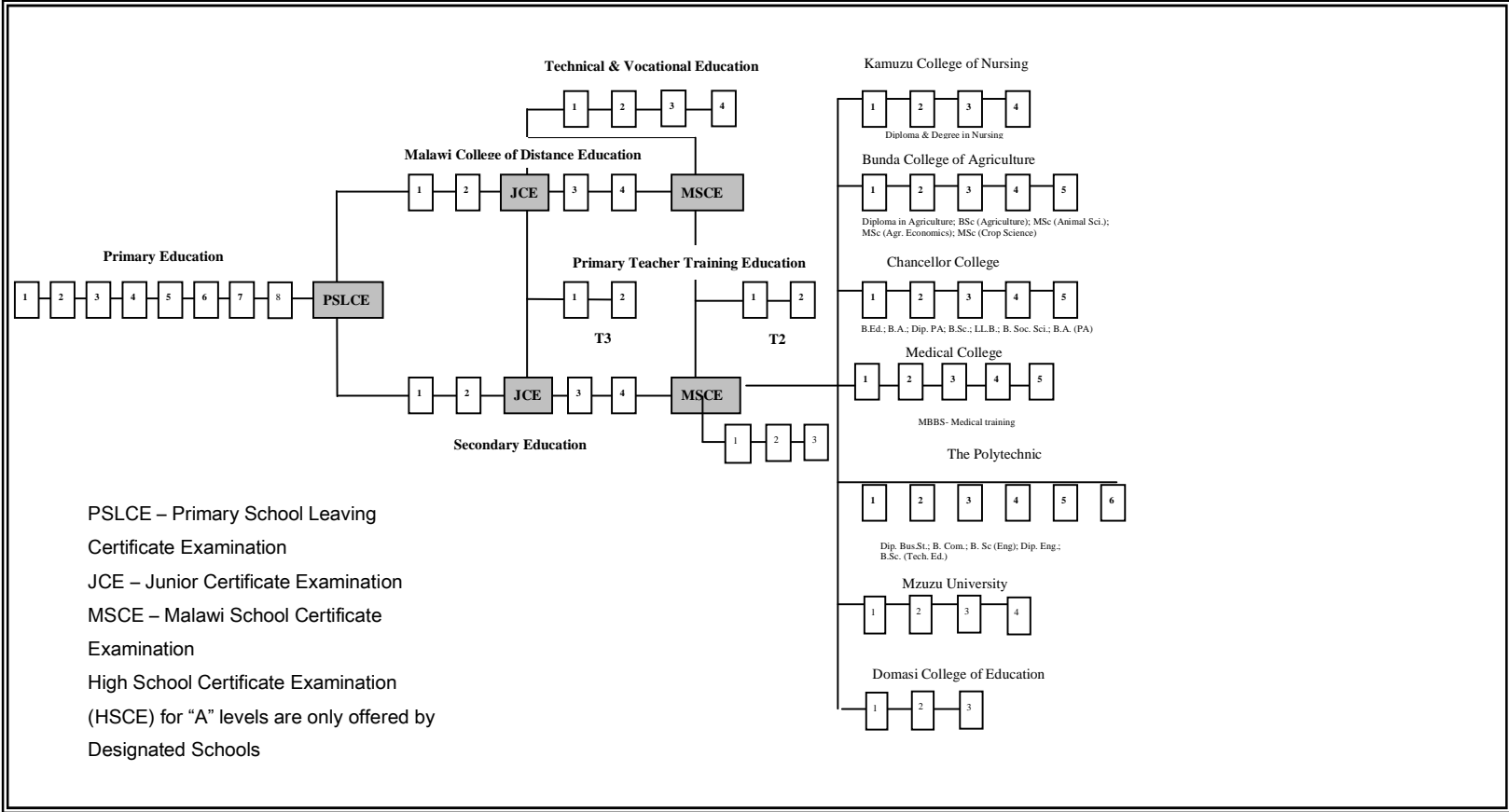

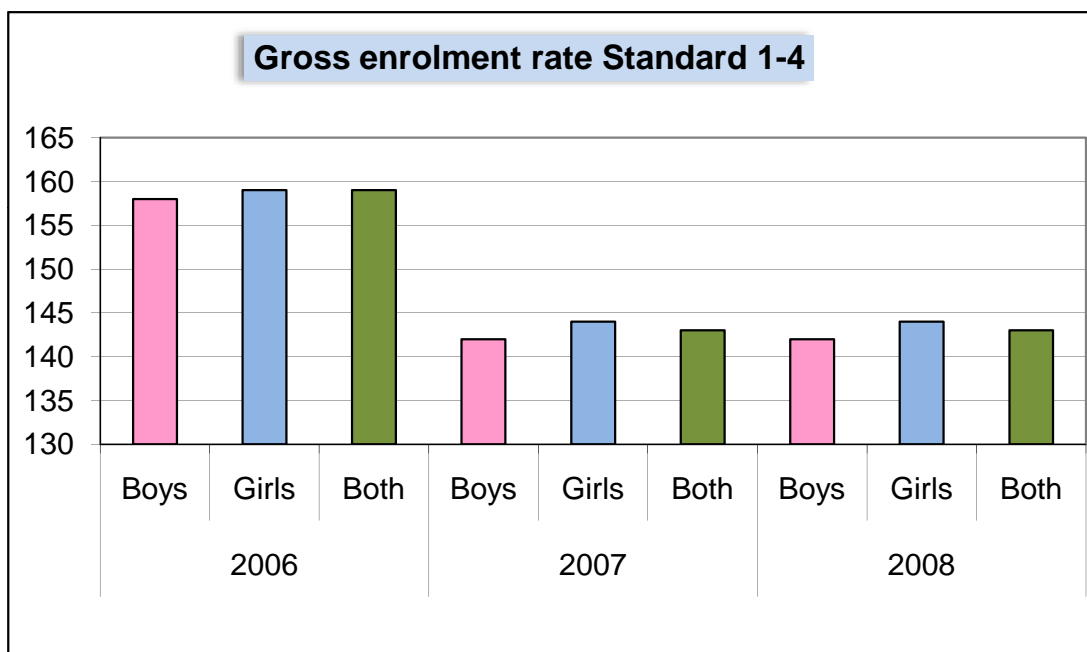

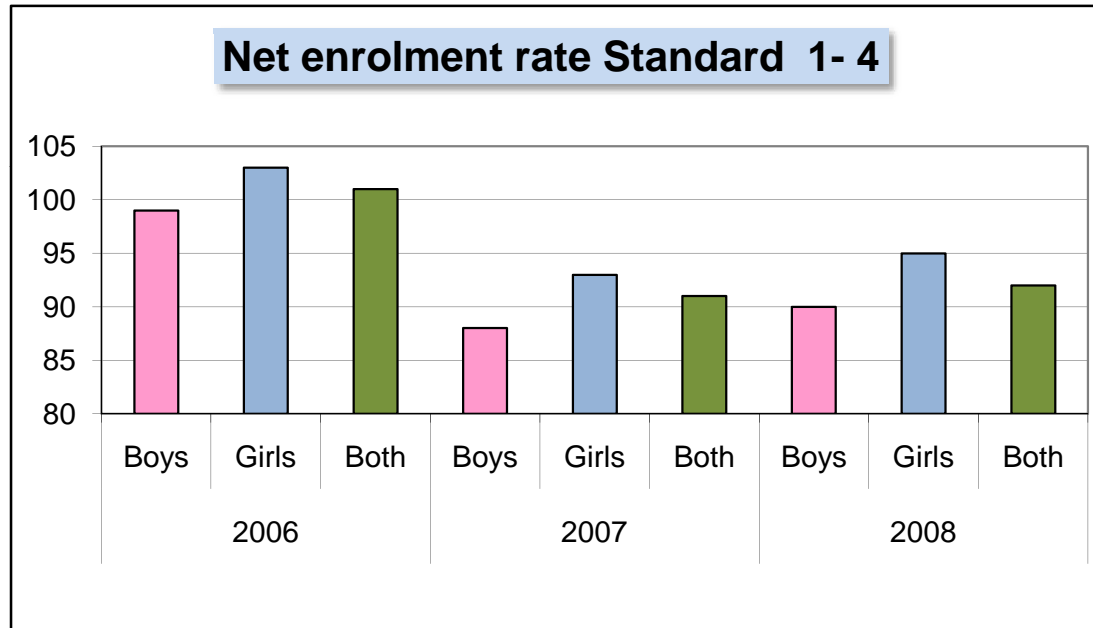

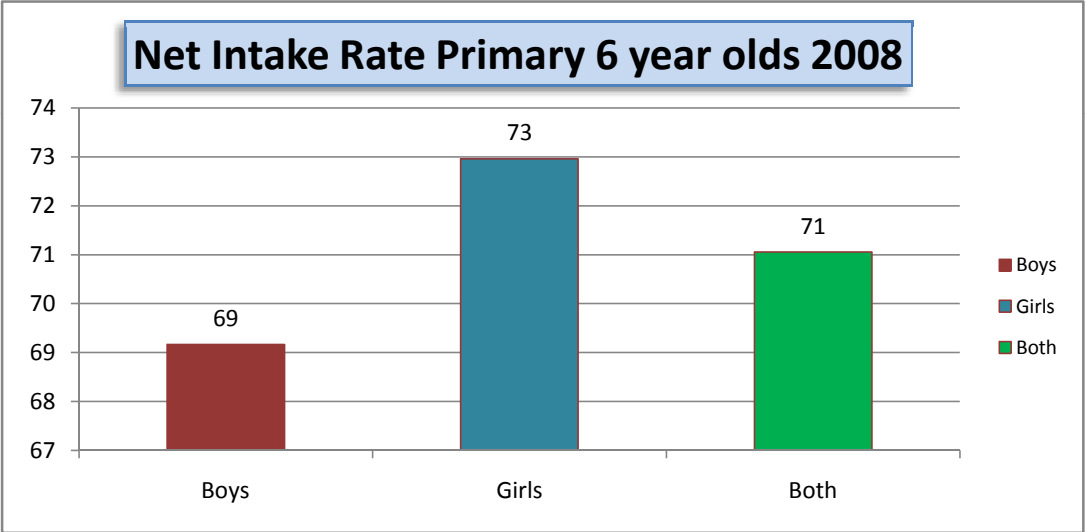

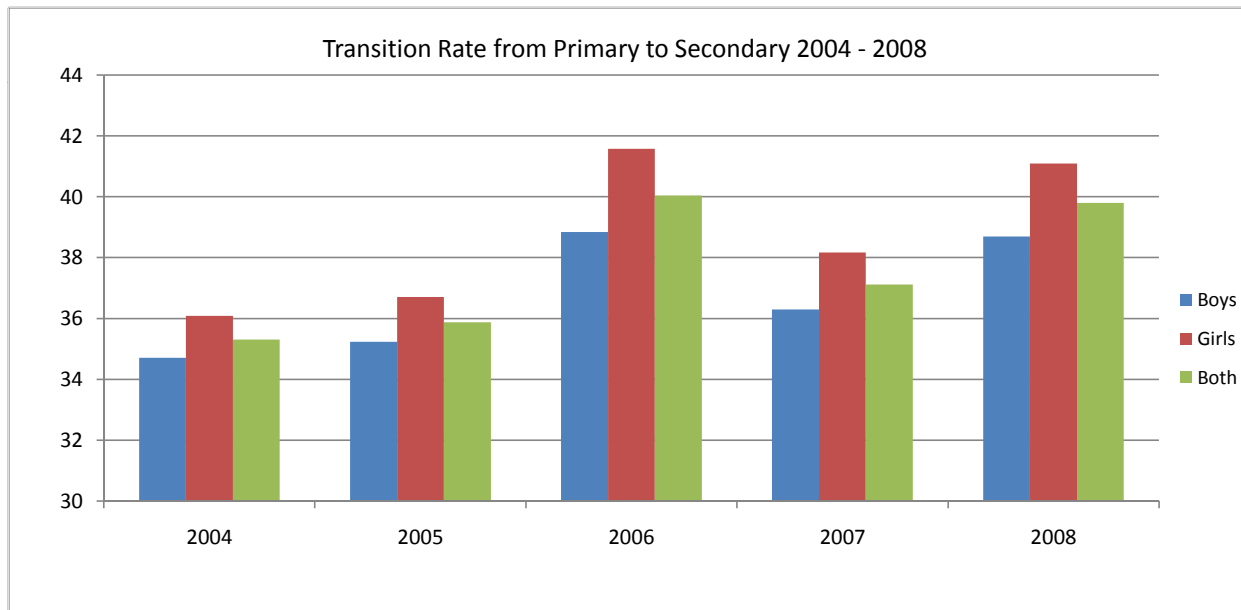

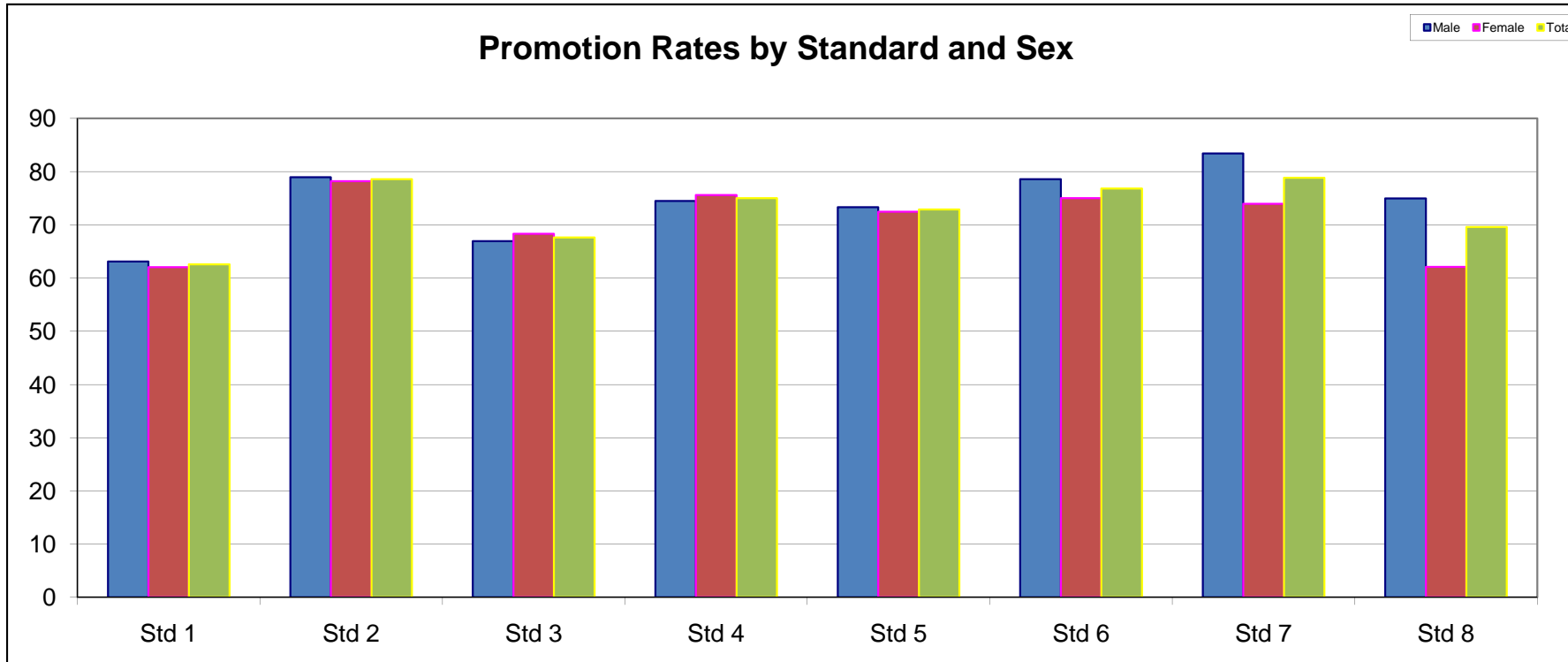

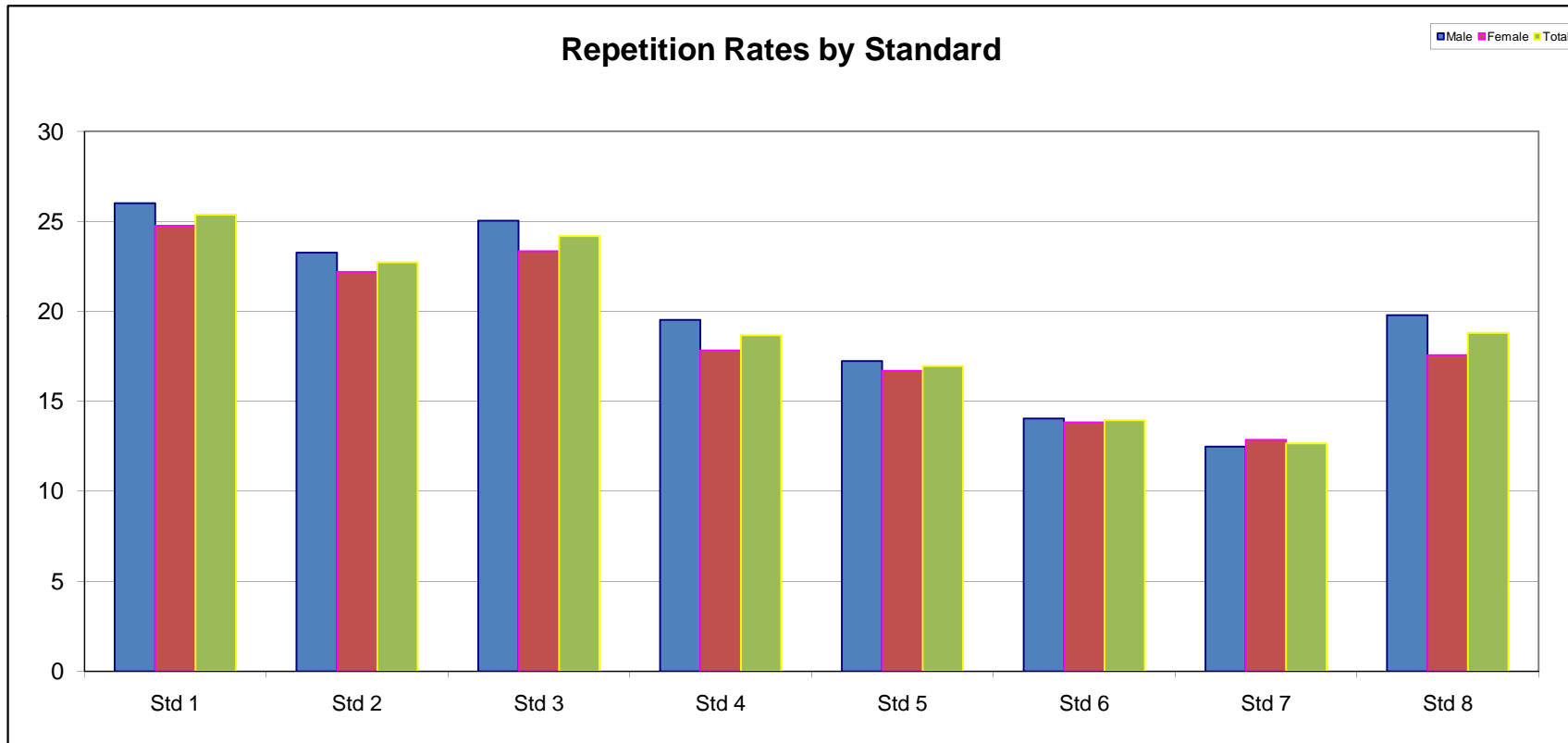

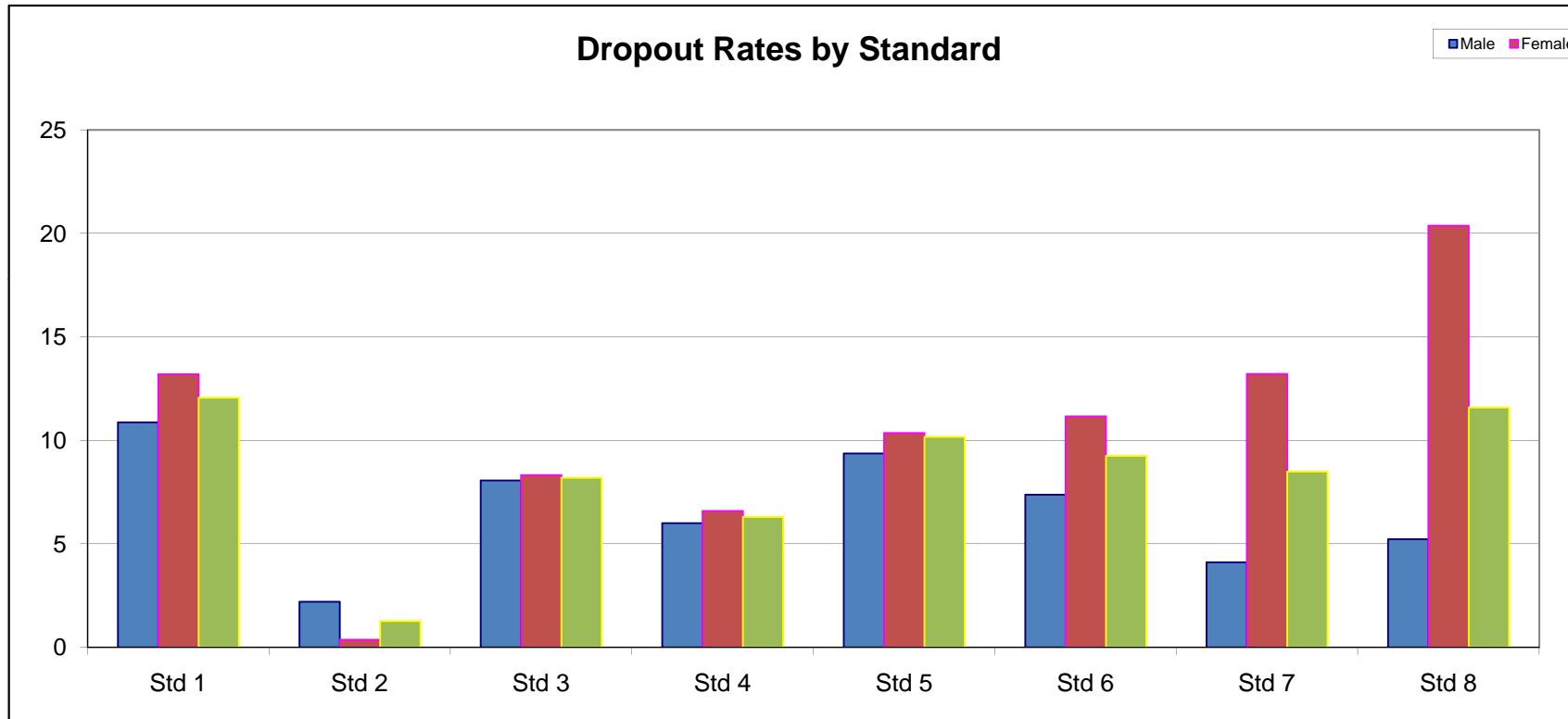

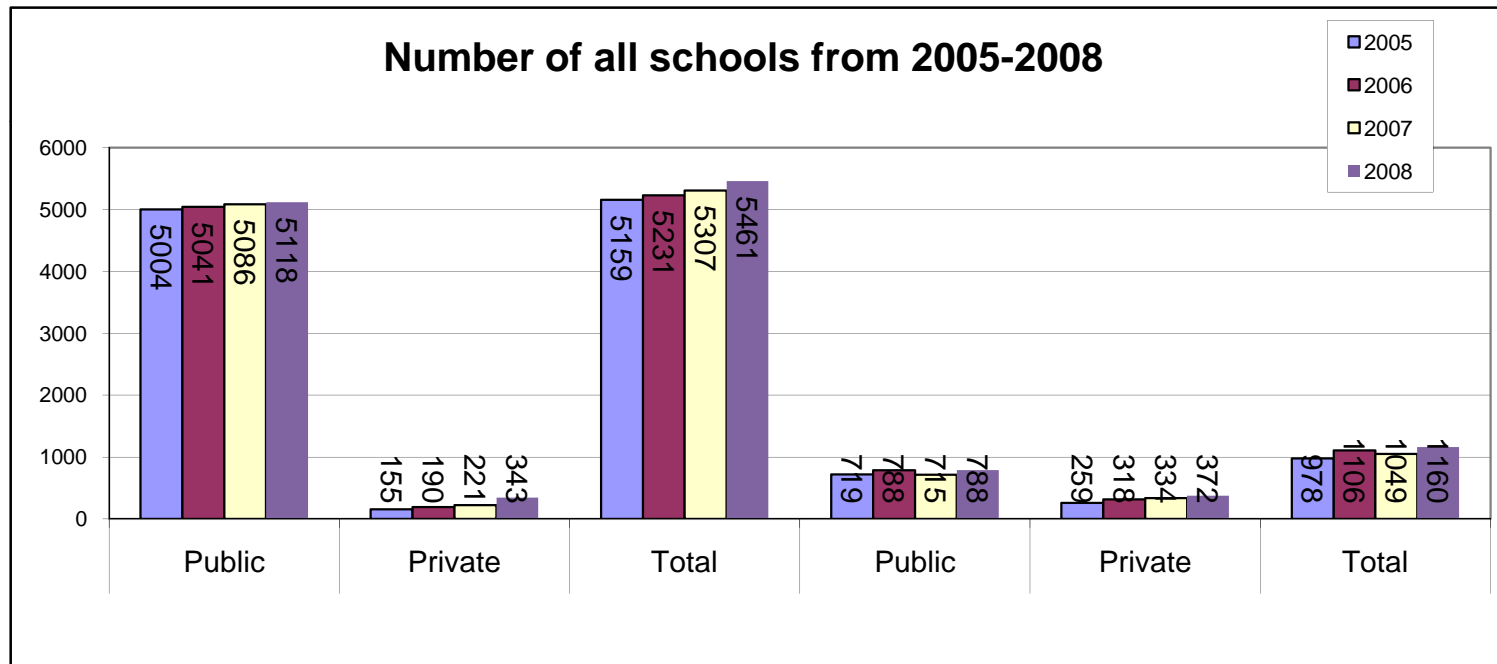

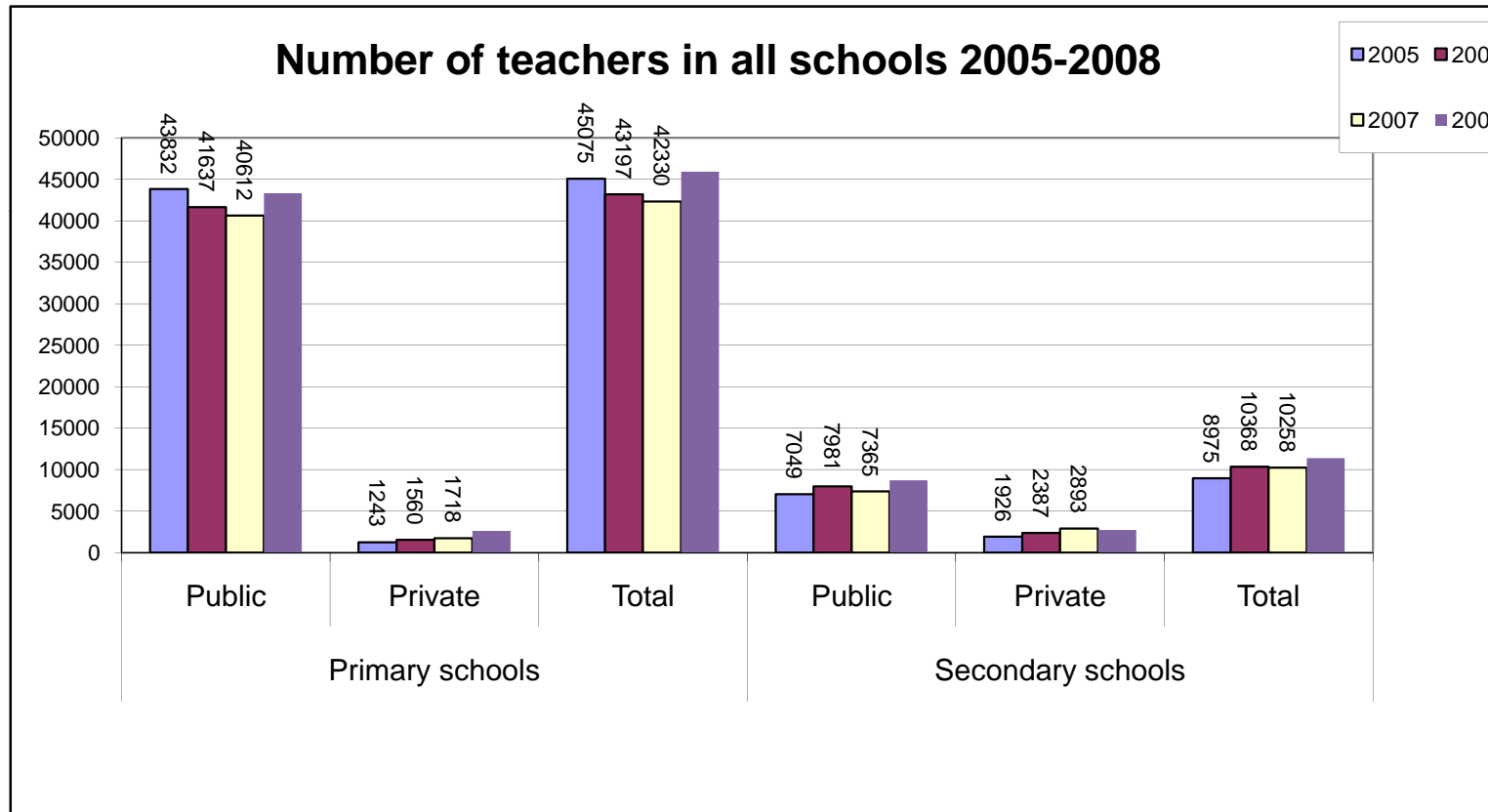

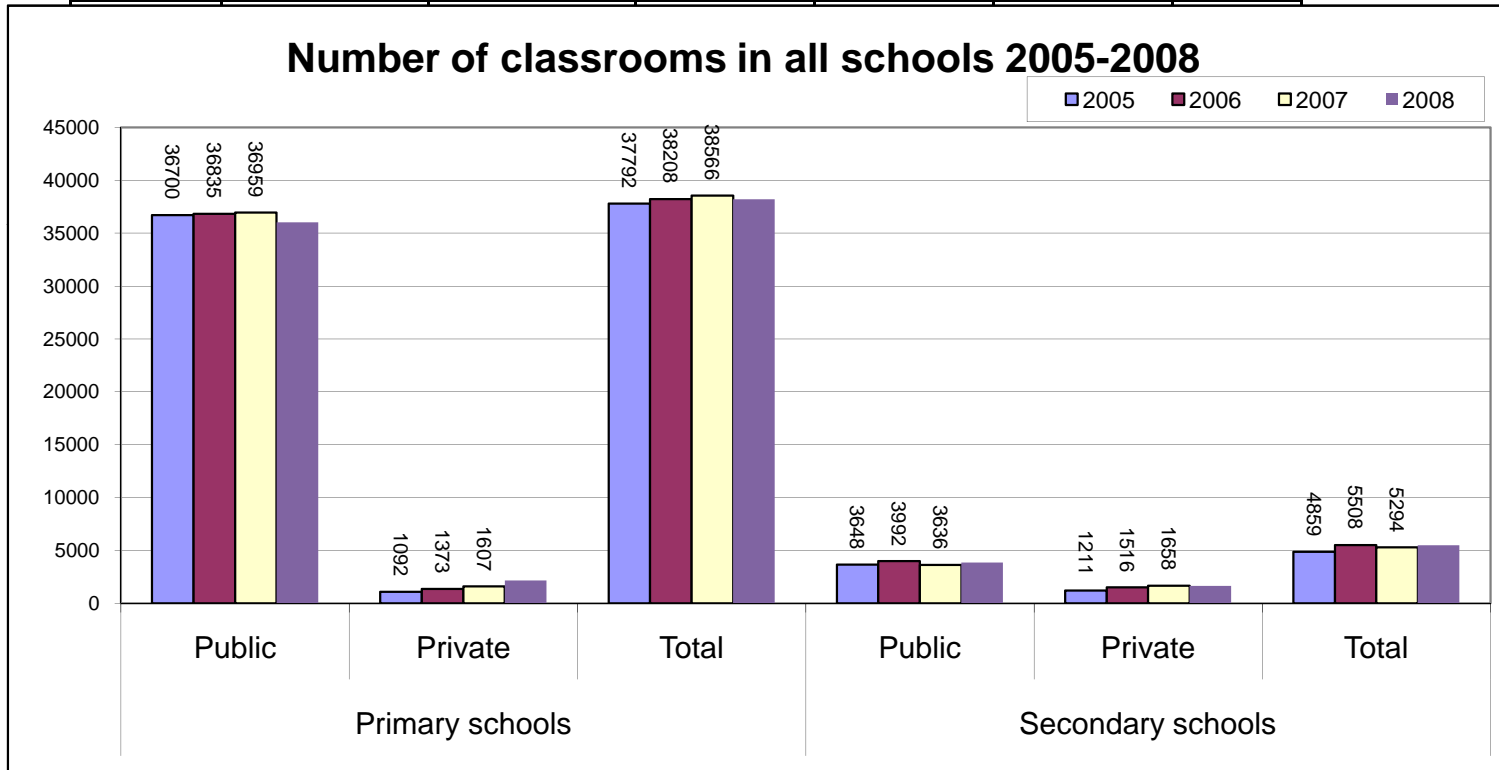

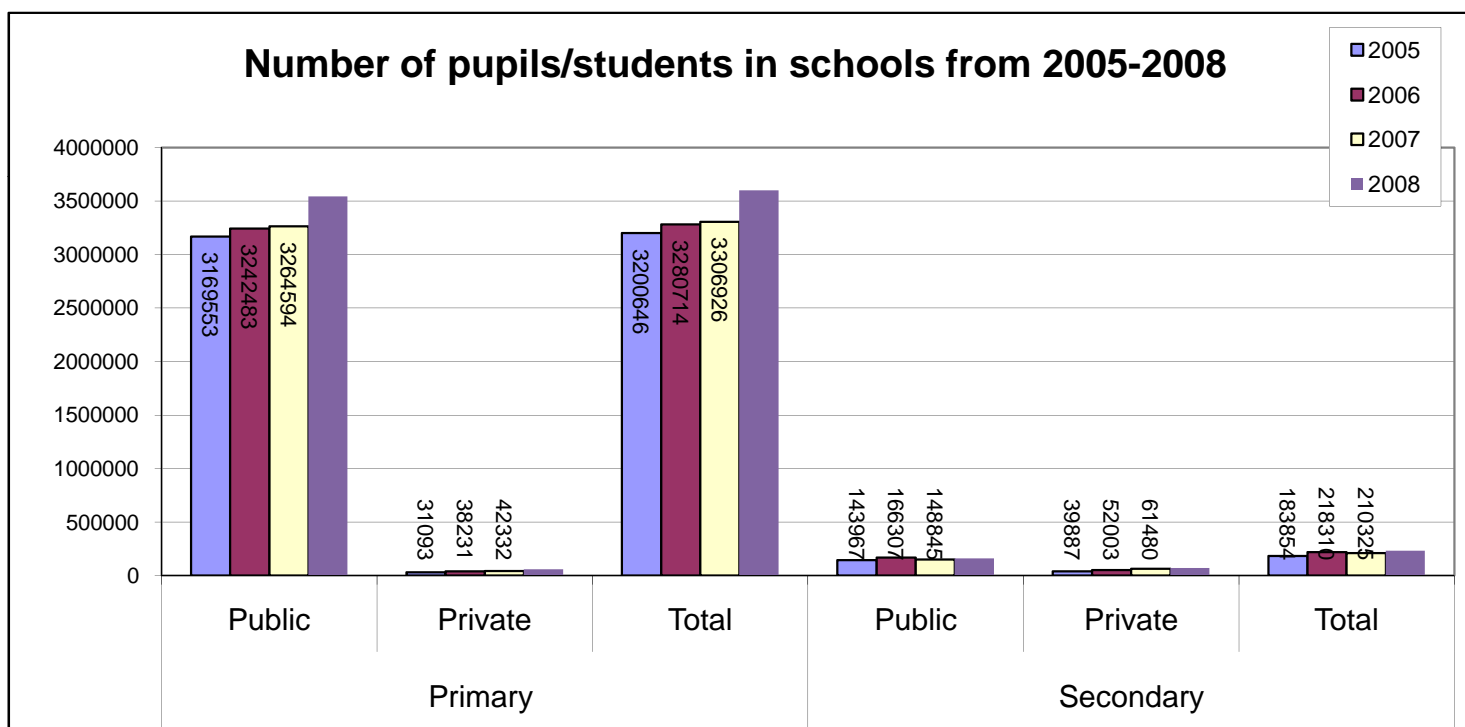


Table 1.10 - Pupils teacher ratio in all Primary schools 2005-2008

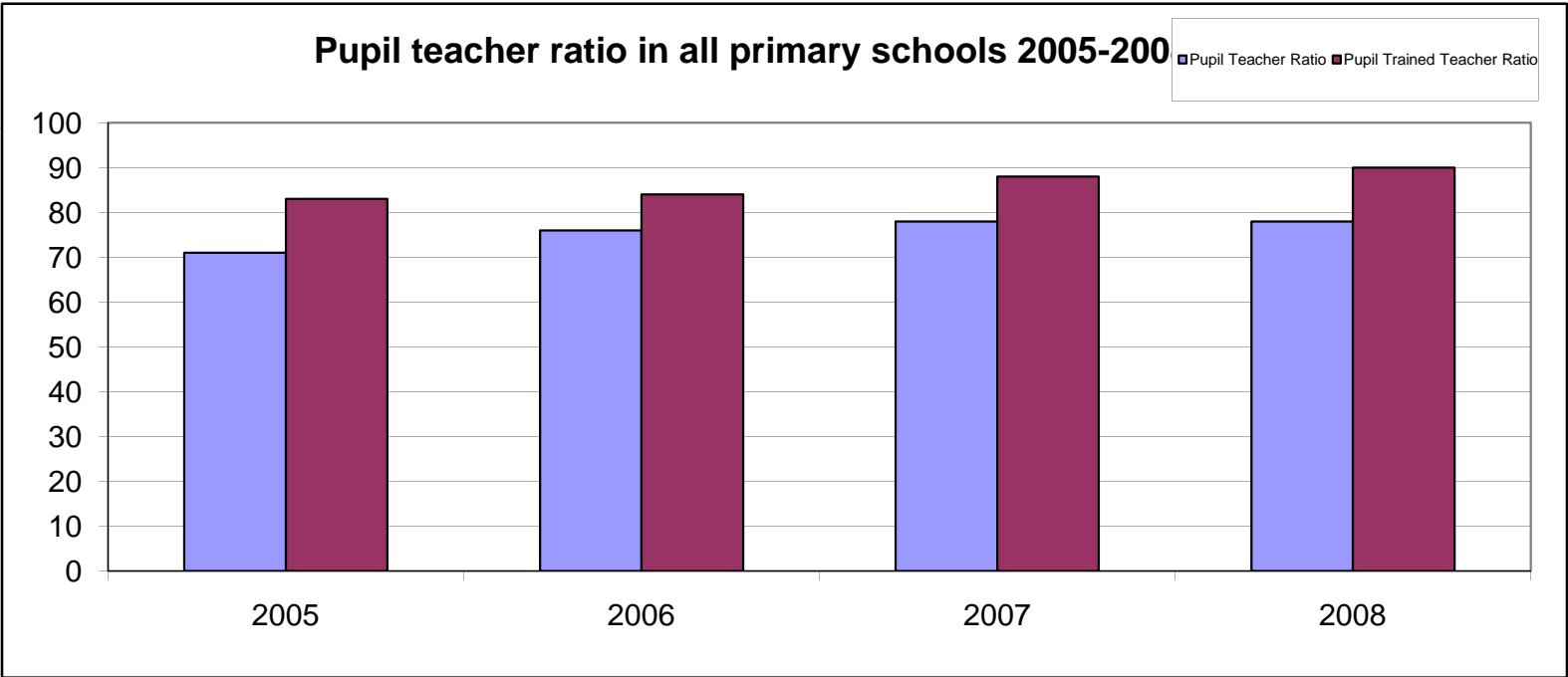


Table 1.11 - Pupil classroom ratio in all Primary schools 2005-2008

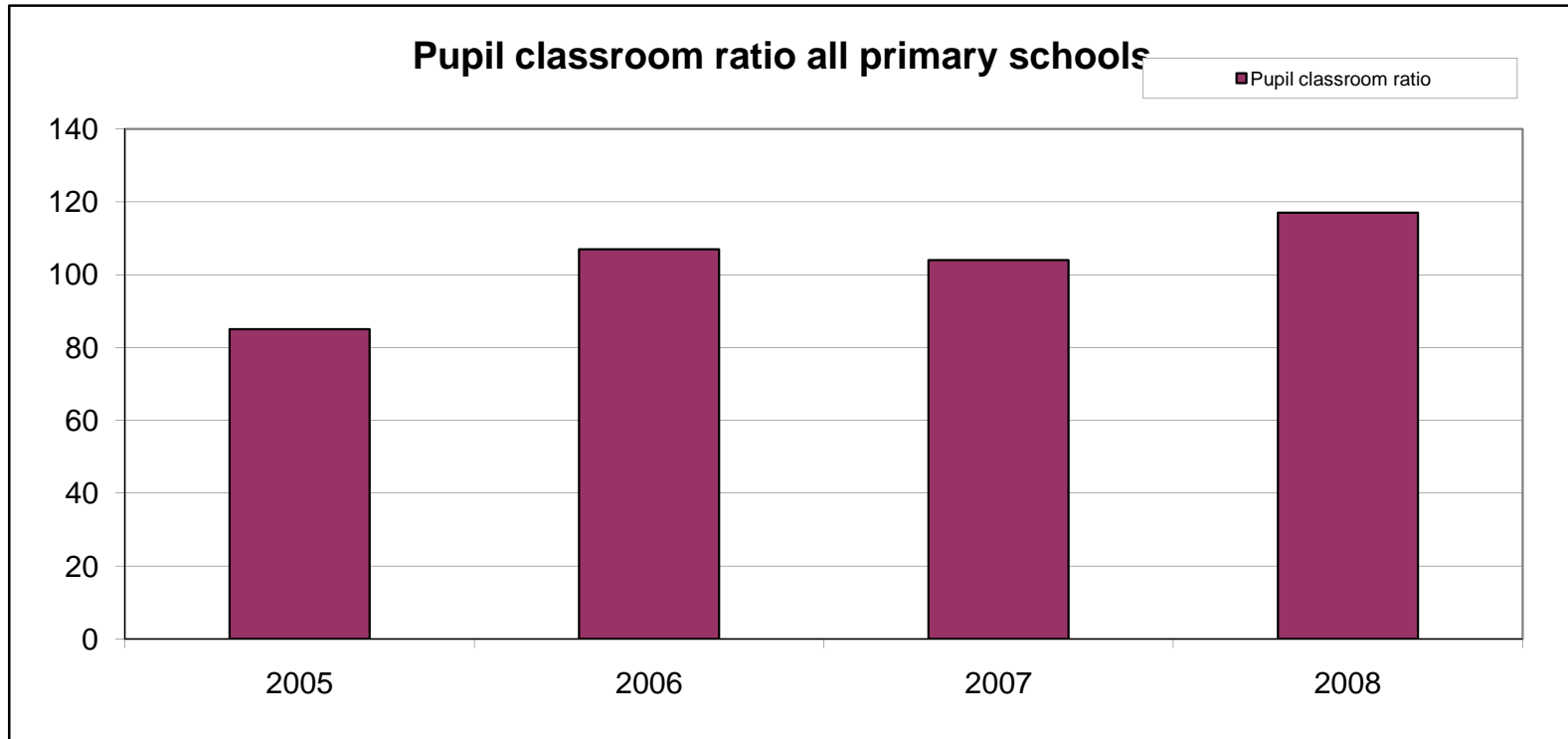

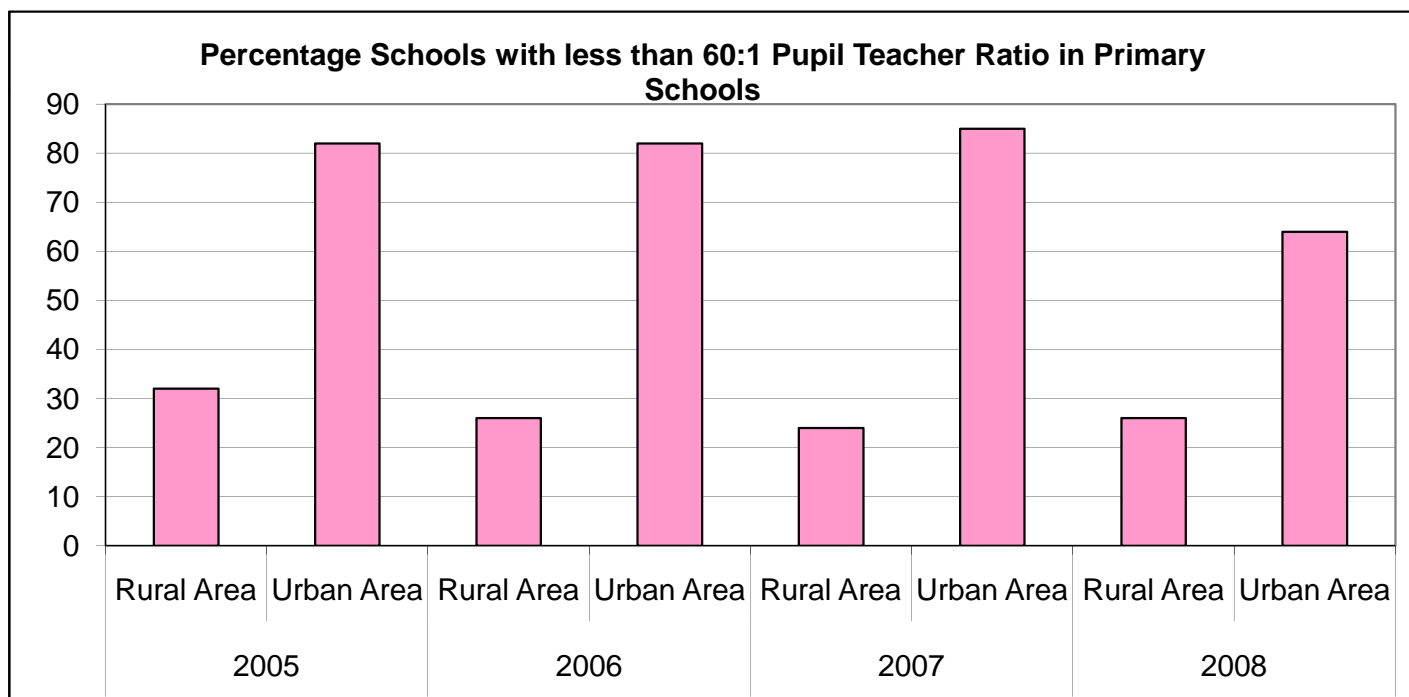

Graph 1.15 Pupil classroom ratio in all districts 2005-2008

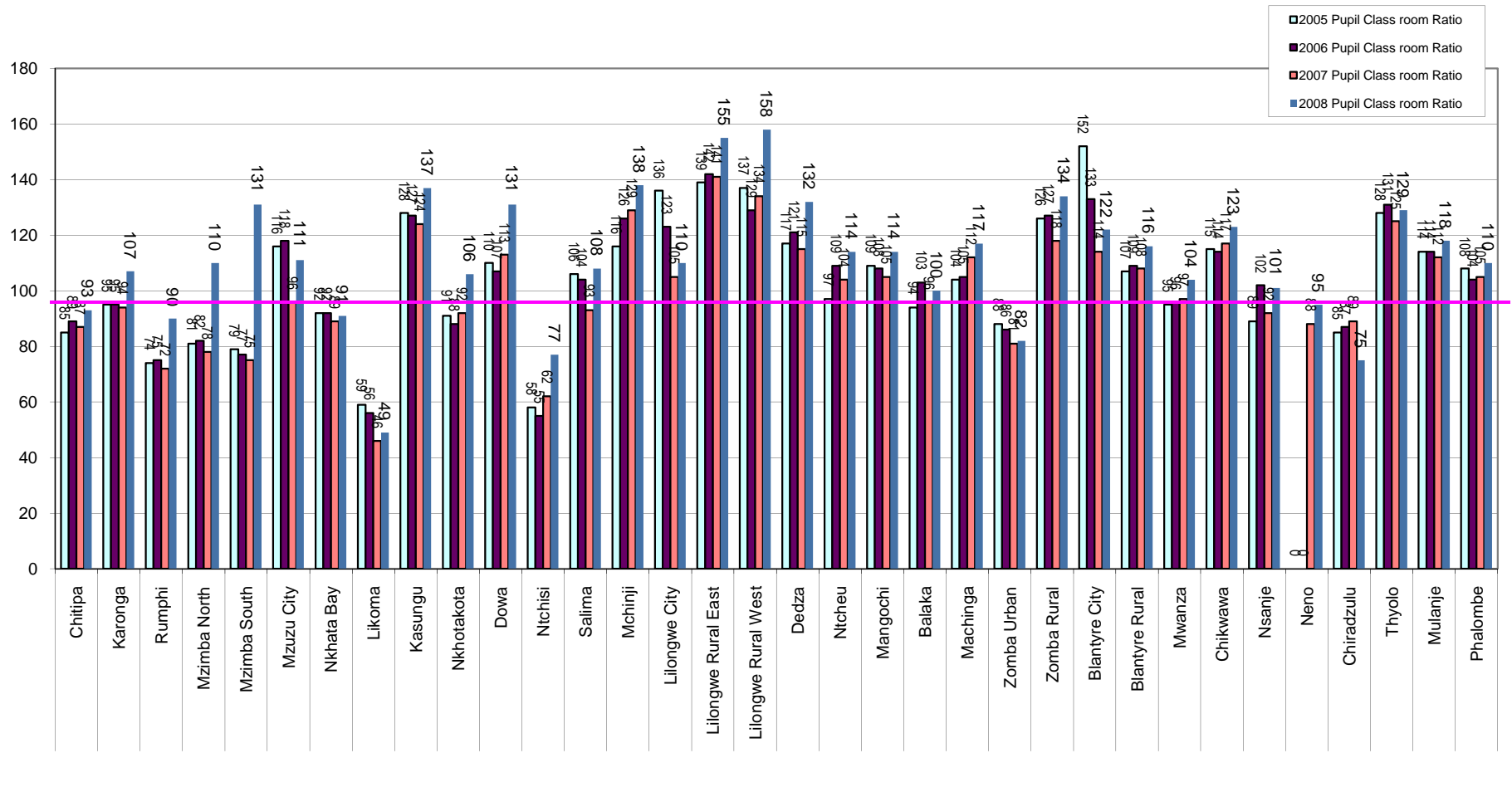
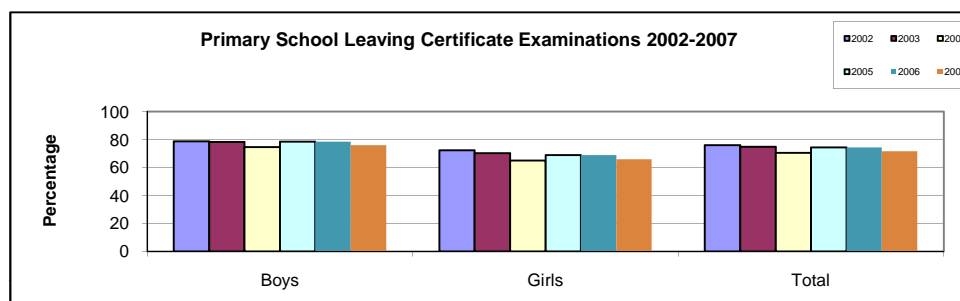

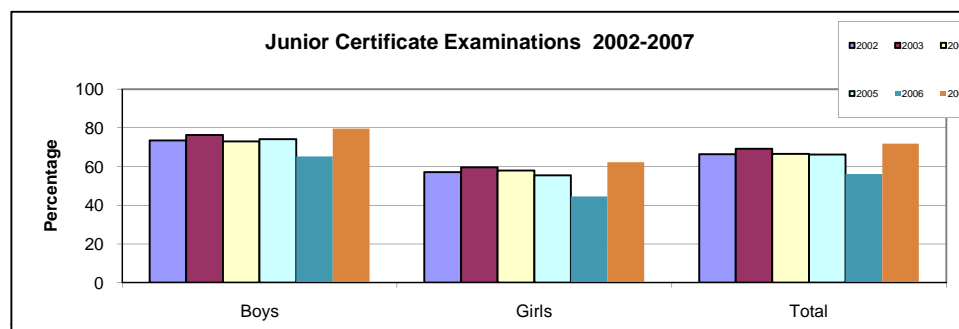

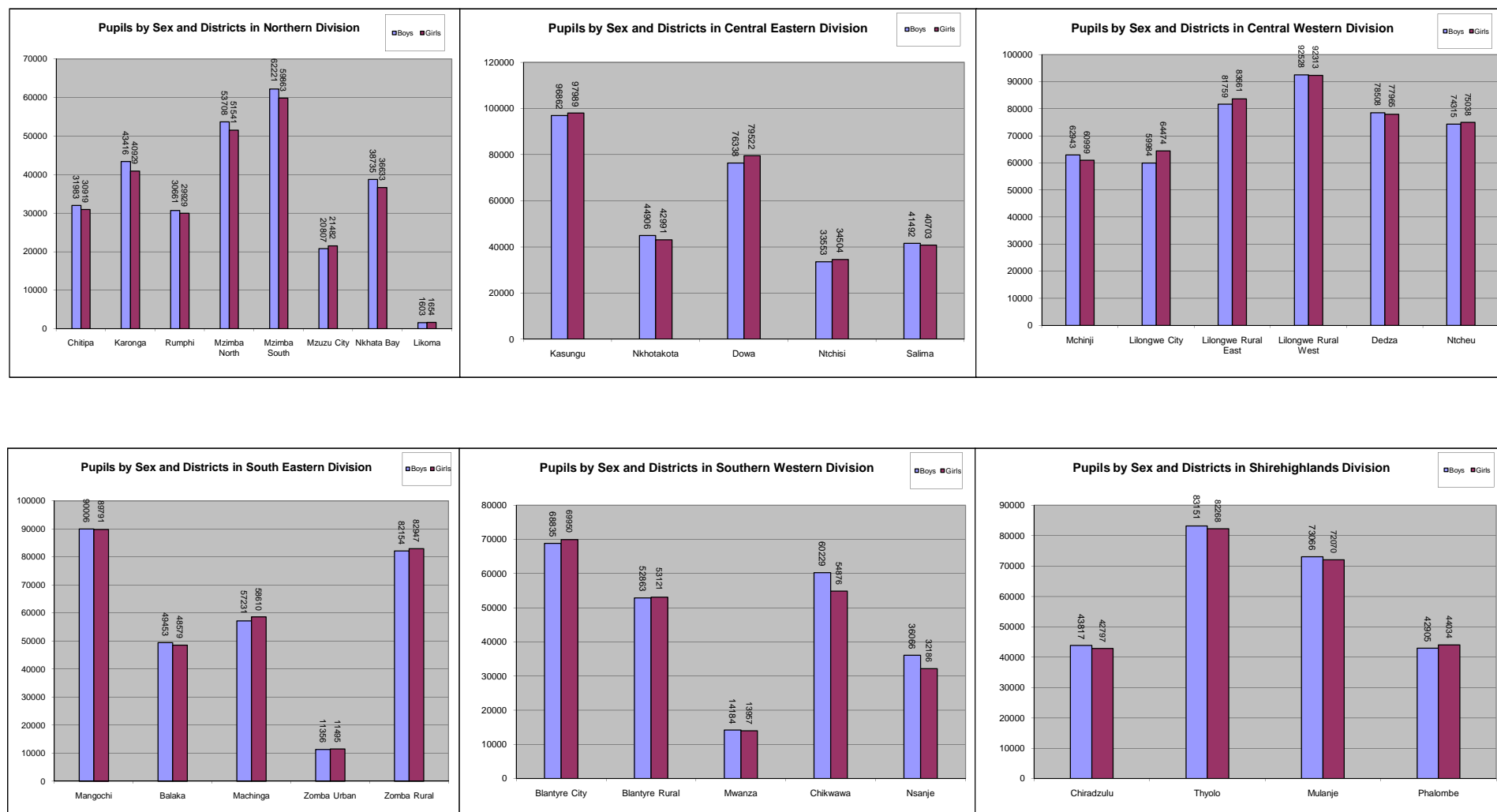

Graph - 2.2c Pupil Teacher and Pupil Classroom Ratios by Districts

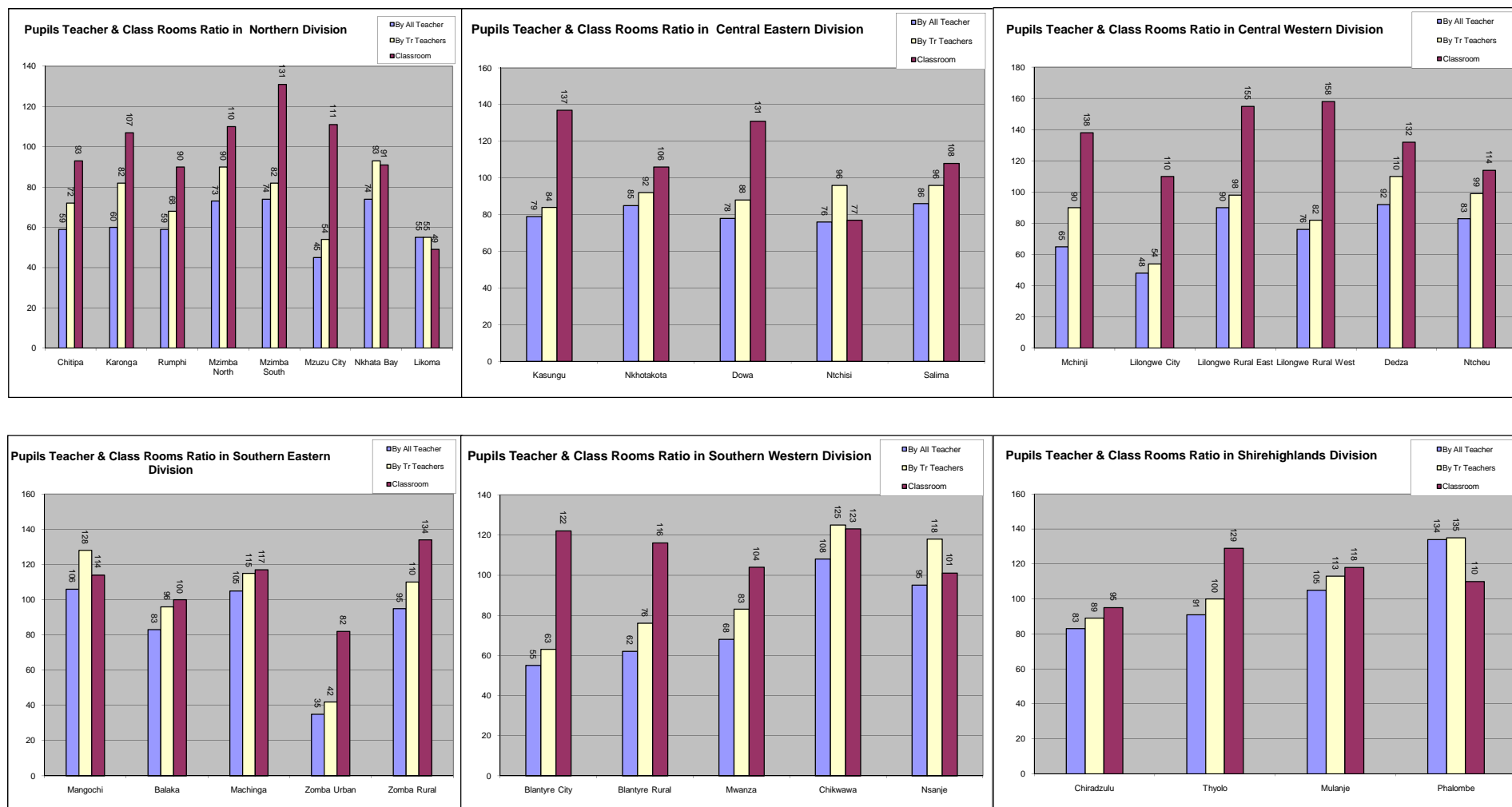

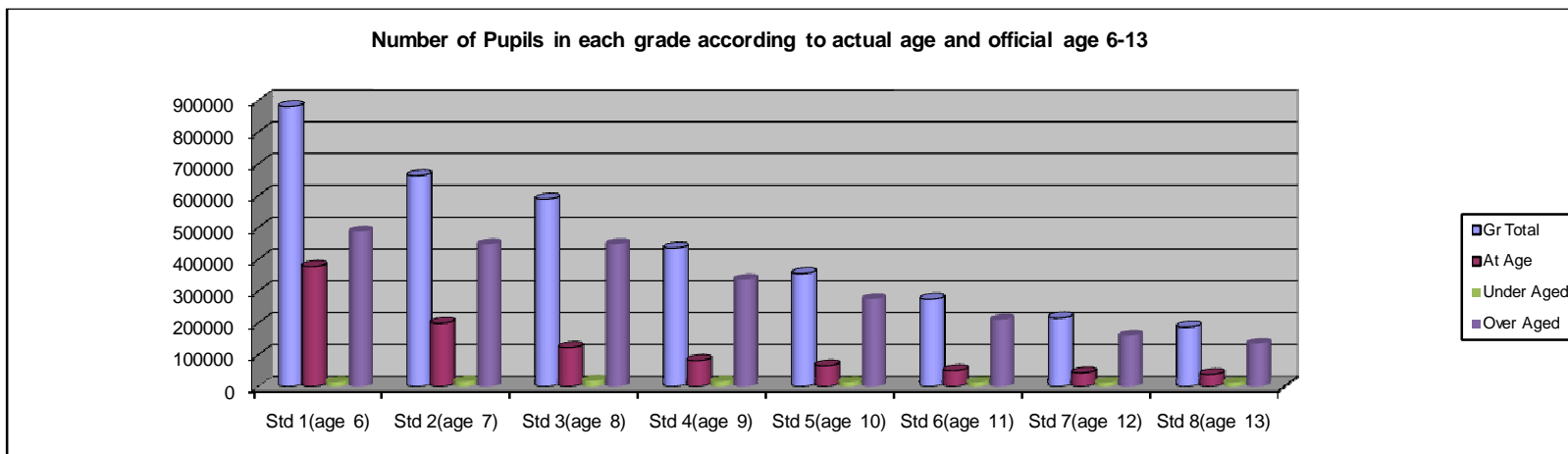

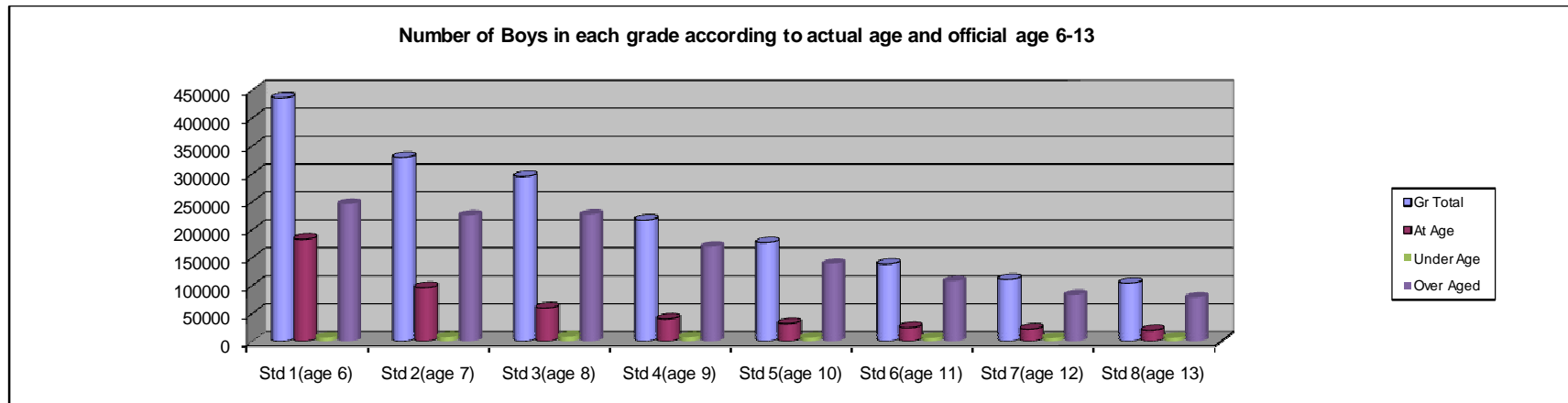

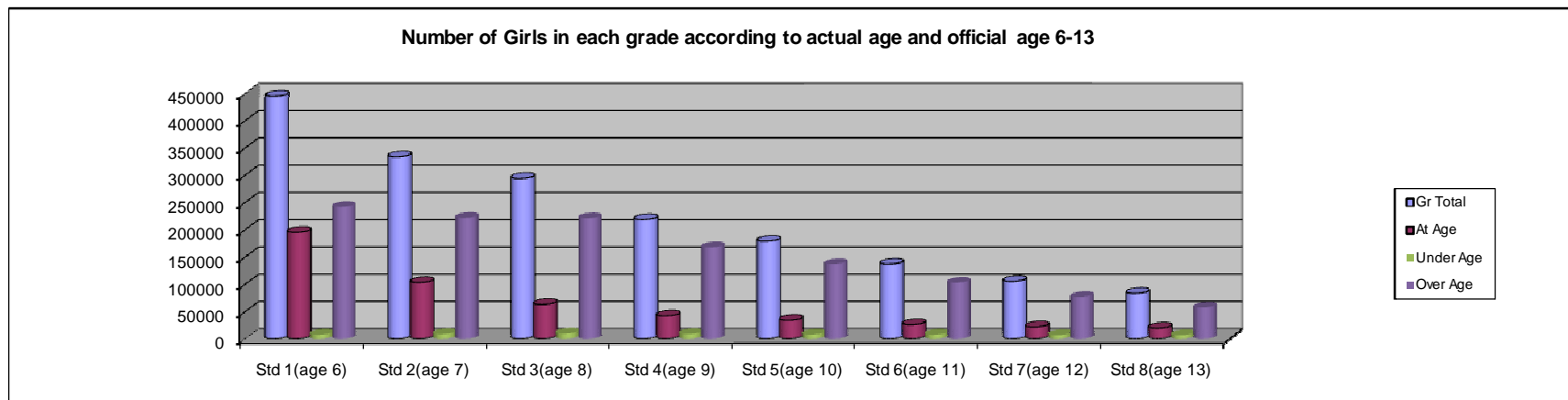

Graph 2.7: New Entrants to Standard 1 by Age and Sex/Division

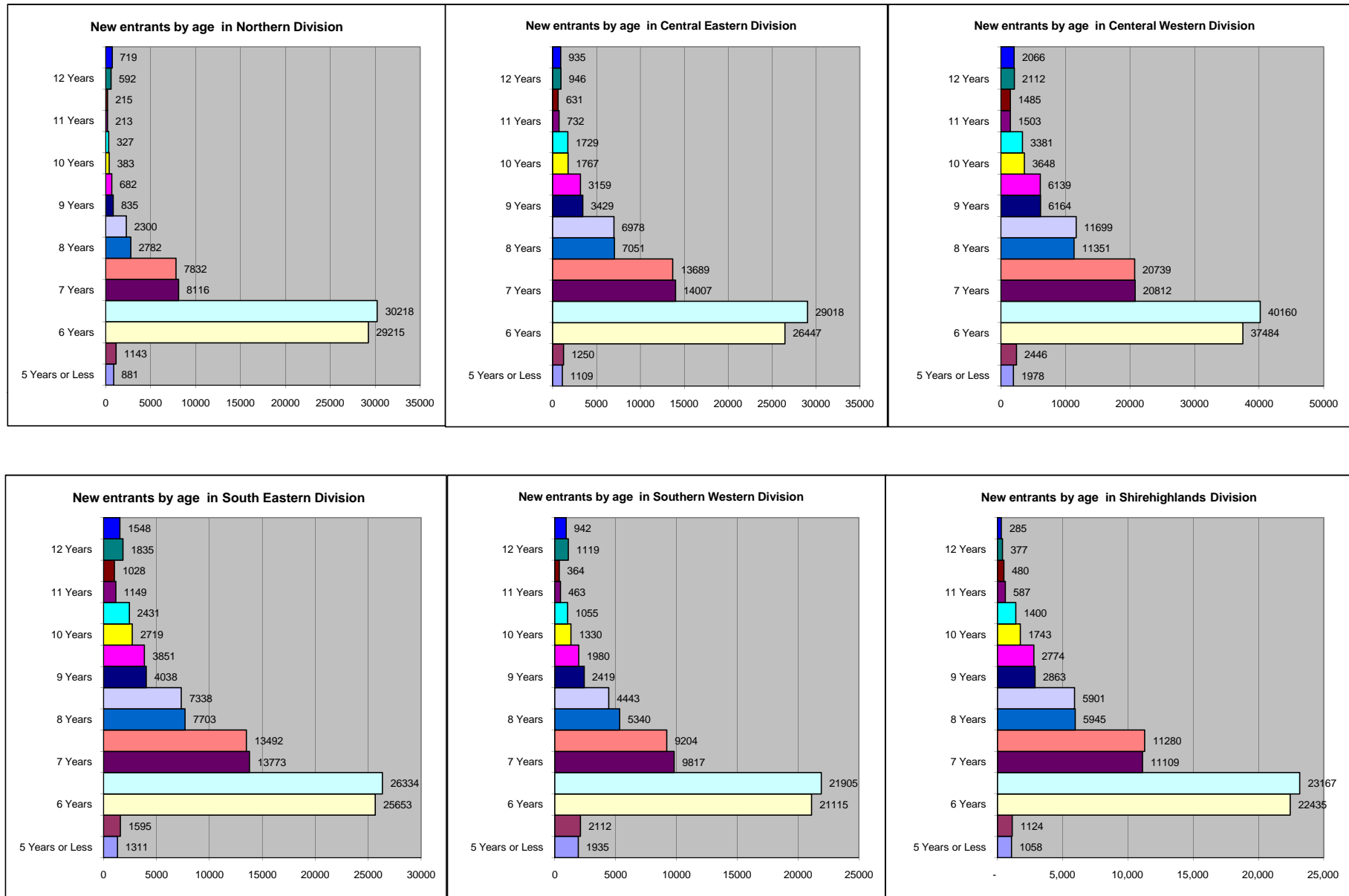

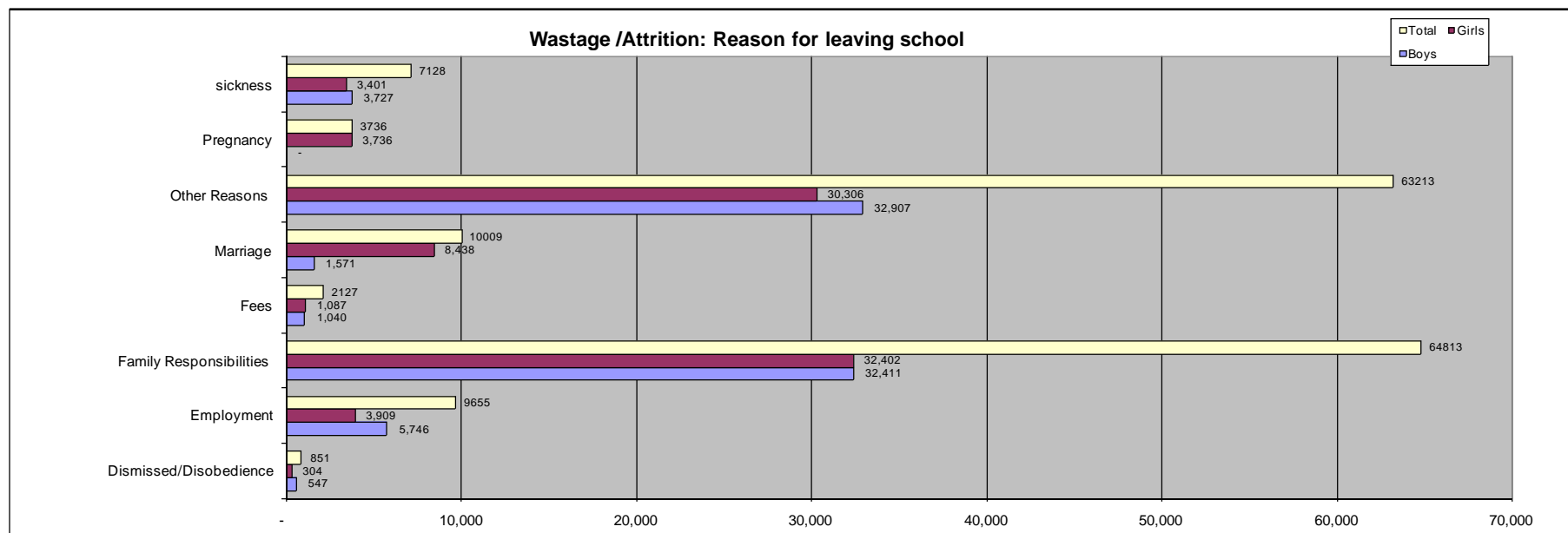


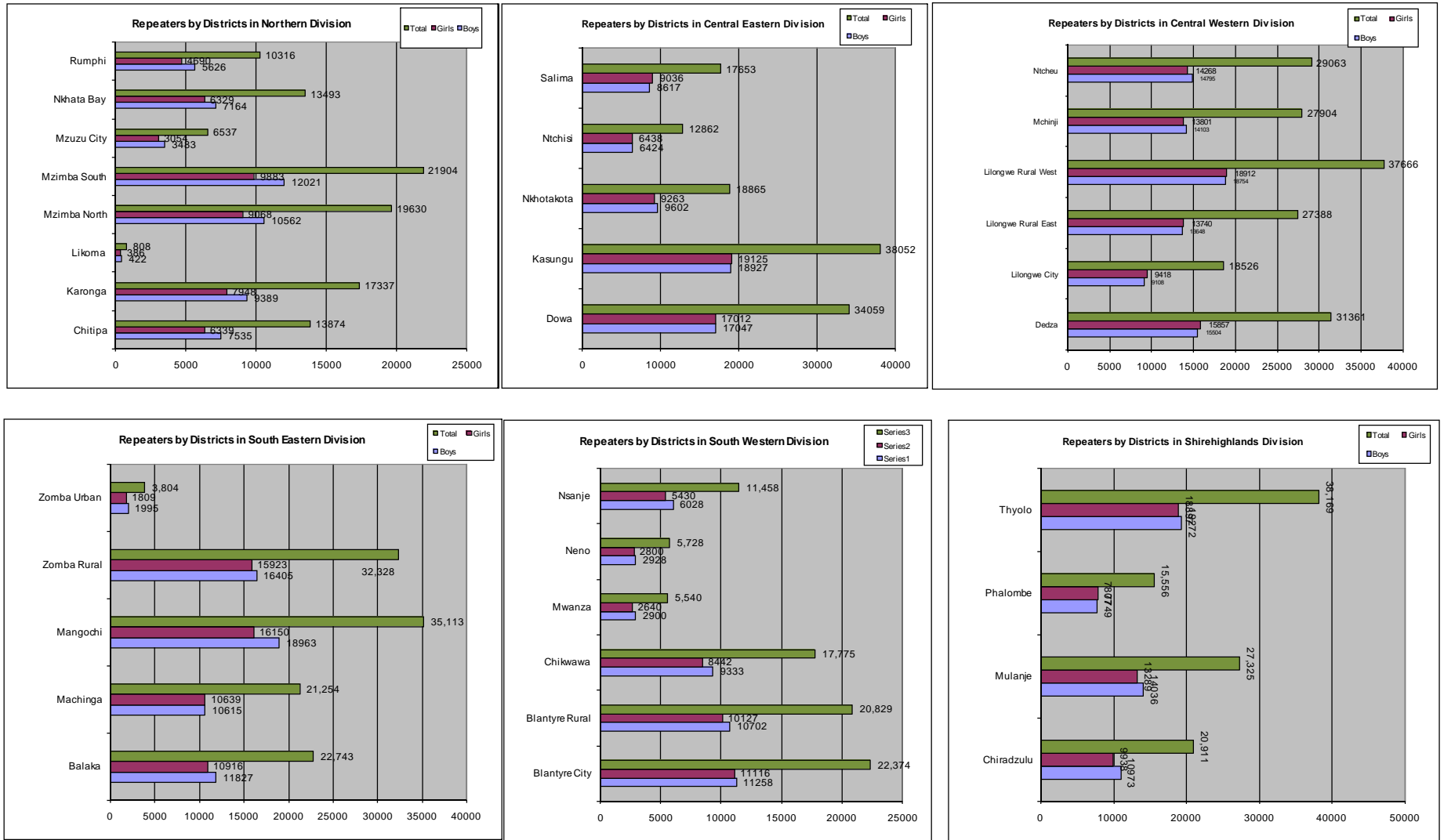

Graph 2.10: Number of Pupils transferred into and out of schools by Districts 2008

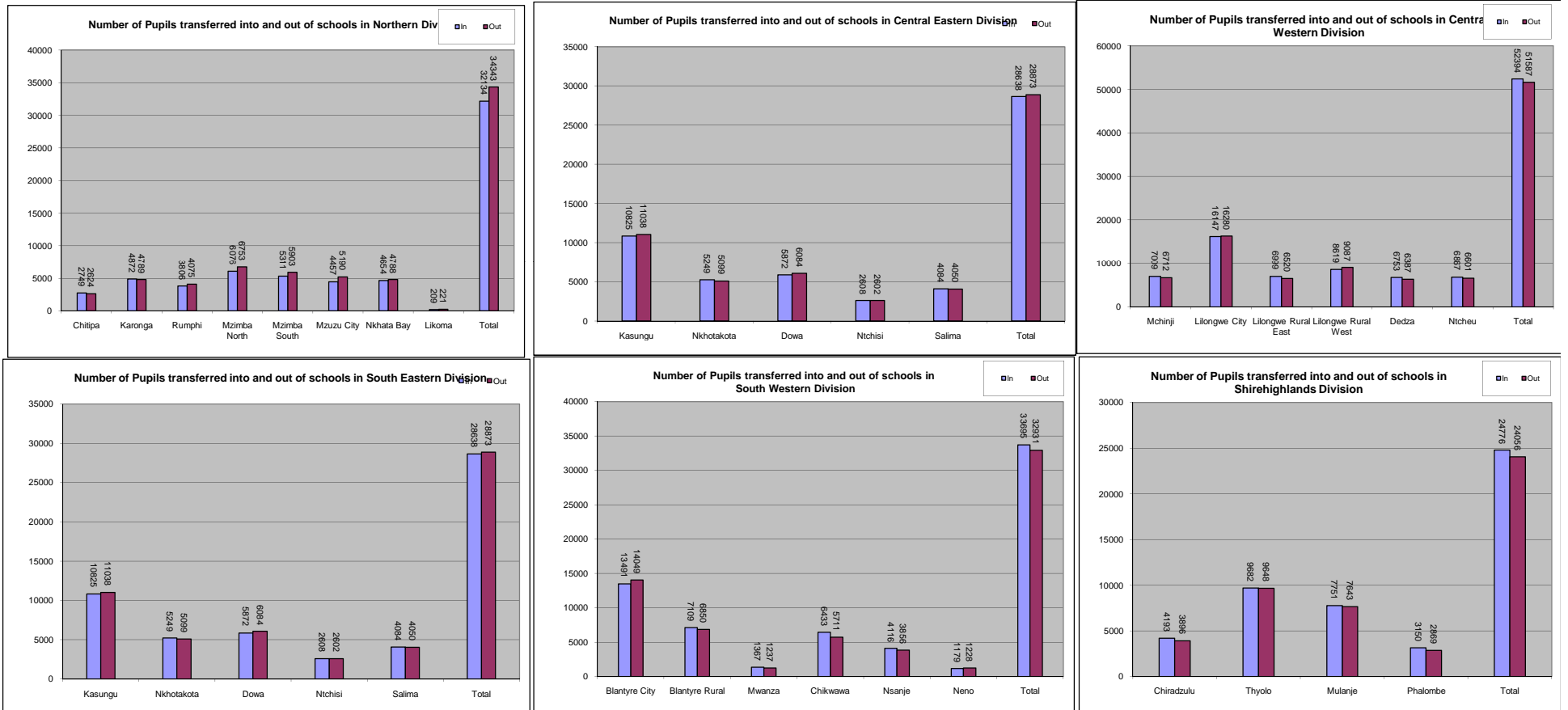

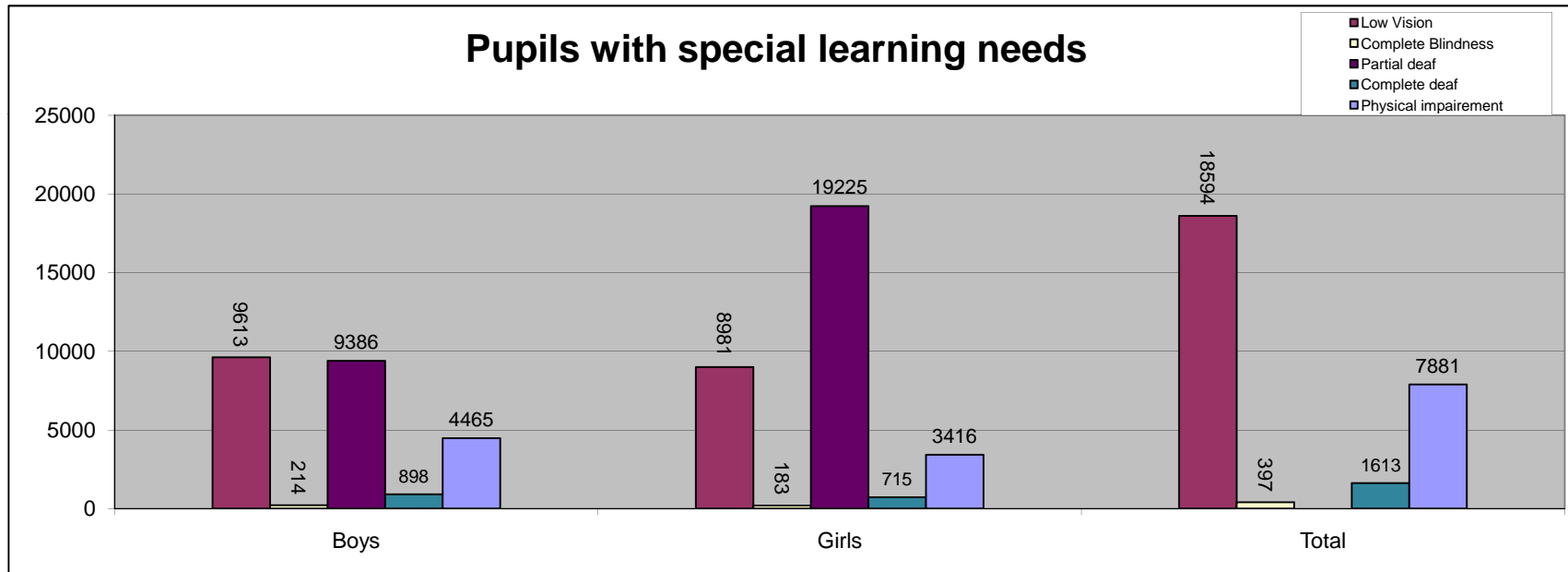

Graph 2.14a Number of Primary Schools, according to main Water Source and Electricity source, 2008

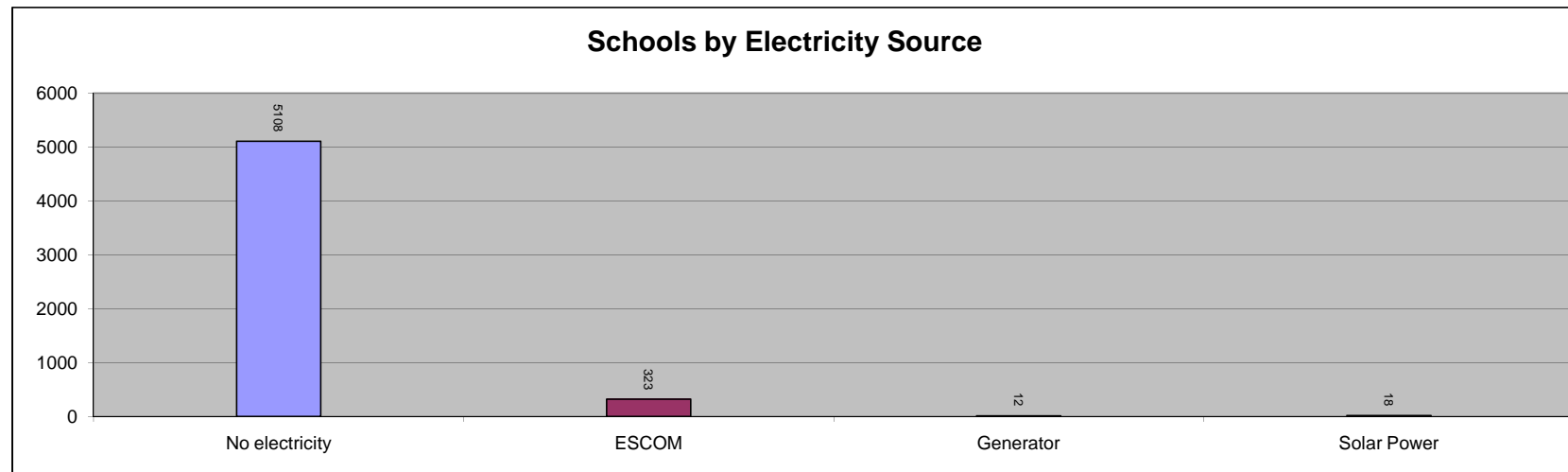
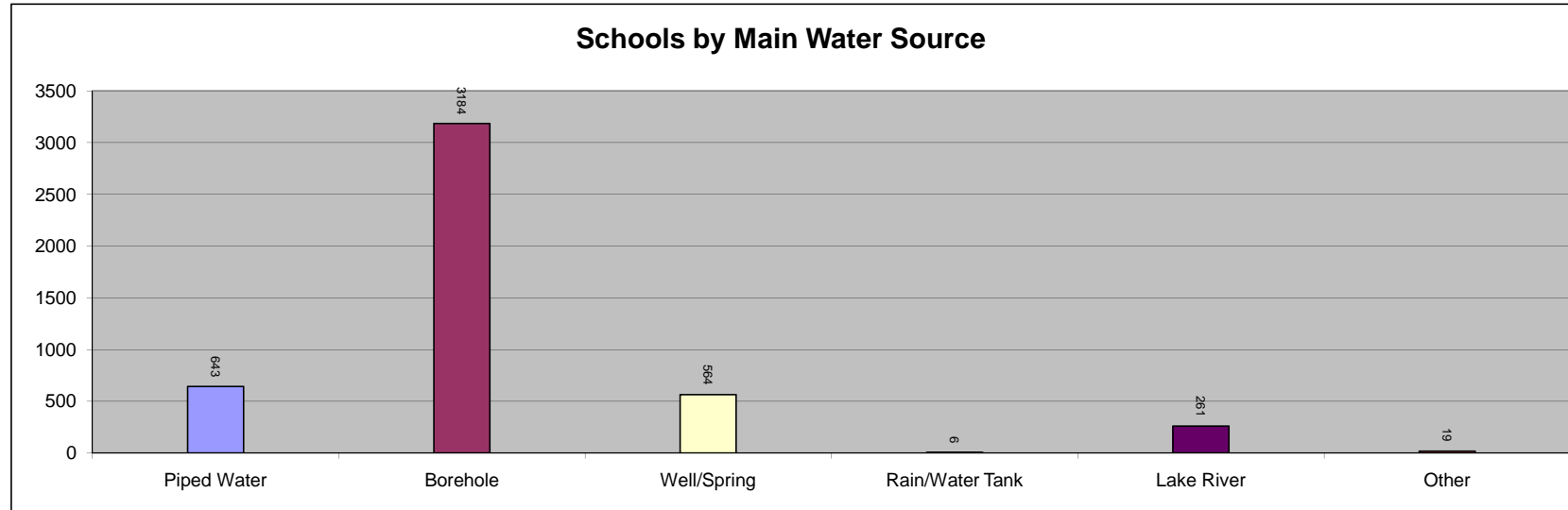

Graph 3.2c Pupils Teacher and Pupils Classrooms Ratio by Districts

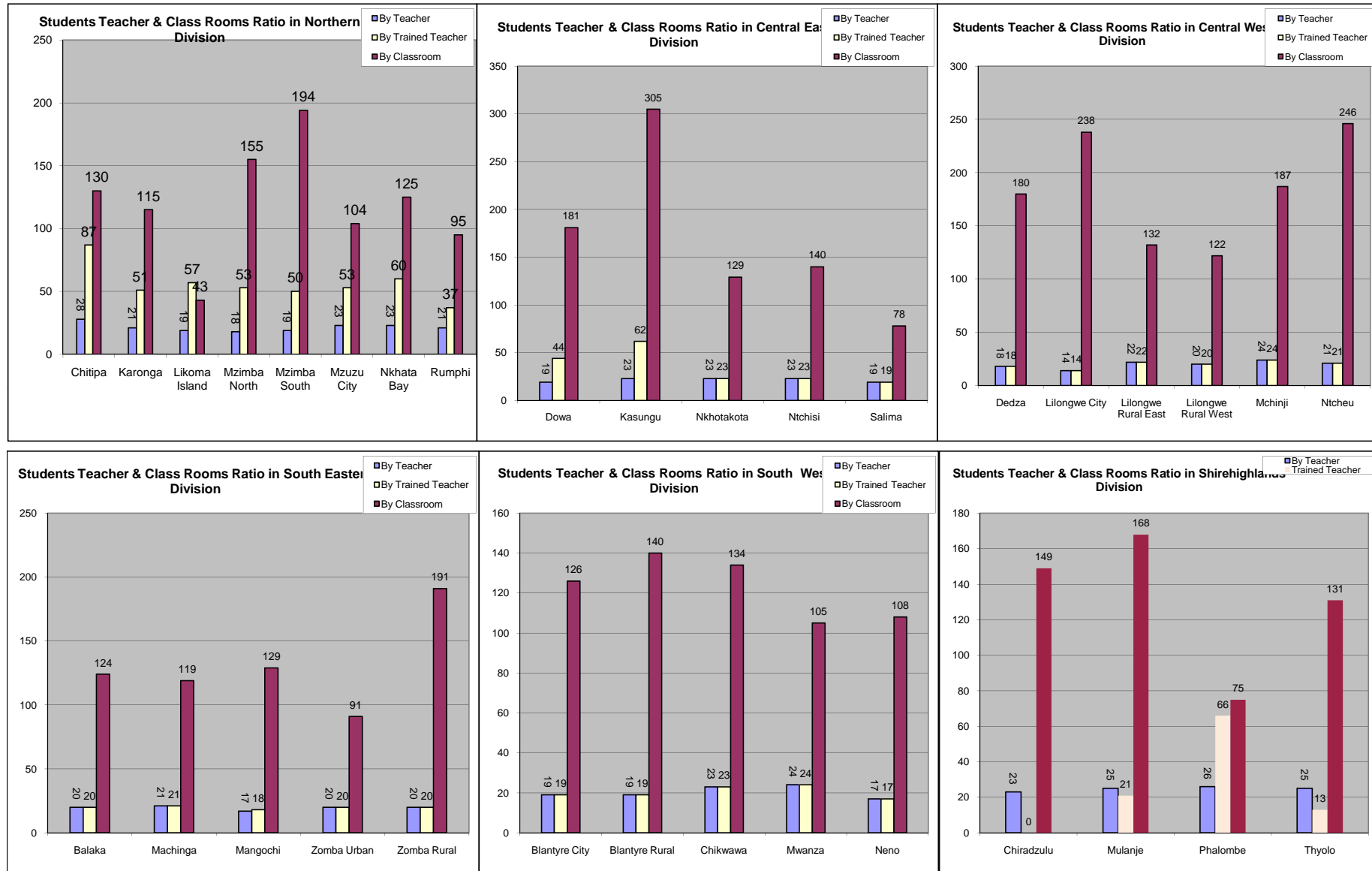

Graph 3.4: Number of Repeaters by Division

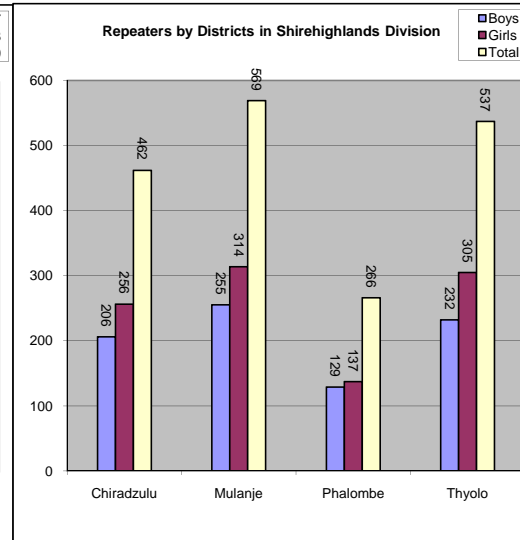
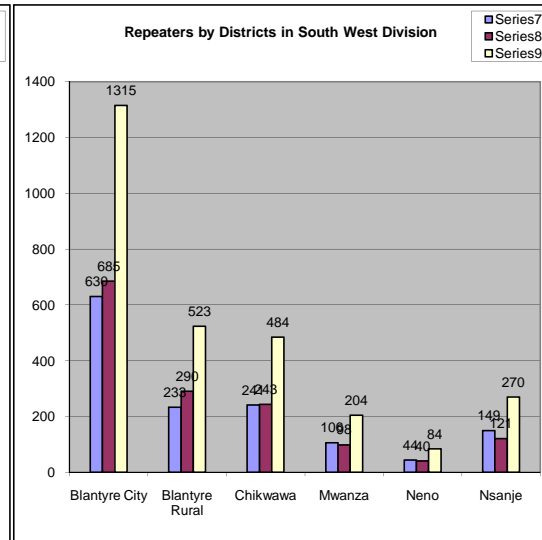
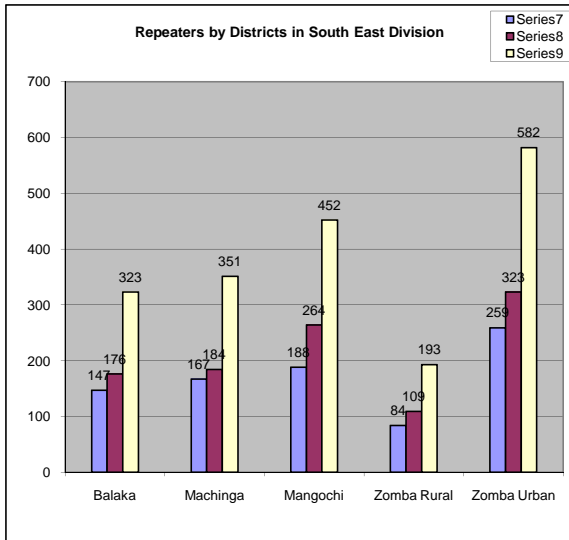
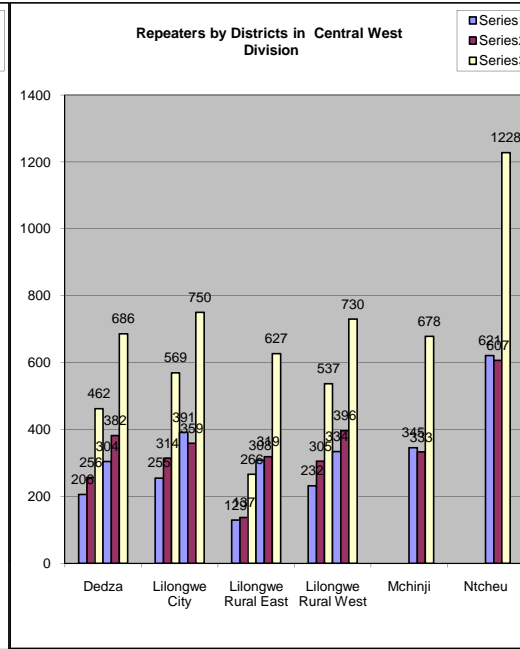
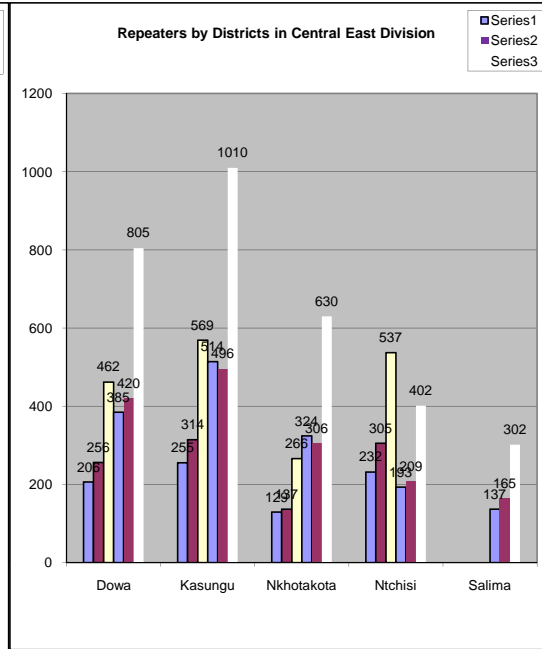
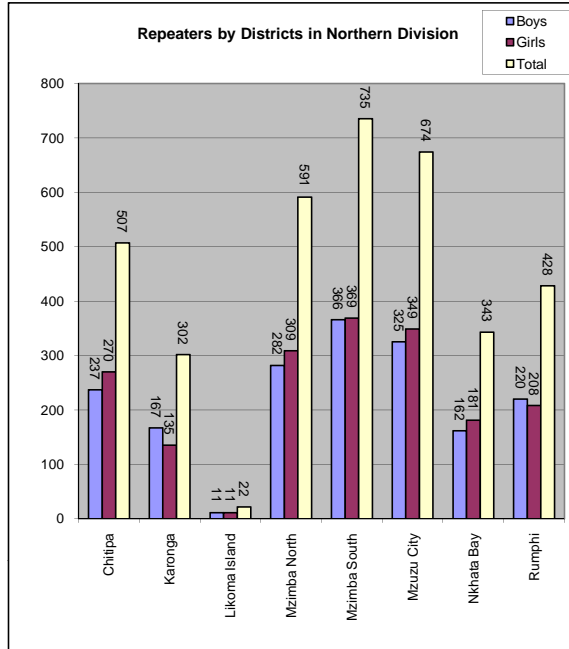

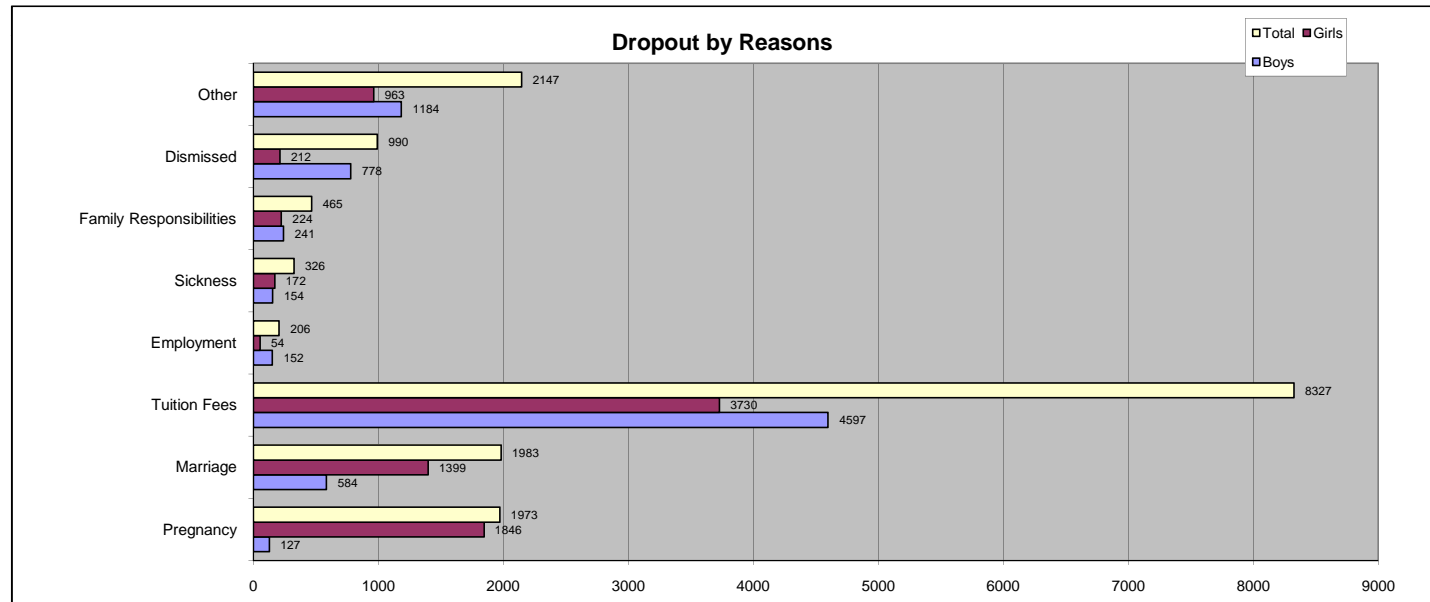

Graph 3.5 Number of Dropouts by Division/Districts

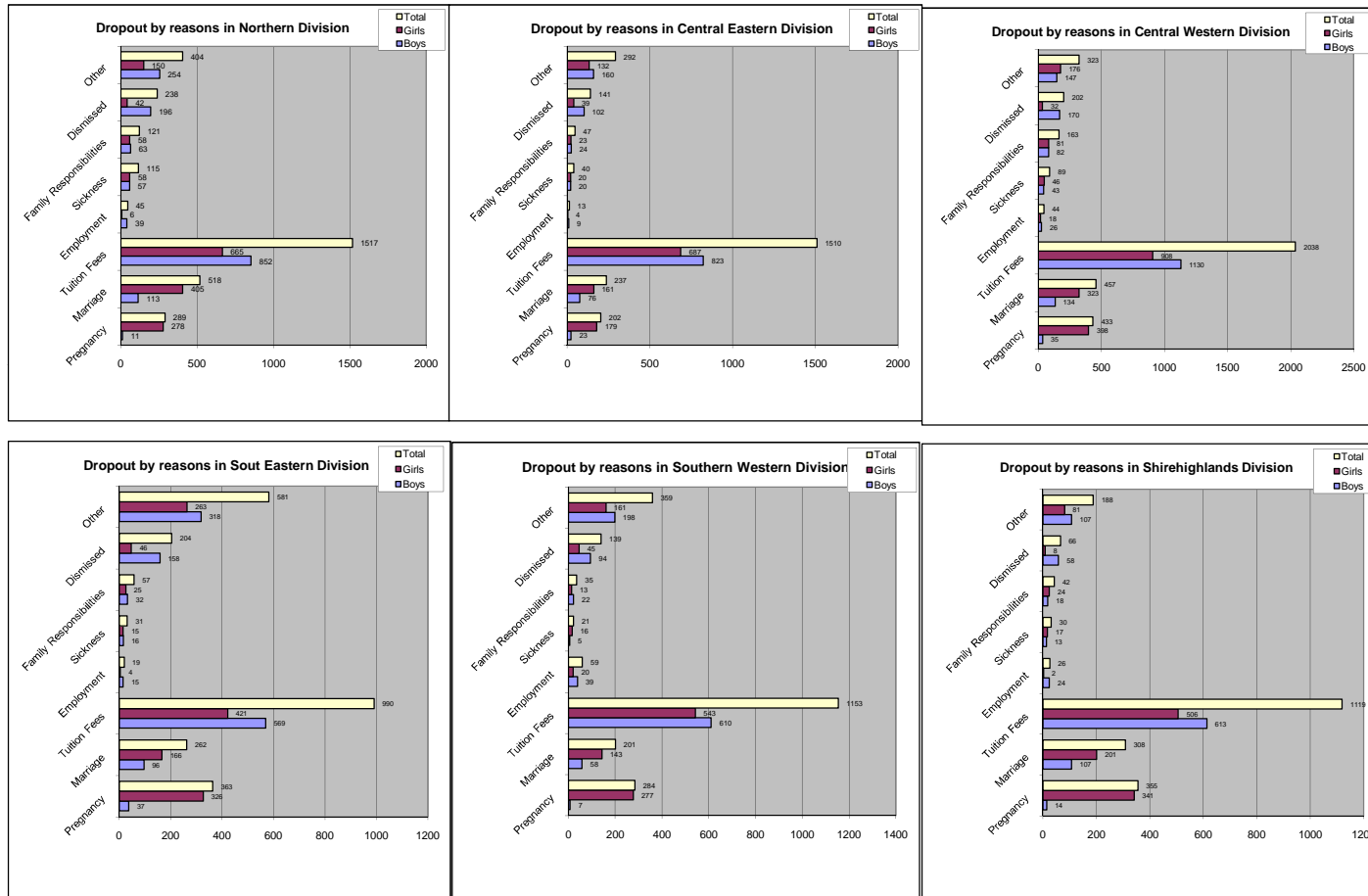

Graph 3.6: Number of Pupils transferred into and out of schools by Division and Sex

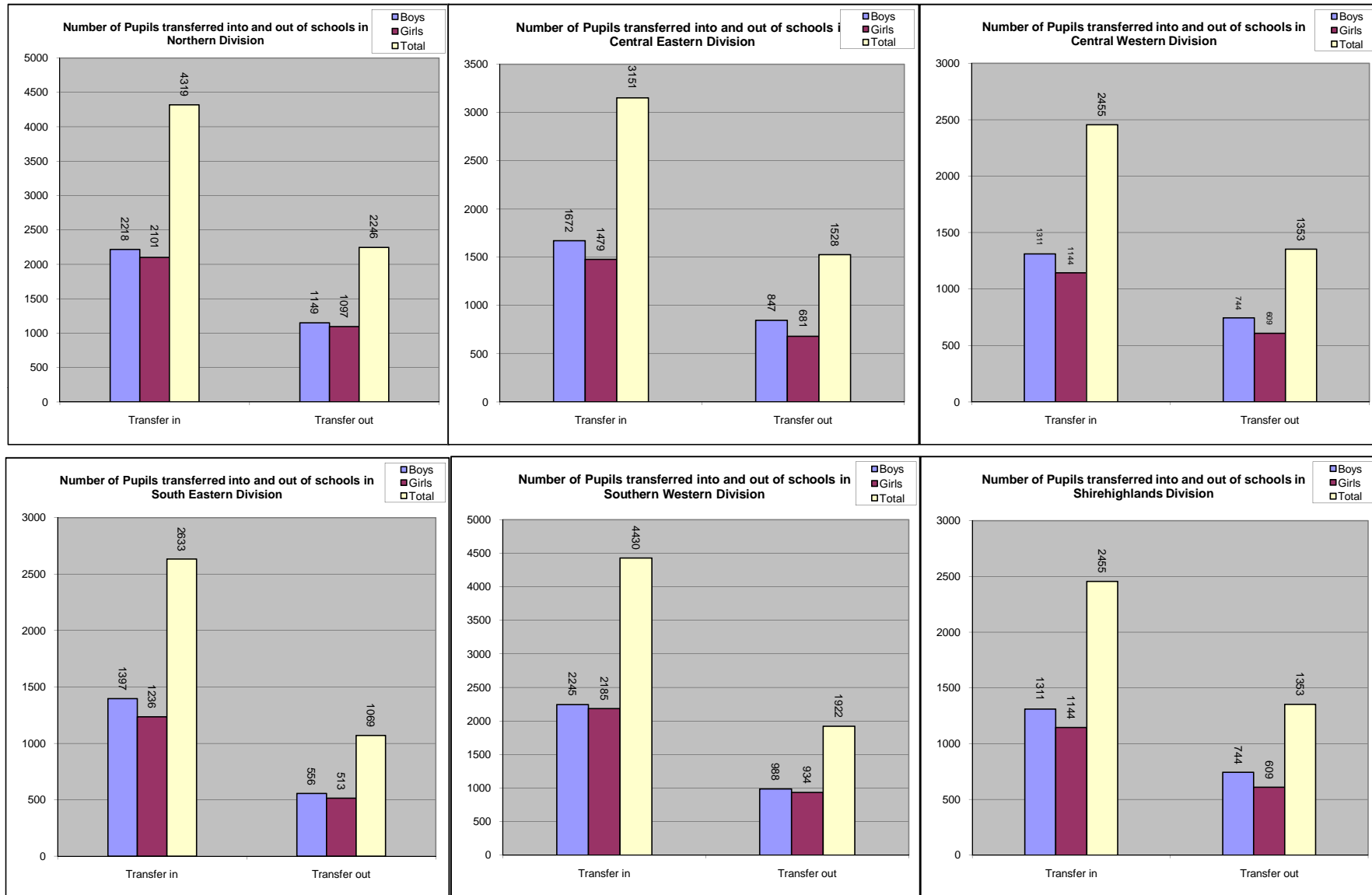

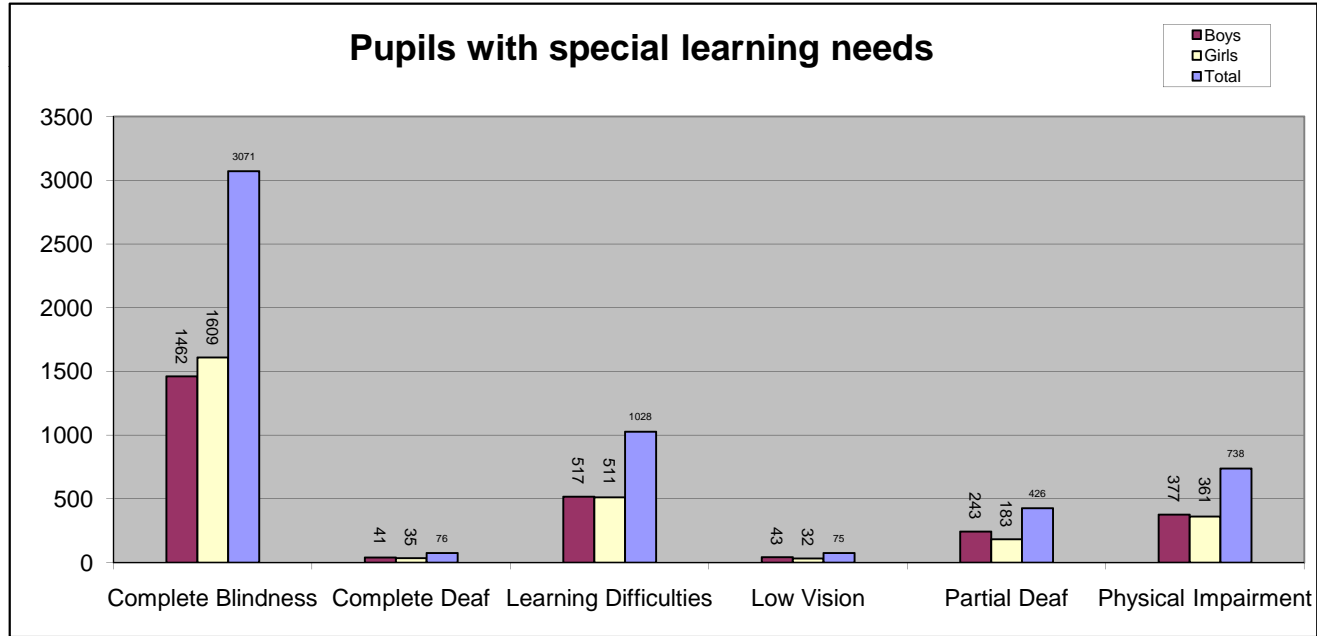

Graph 3.7a: Number of Pupils with Special education learning needs by Division and Sex

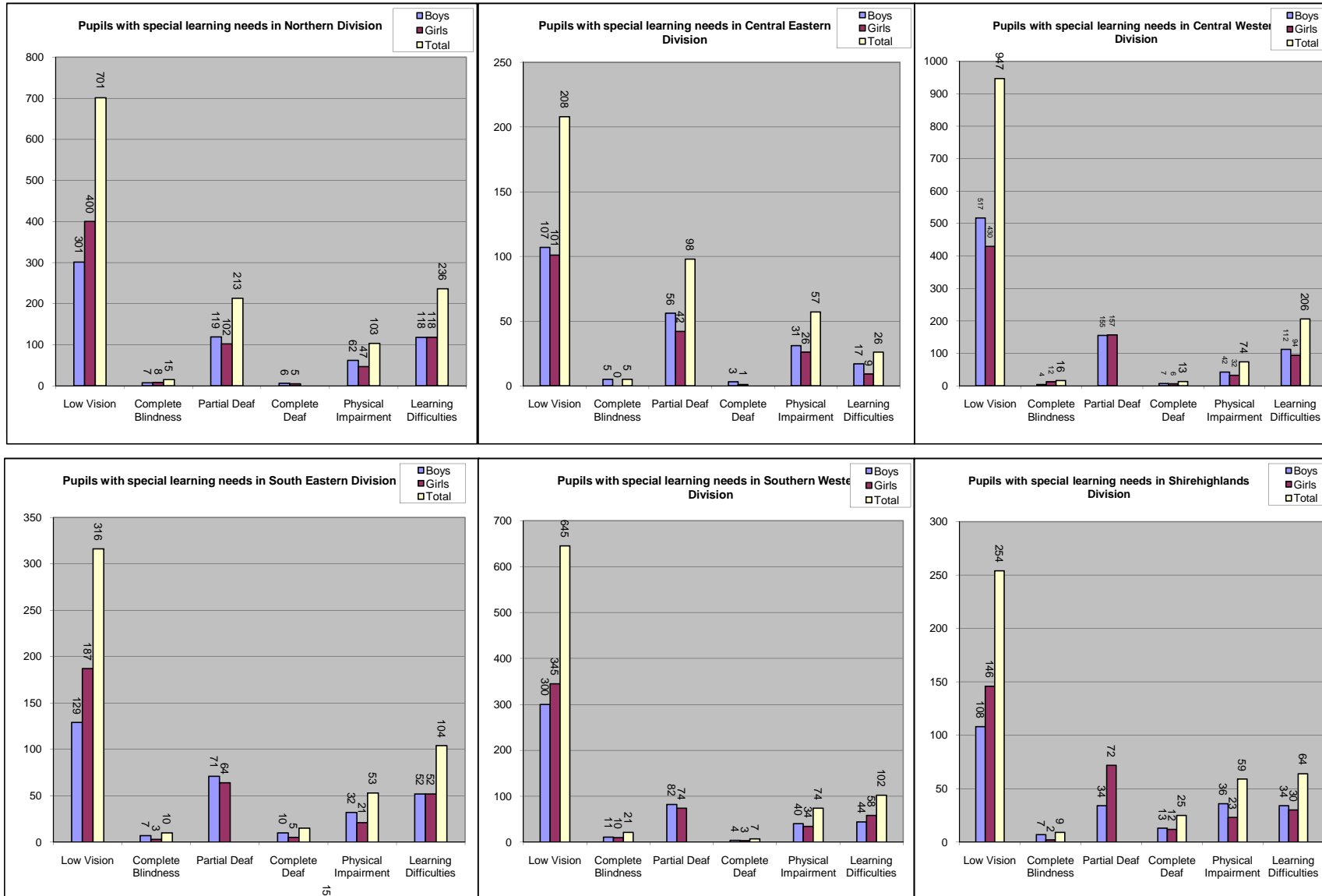

Graph 3.8 Number of Building (Rooms) by condition, and type

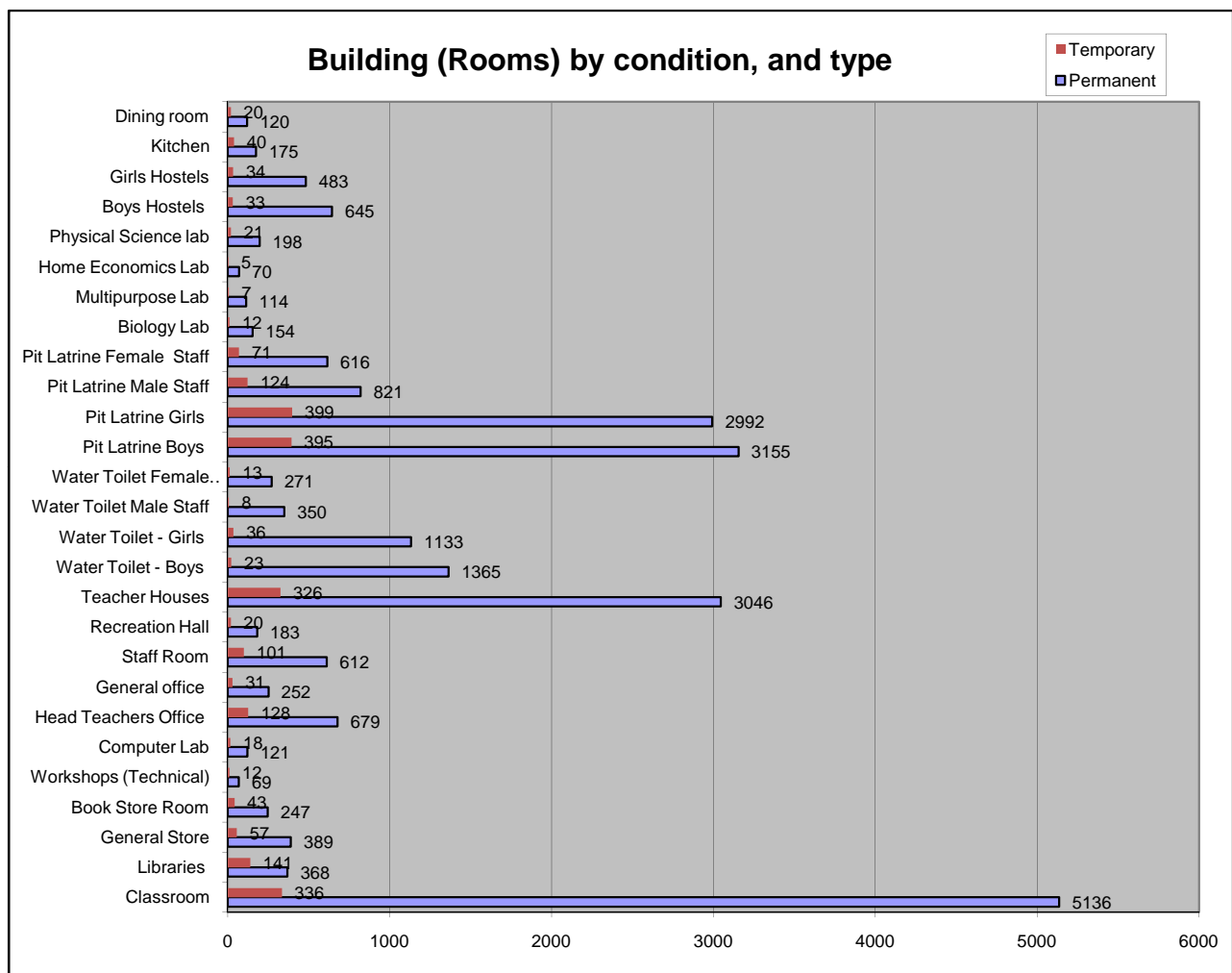

Graph 3.9 Teaching Staff Reason for leaving Schools by Division/Districts

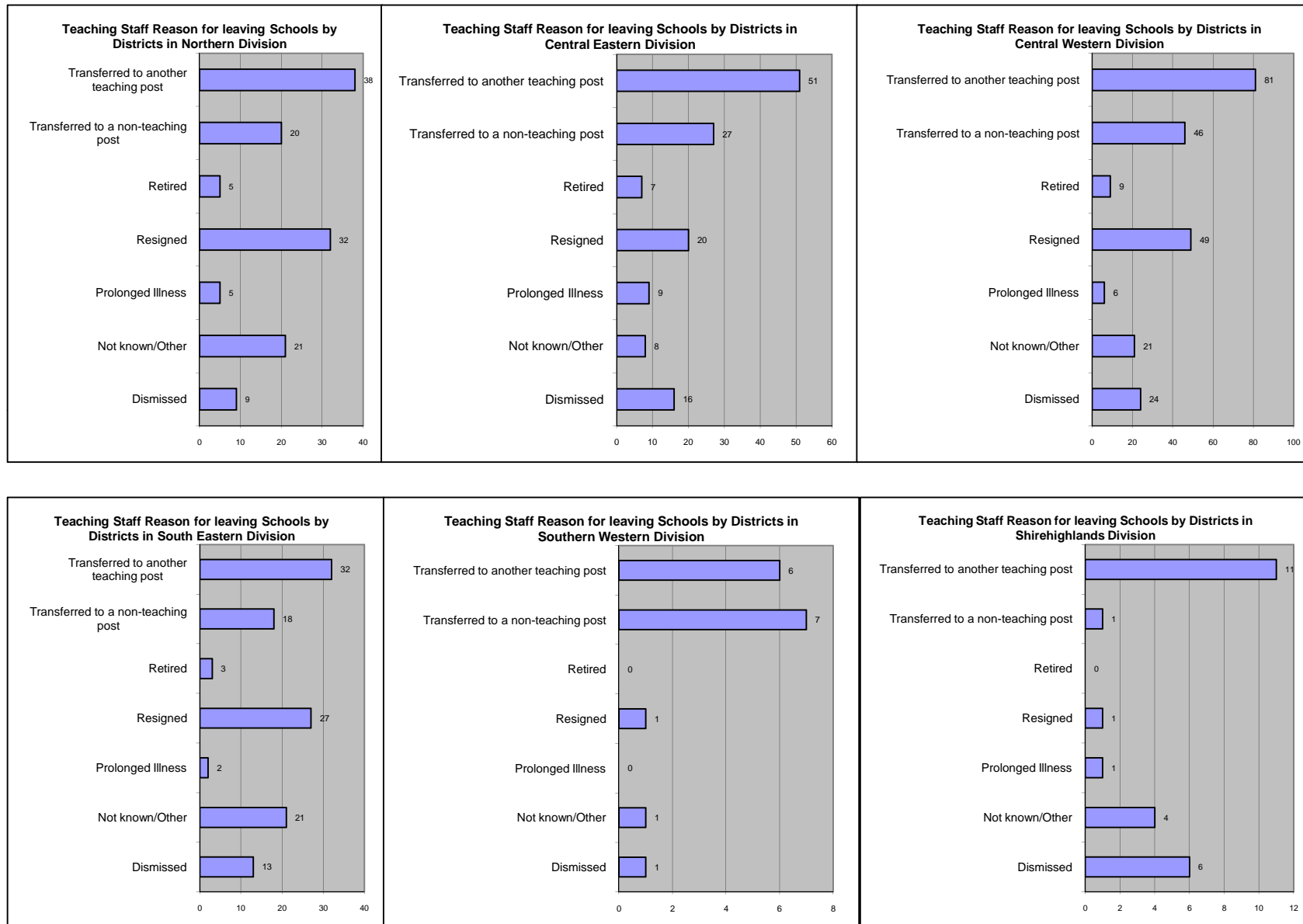
