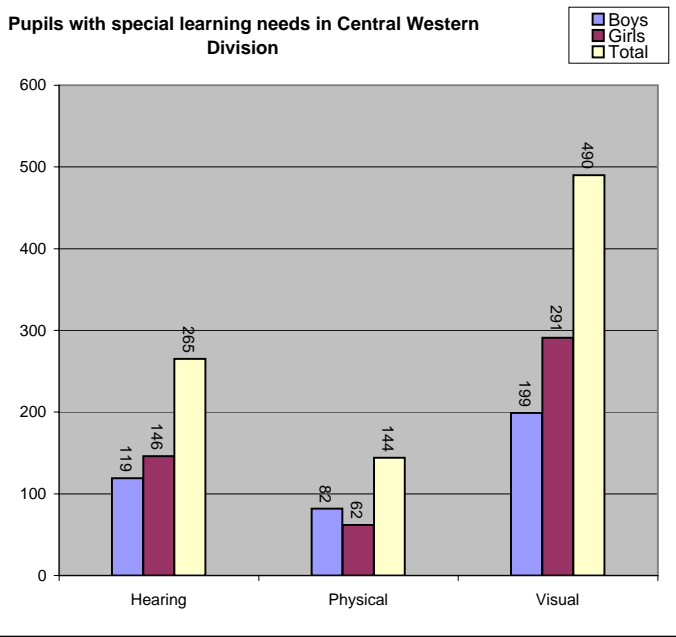
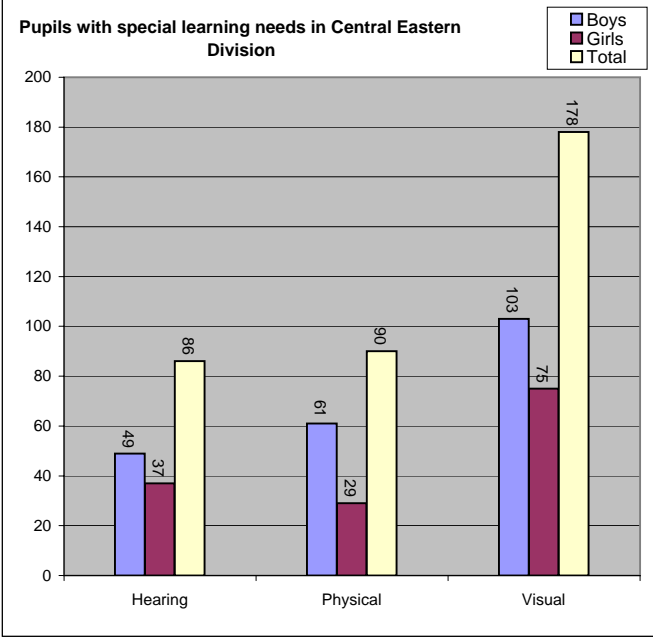

Graph 3.8a Number of Orphans Pupils by Division and Sex, 2004

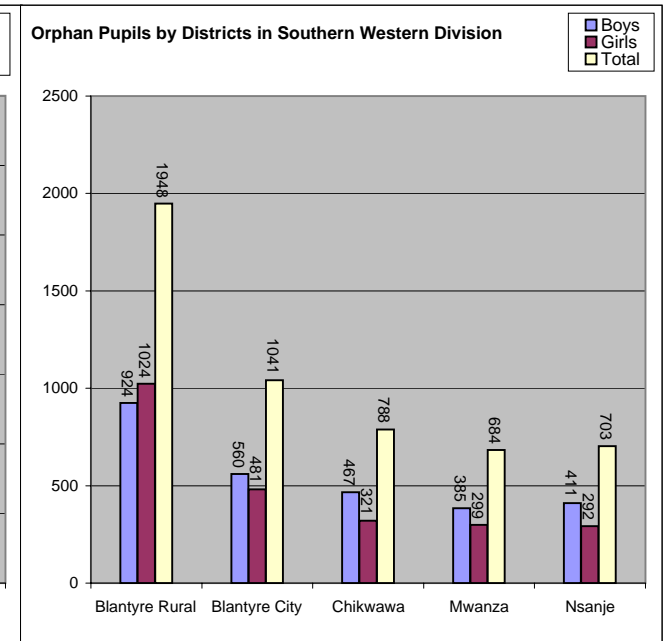
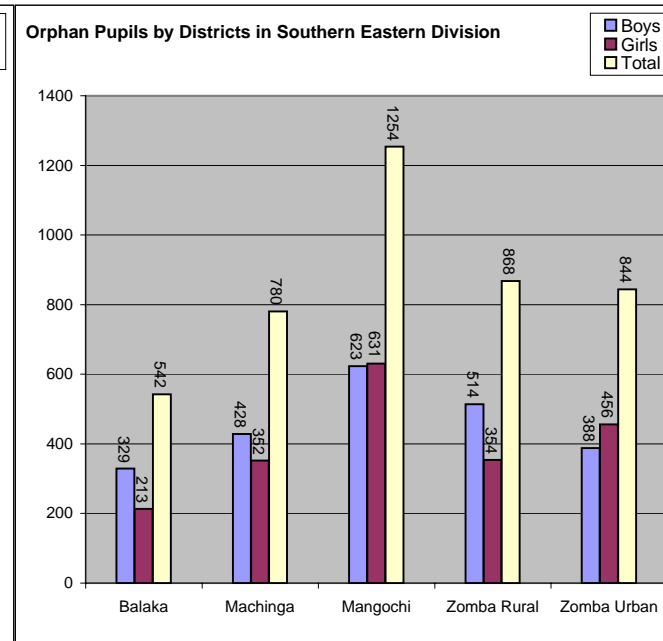
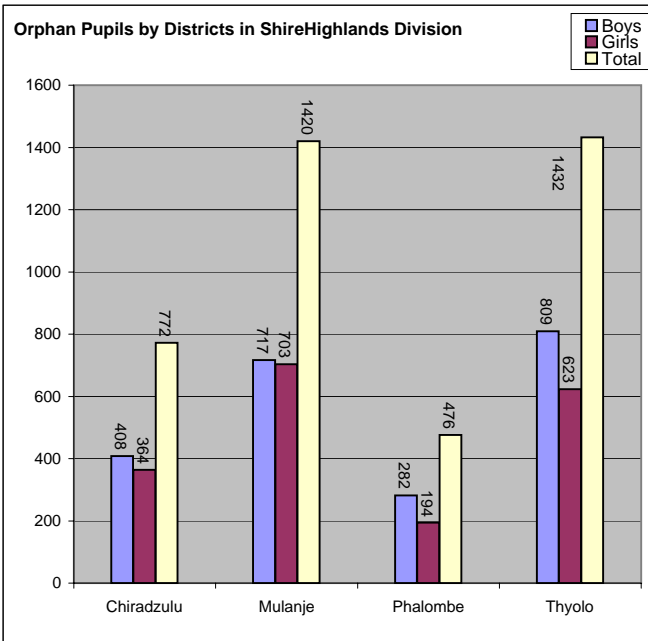
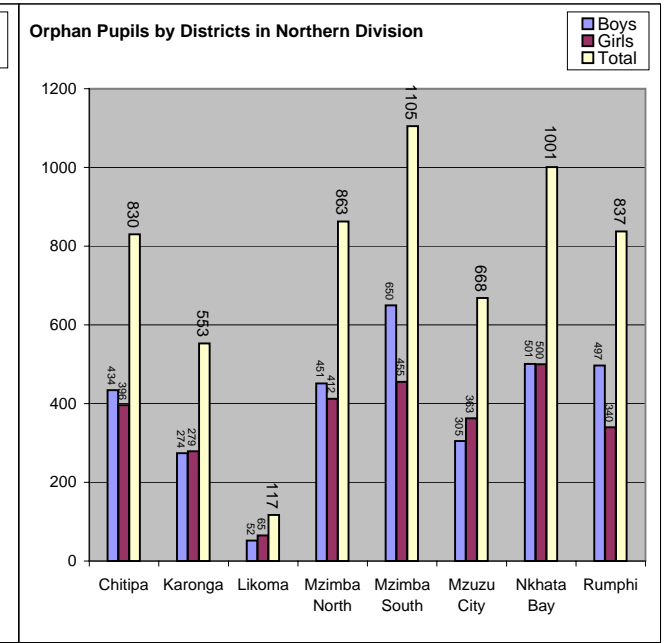
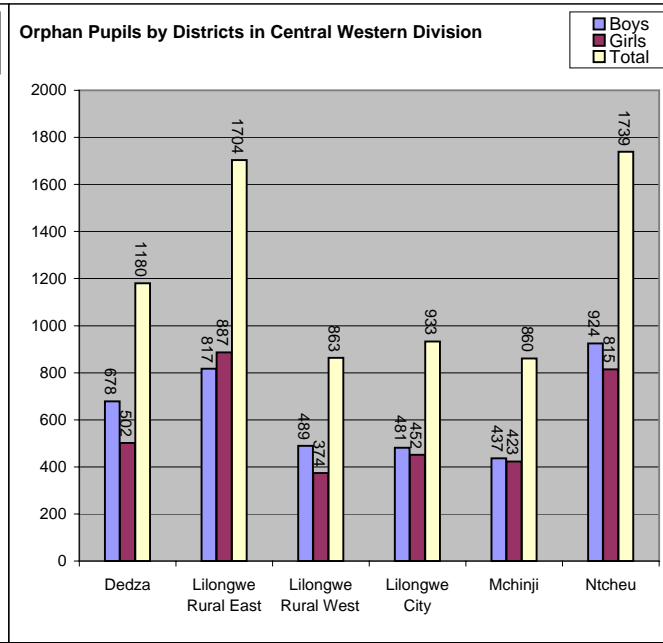
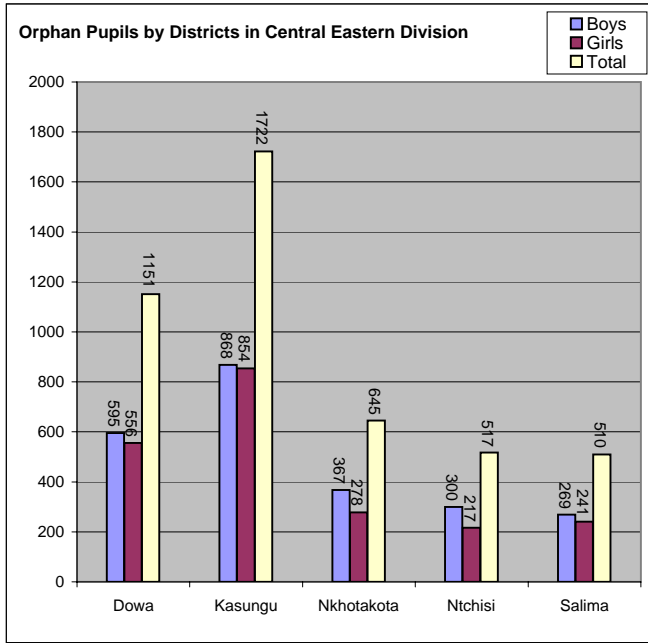

Graph 3.9b Number of Building (Rooms) by condition, type, by Division

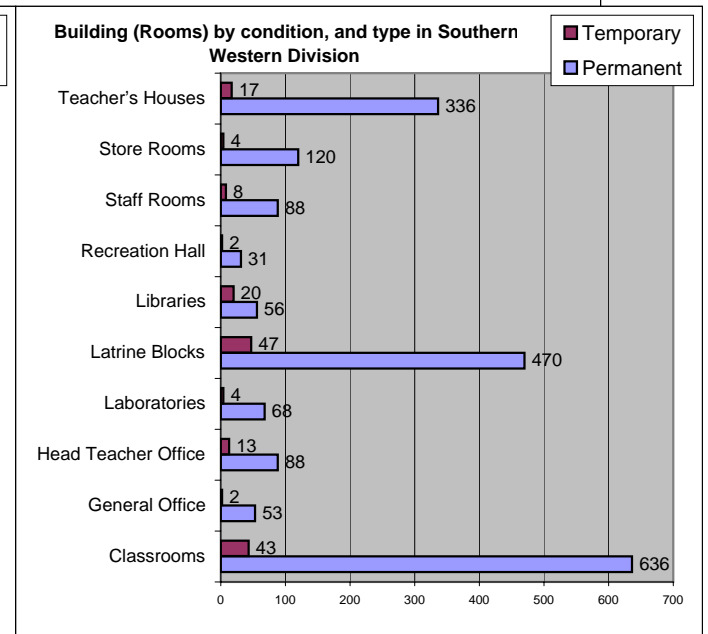
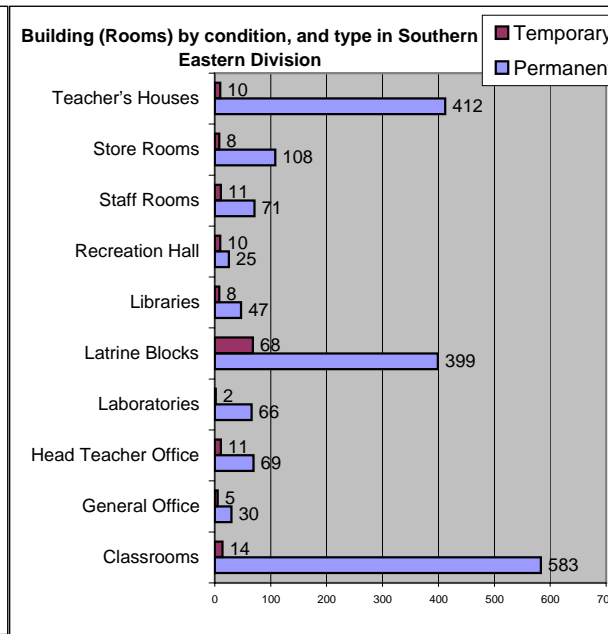
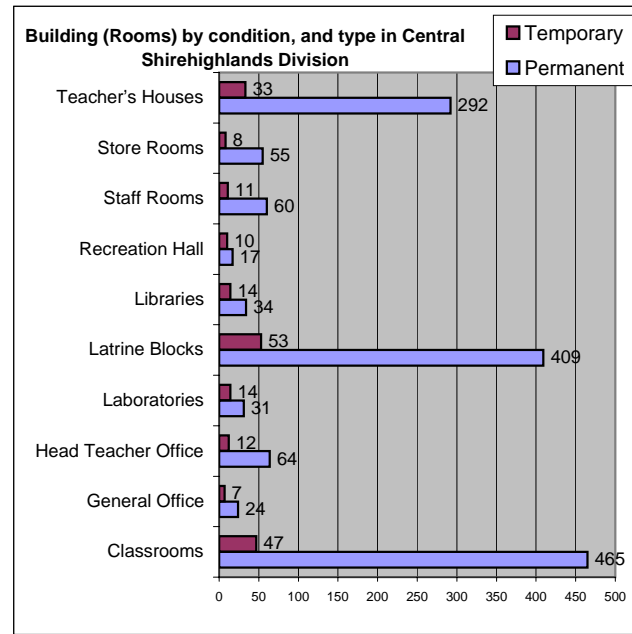
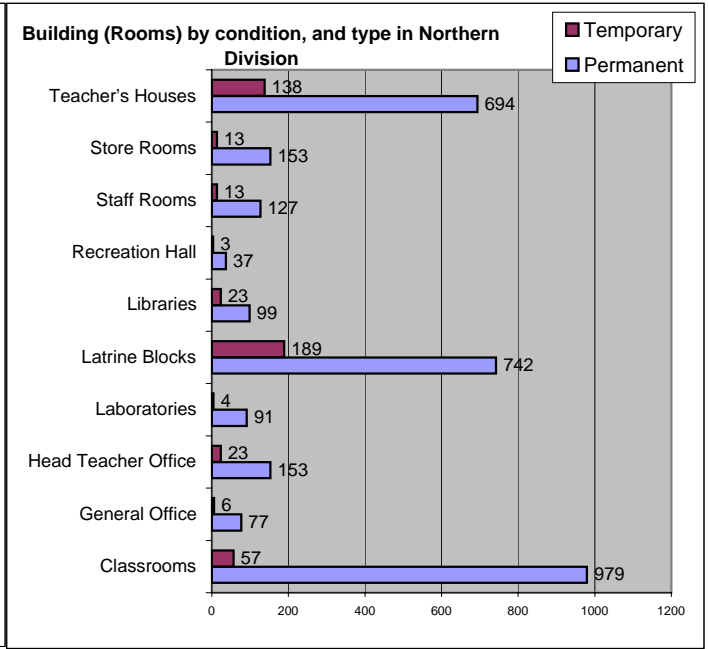
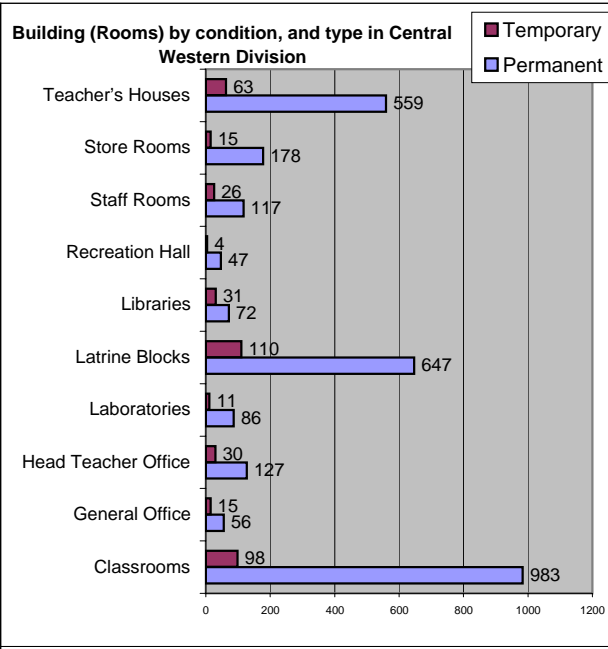
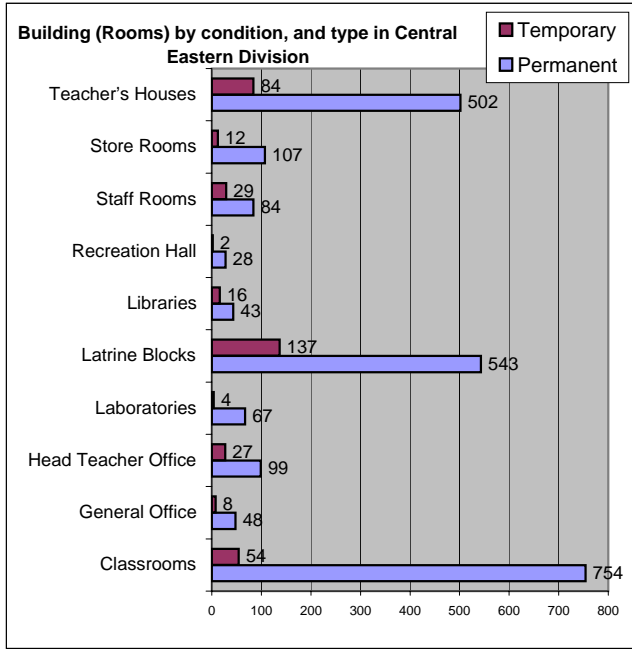
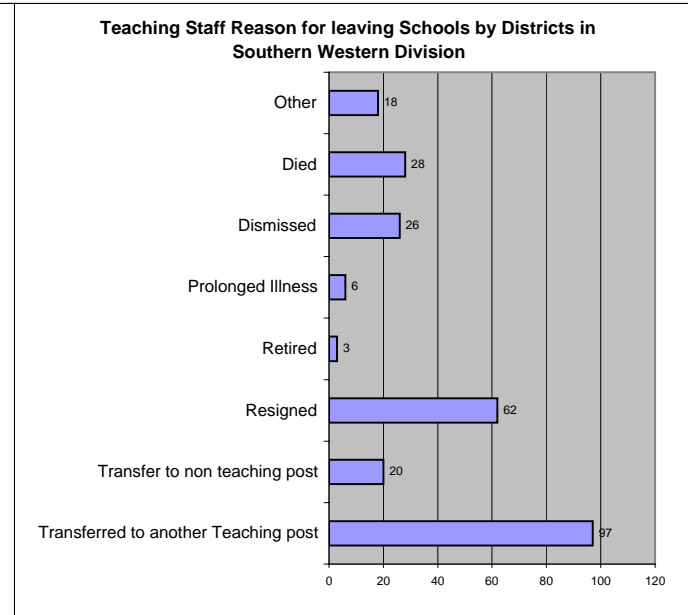
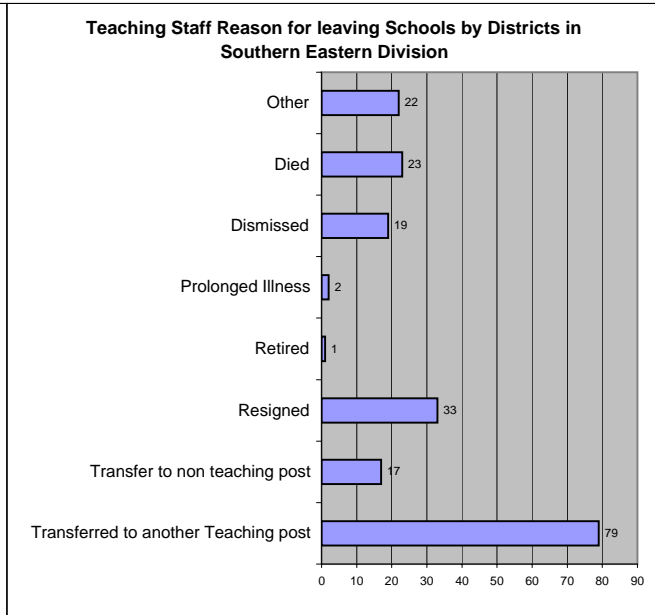
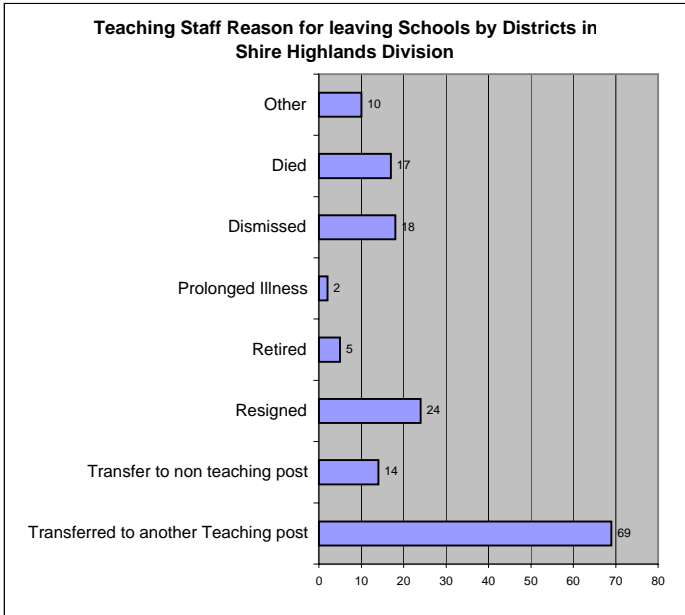
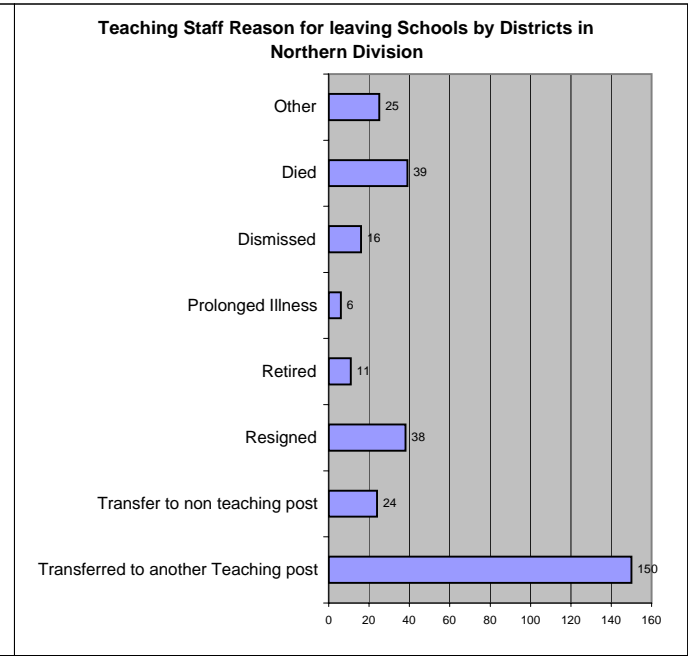
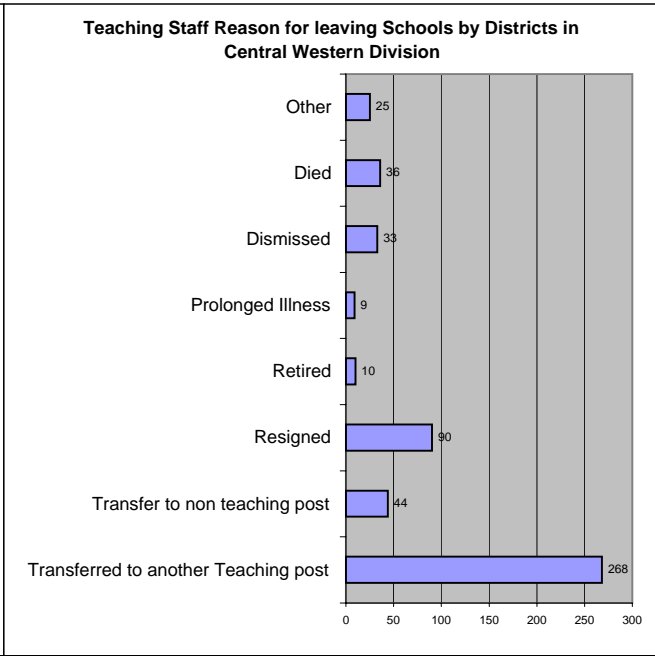
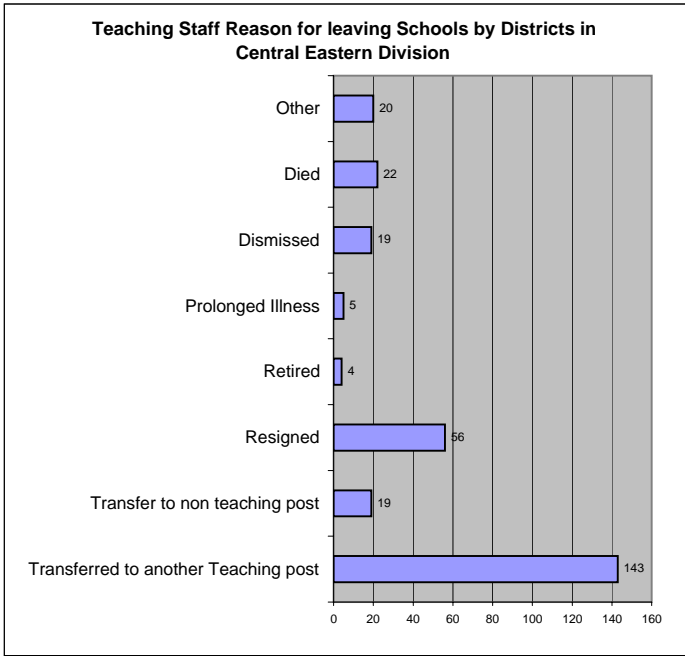


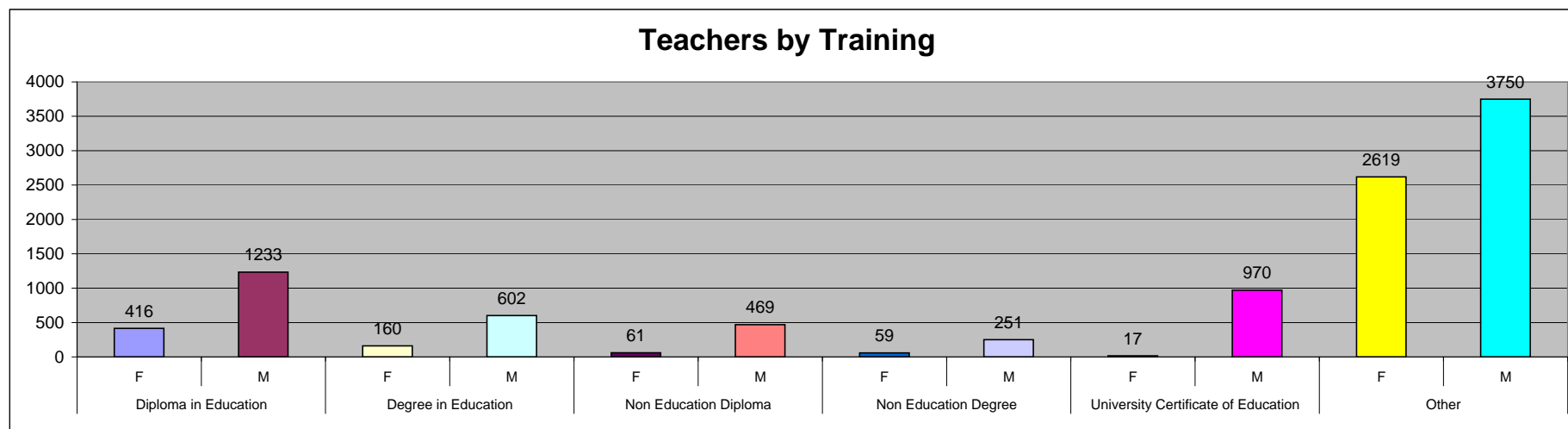
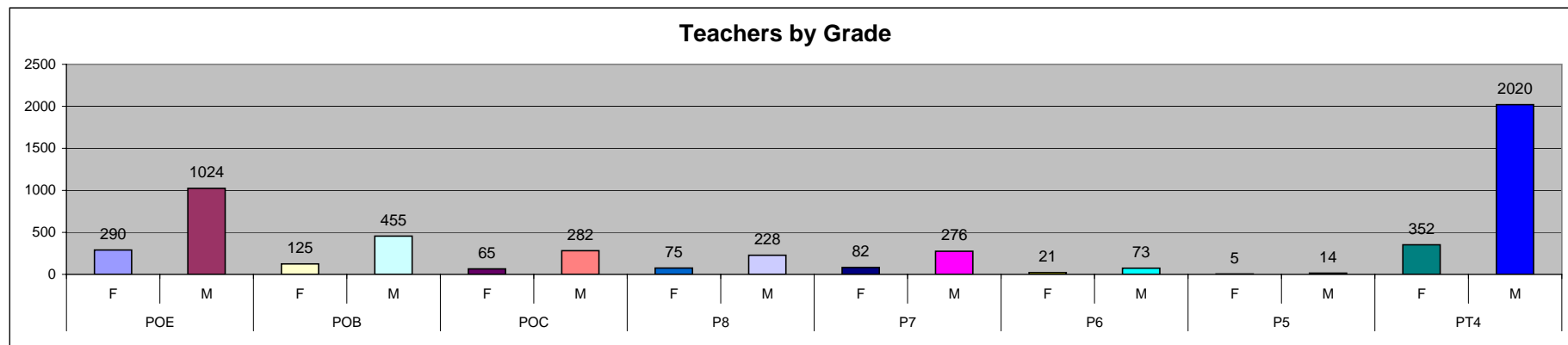
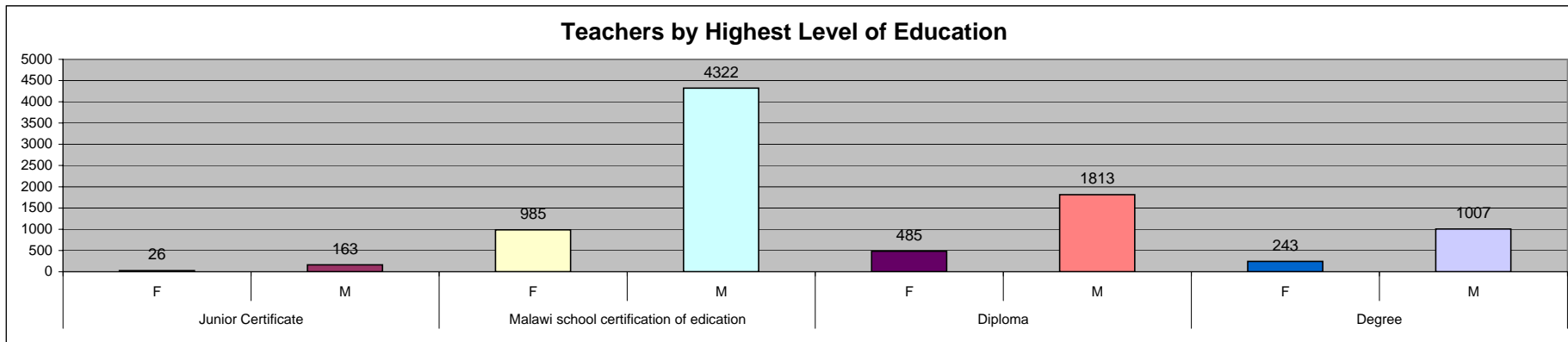

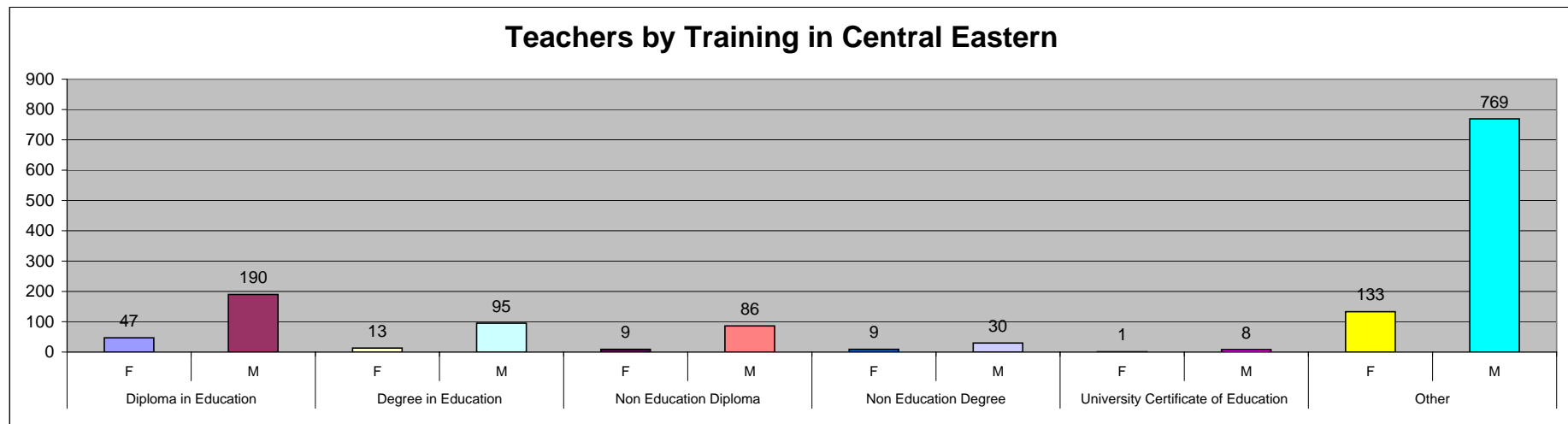
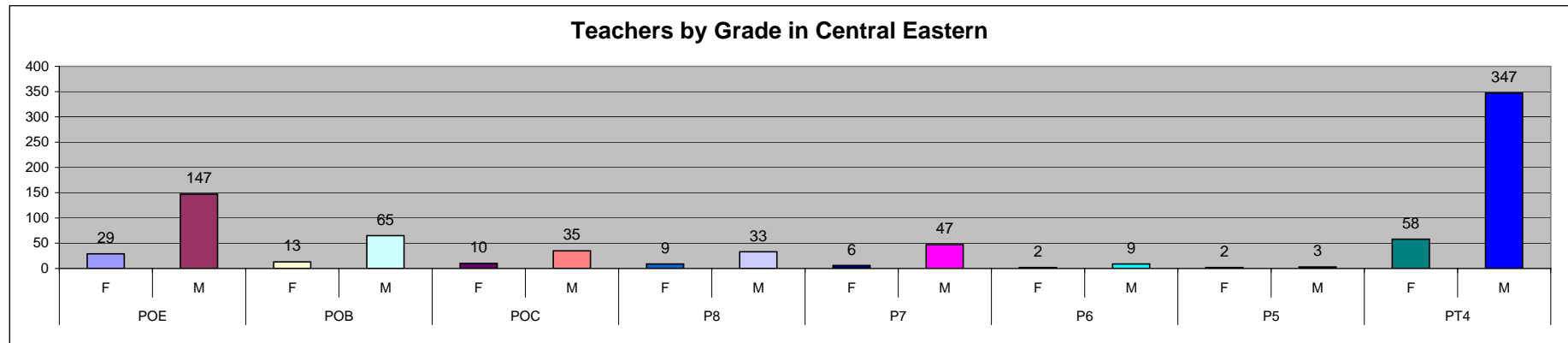
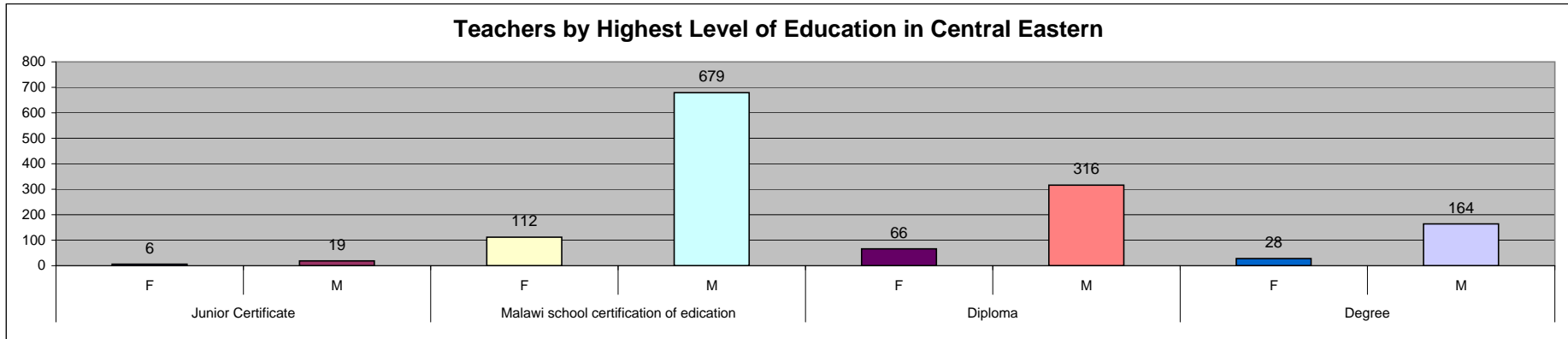
Graph 3.10a Teaching Staff Reason for leaving Schools by Division/Districts



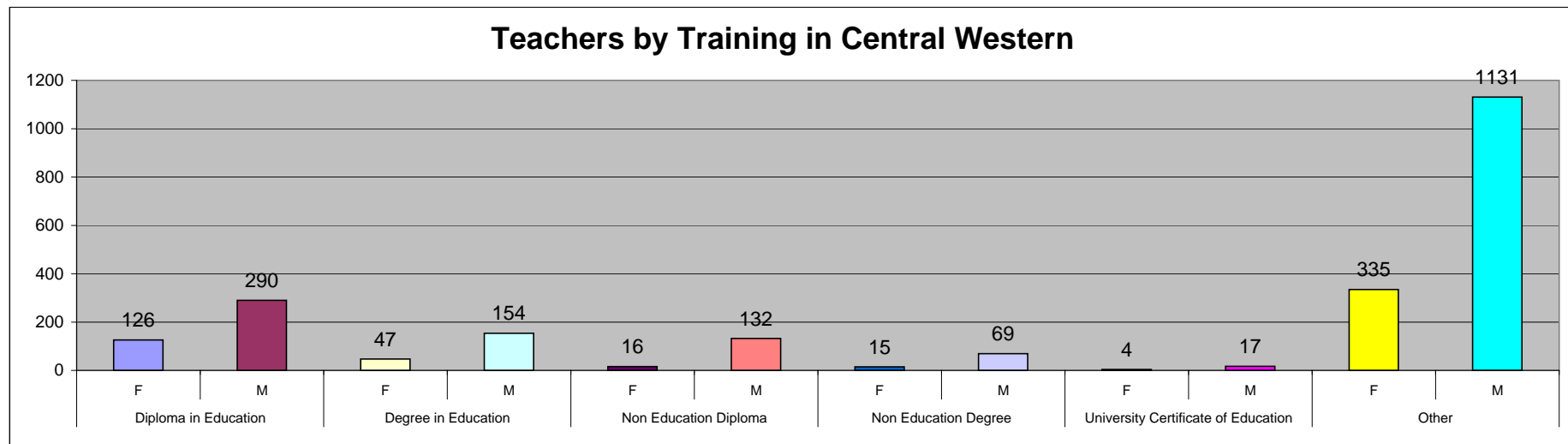
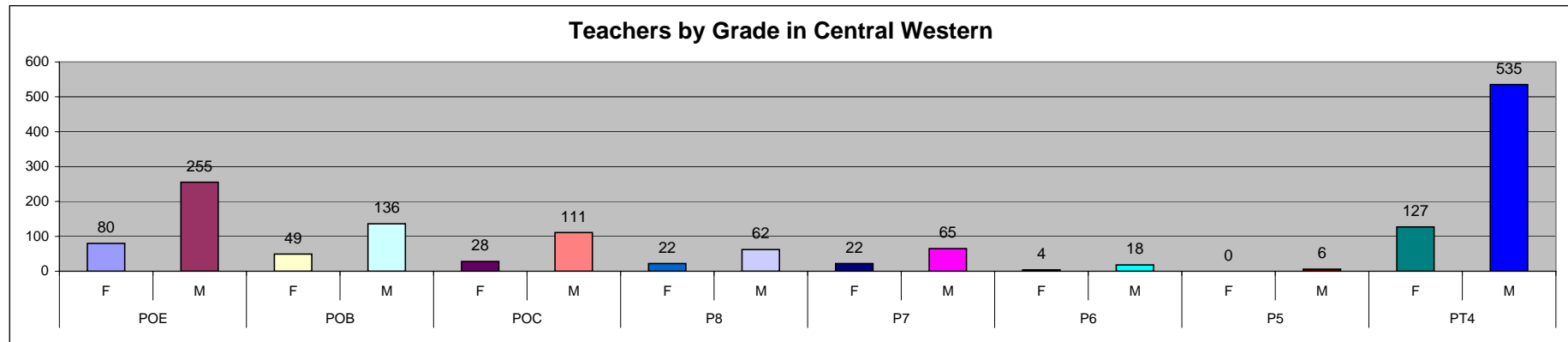
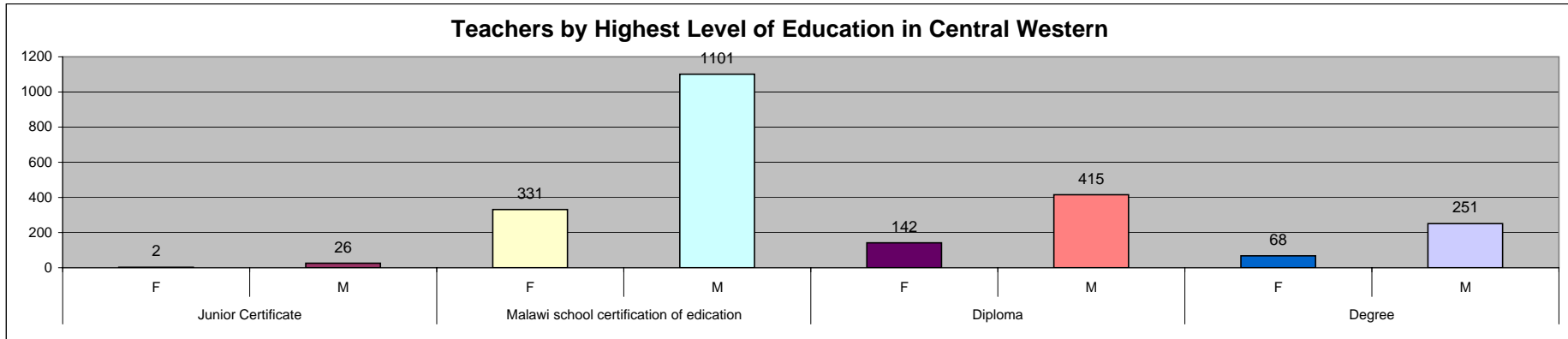
Graph 3.11a Teachers by Highest level of Education, Grade, Training and Sex, 2004



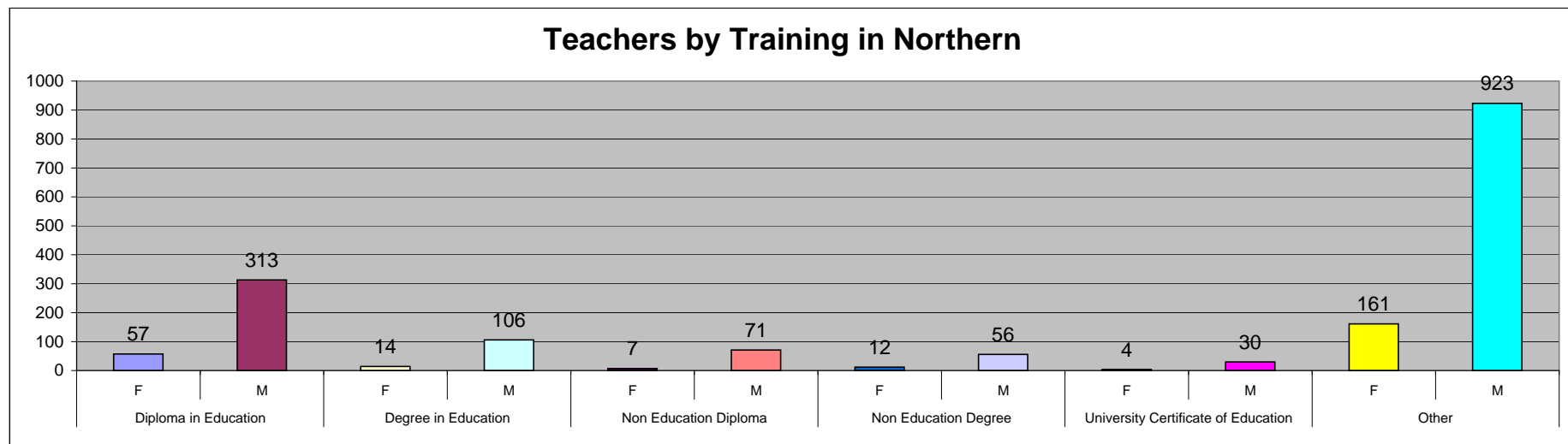
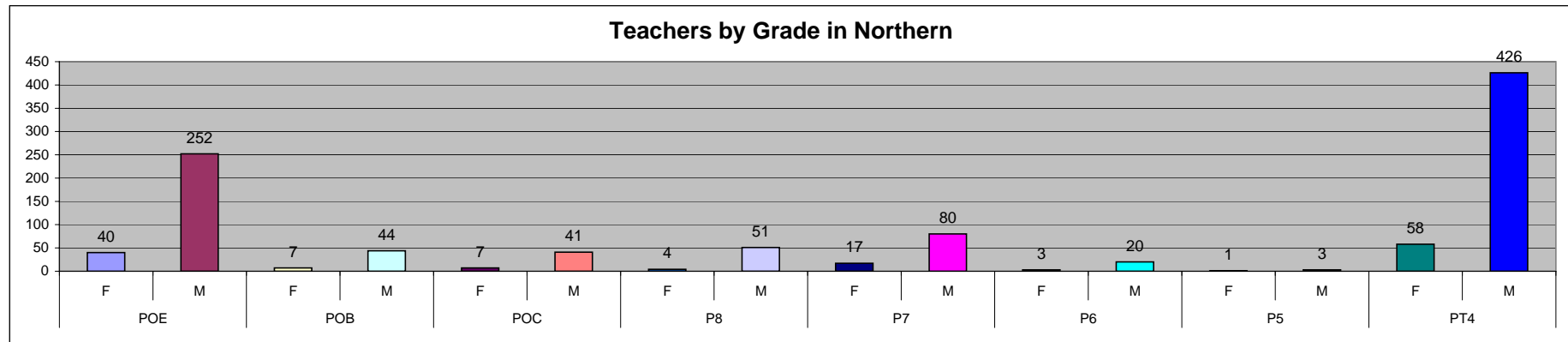
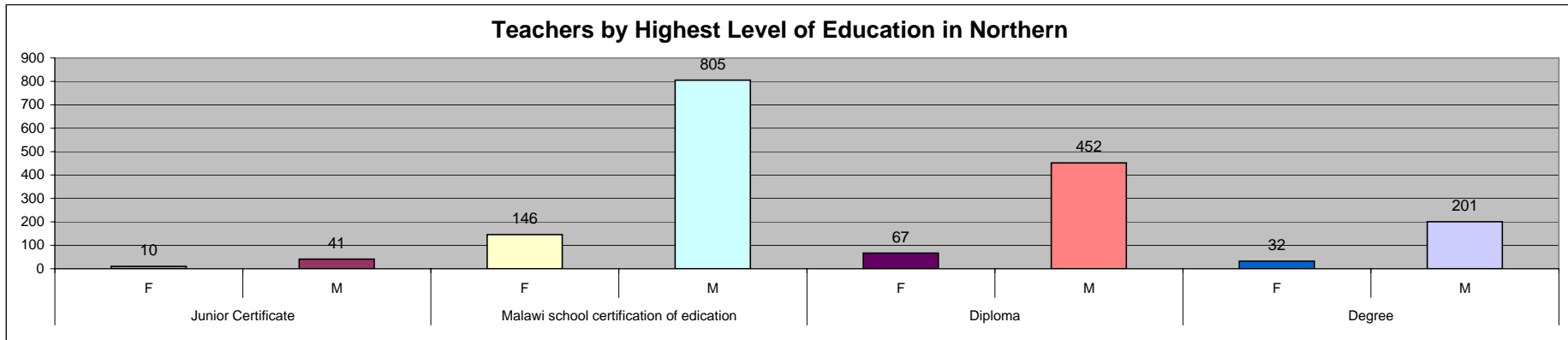
Graph 3.11b Teachers by Highest level of Education, Grade, Training and Sex, 2004 (Central Eastern)



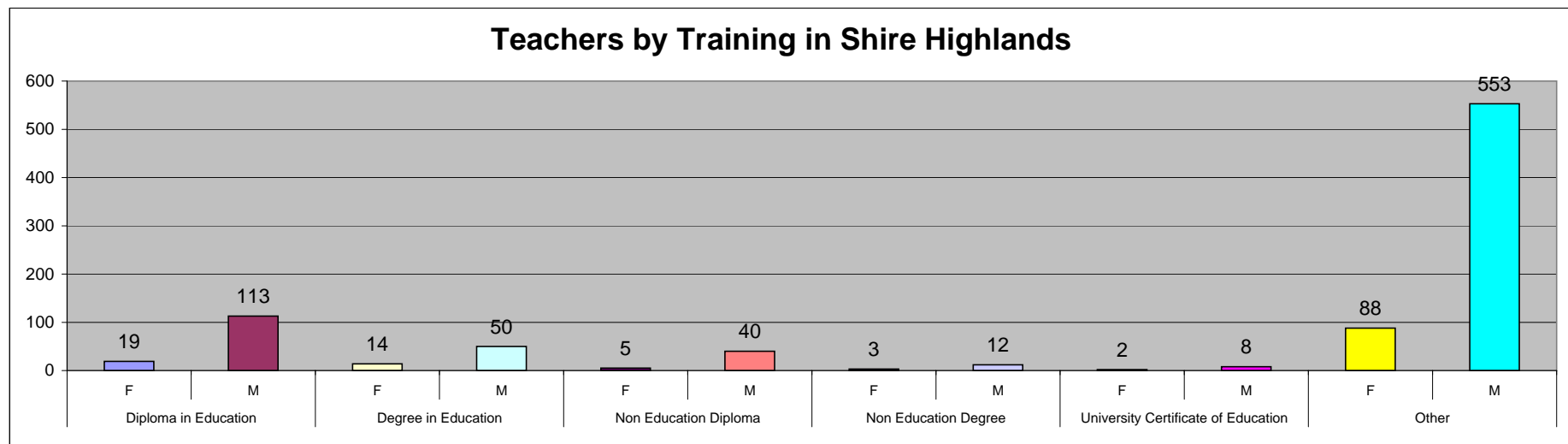
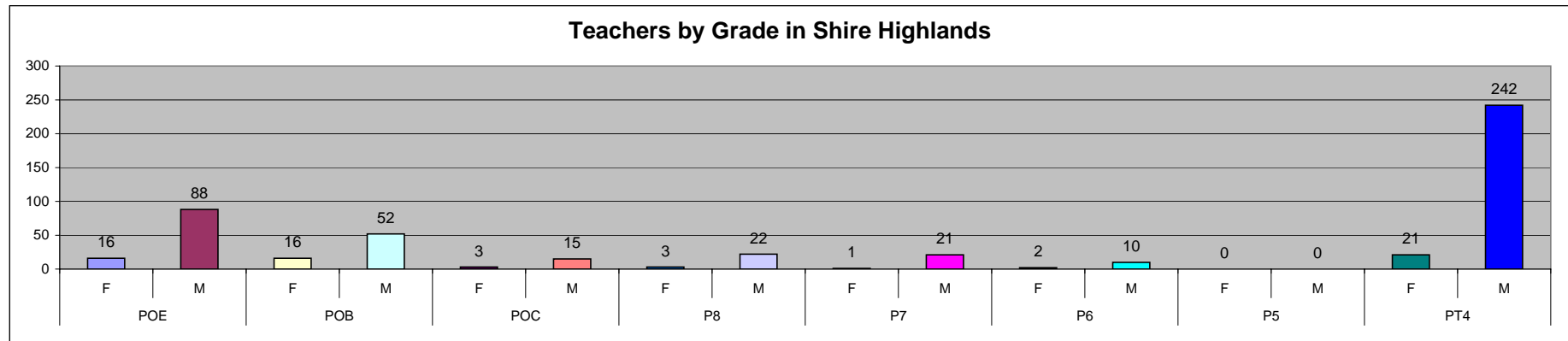
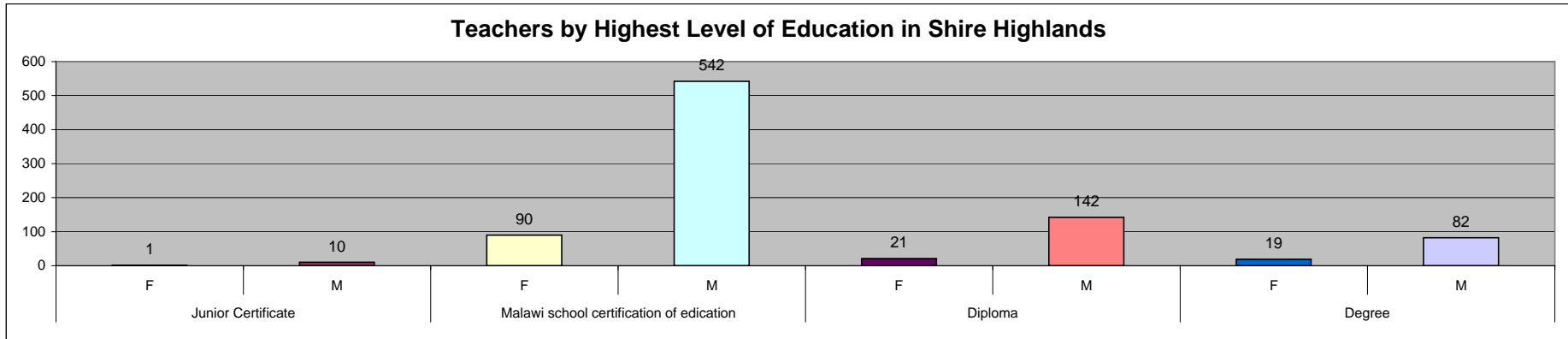
Graph 3.11c Teachers by Highest level of Education, Grade, Training and Sex, 2004 (Central Western)



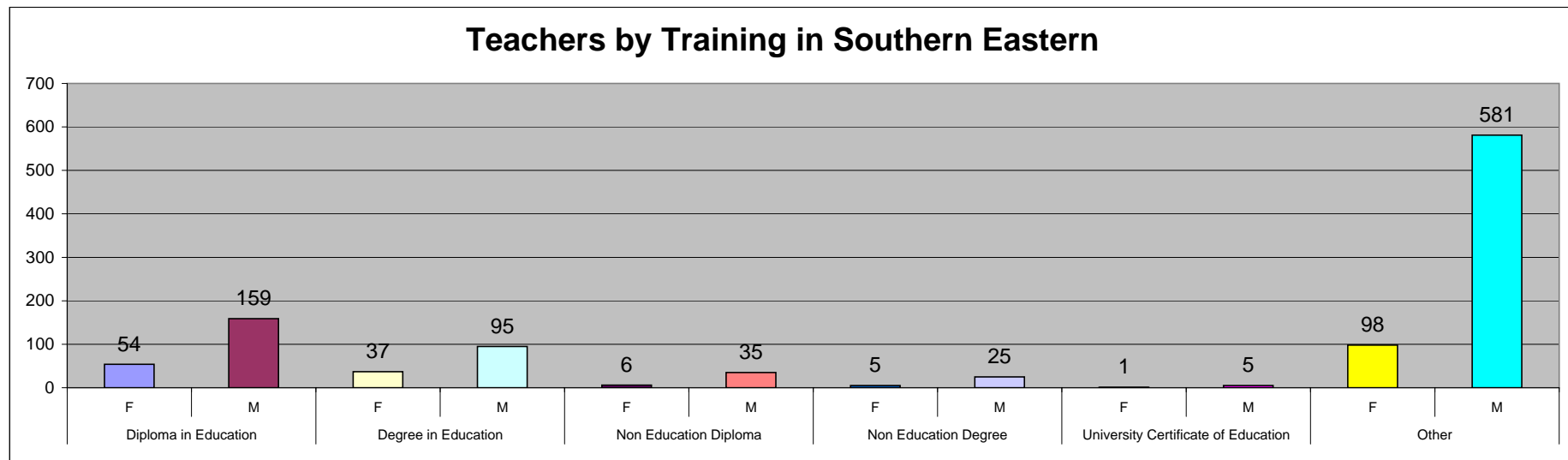
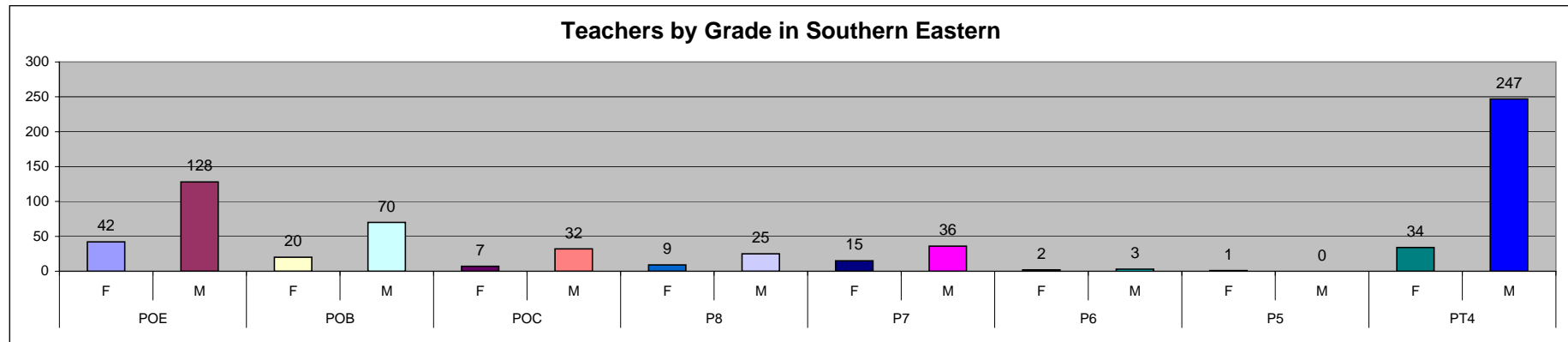
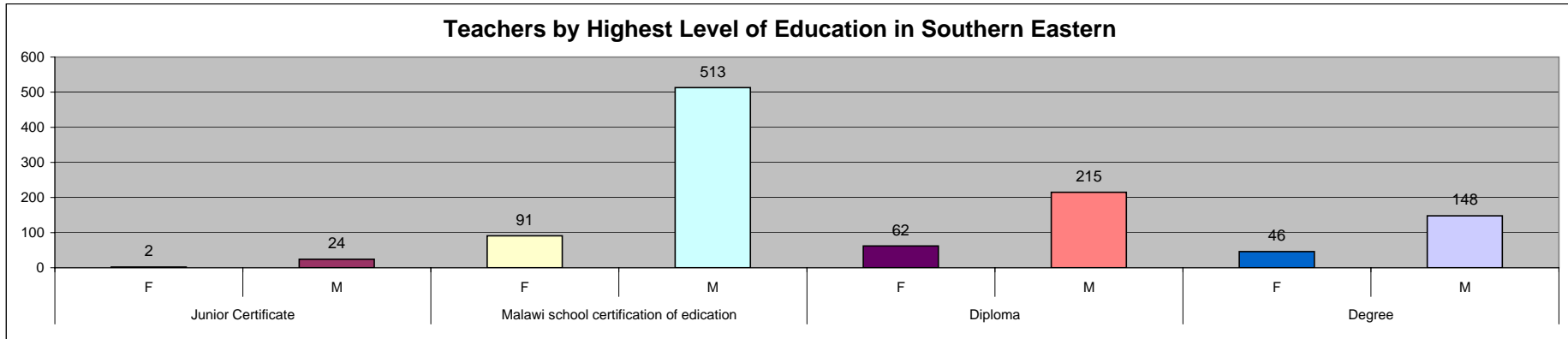
Graph 3.11d Teachers by Highest level of Education, Grade, Training and Sex, 2004 (Northern)
