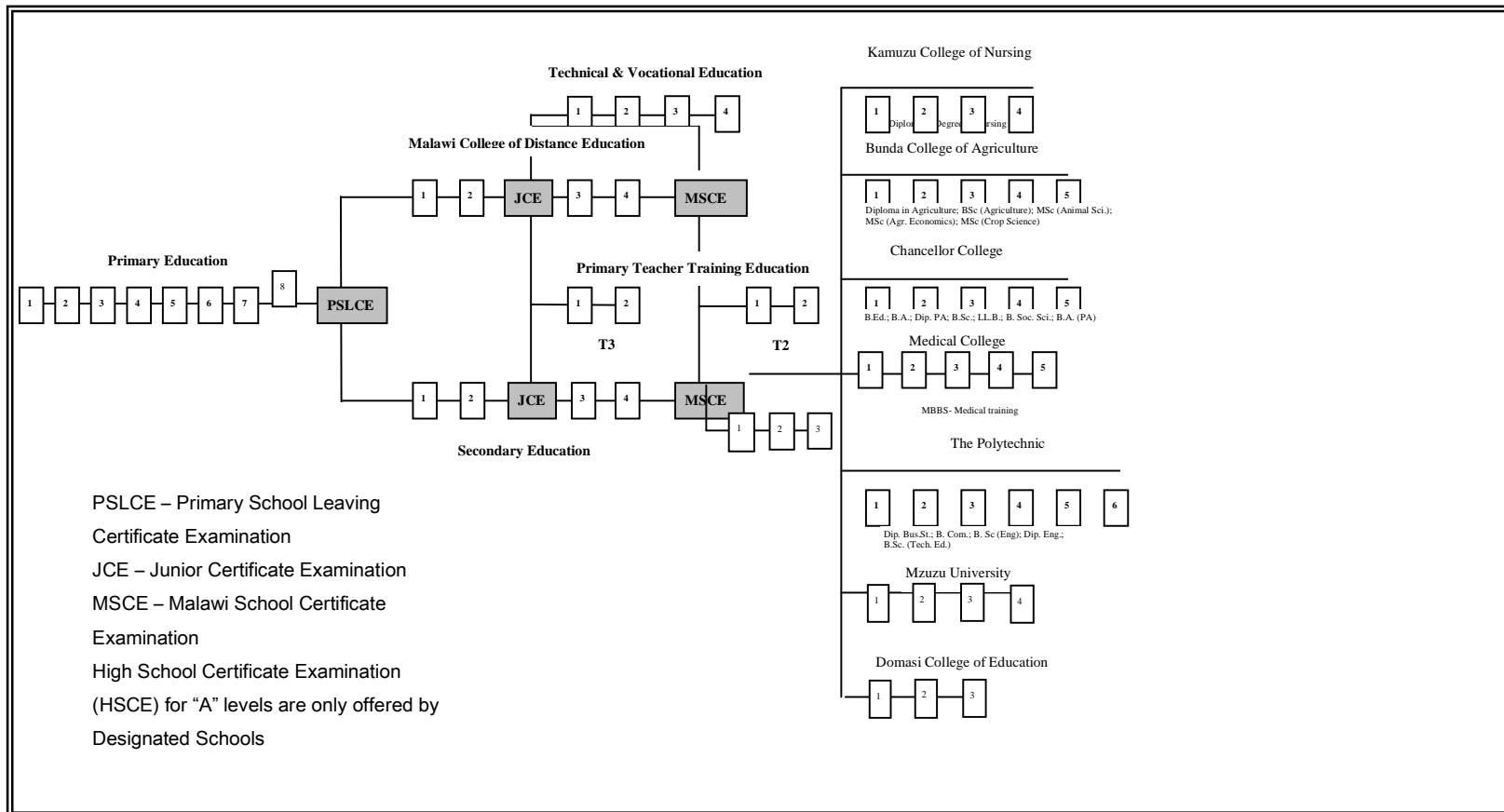

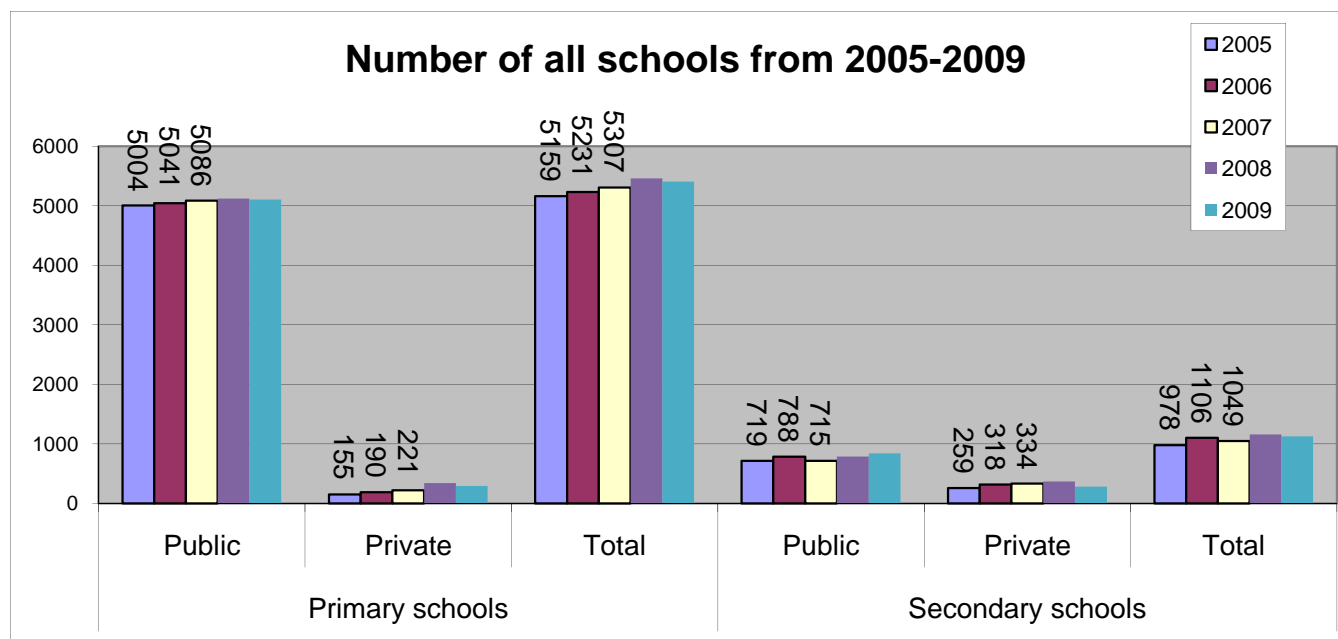

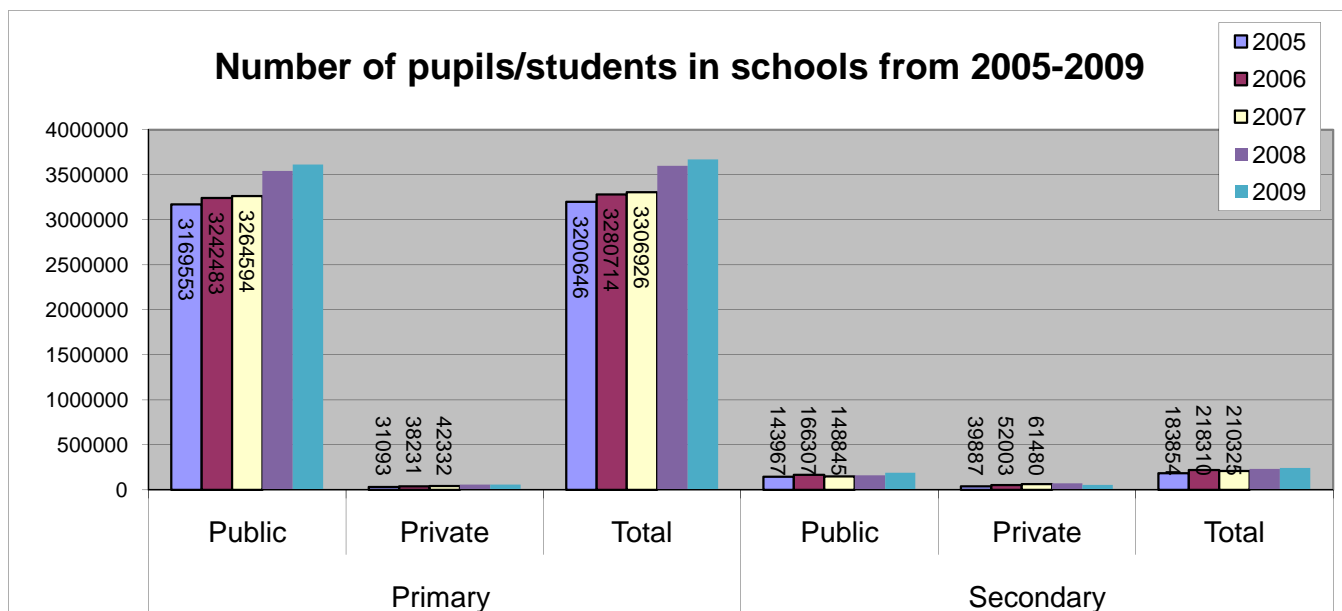

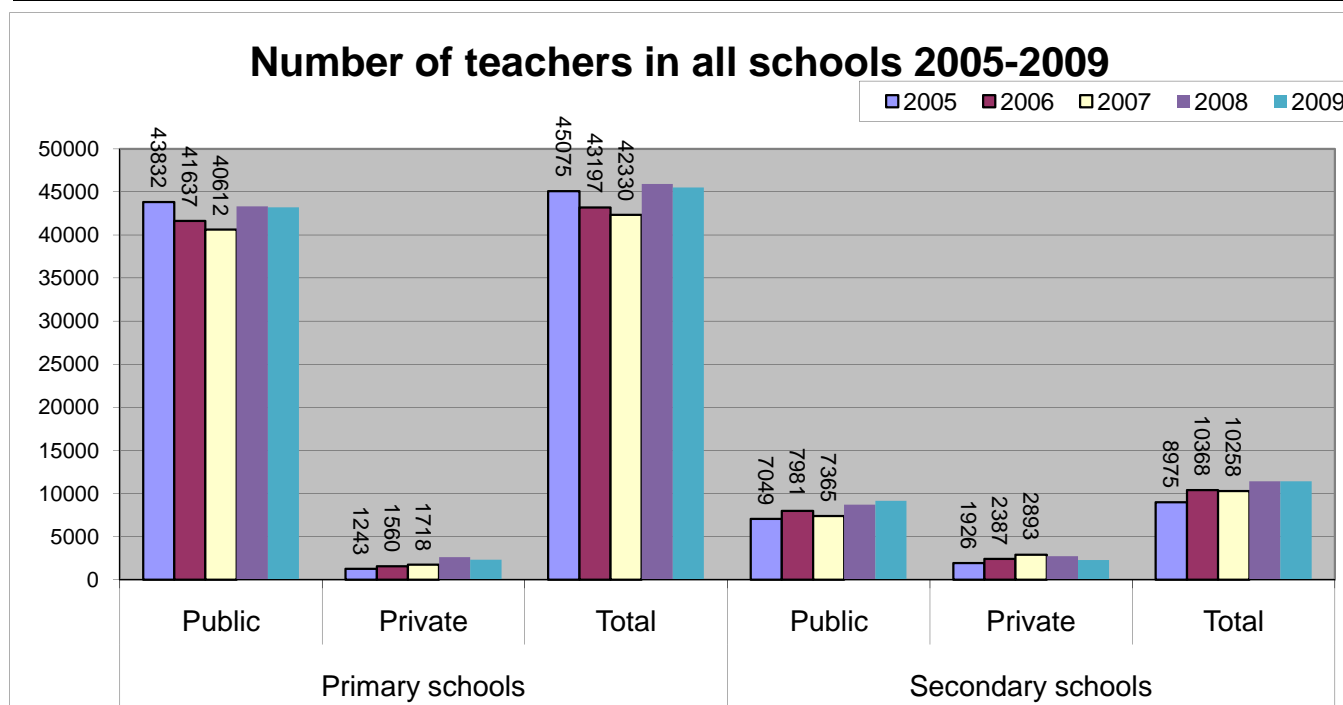

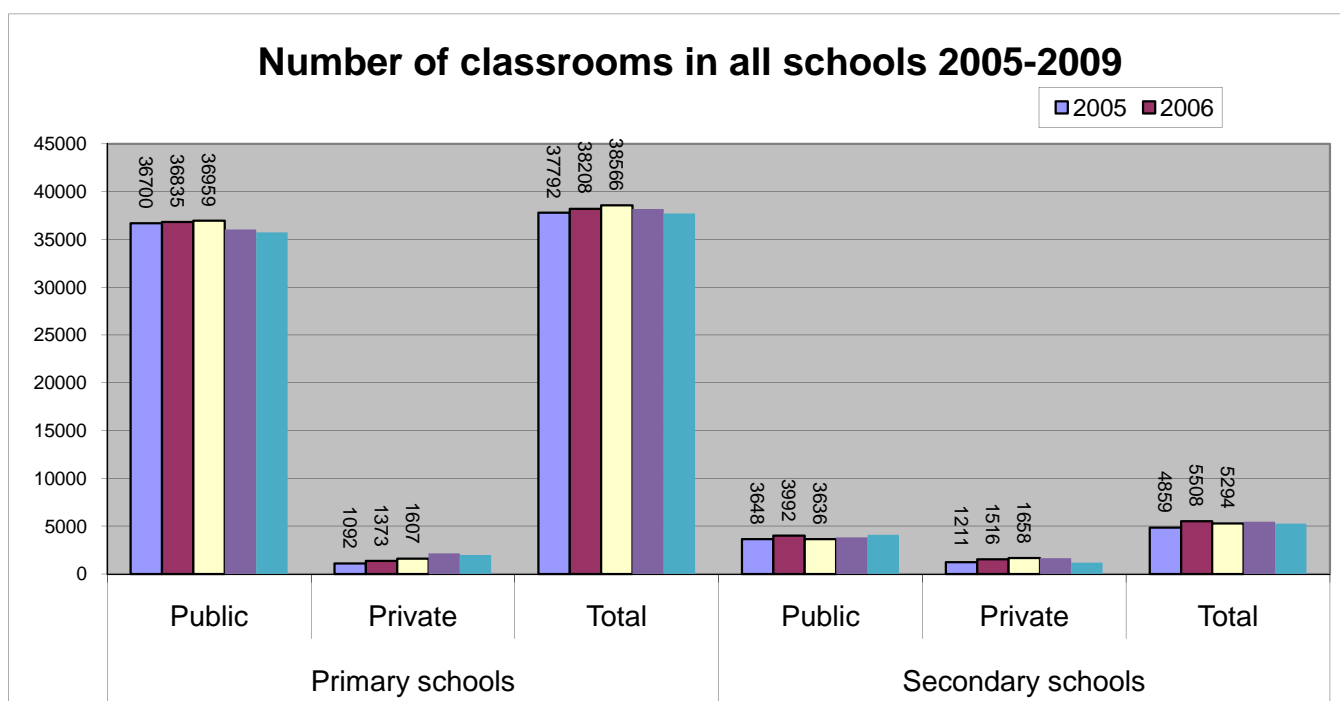


Table 1.8 - Pupils teacher ratio in all Primary schools 2005-2009

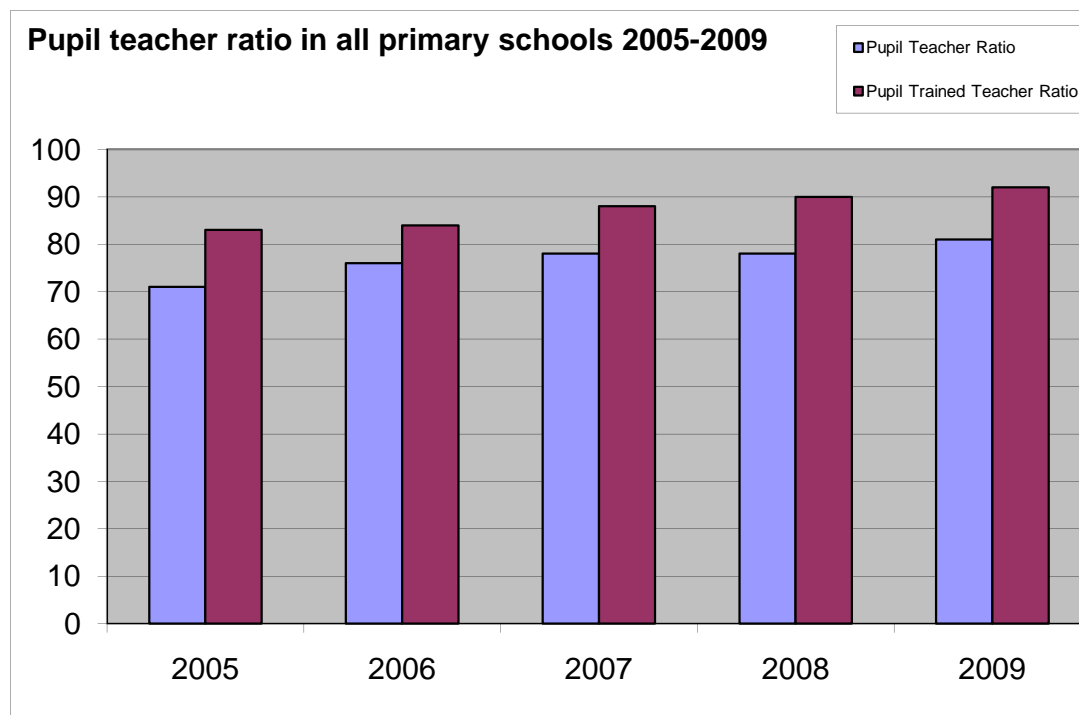


Table 1.9 - Pupil classroom ratio in all Primary schools 2005-2009

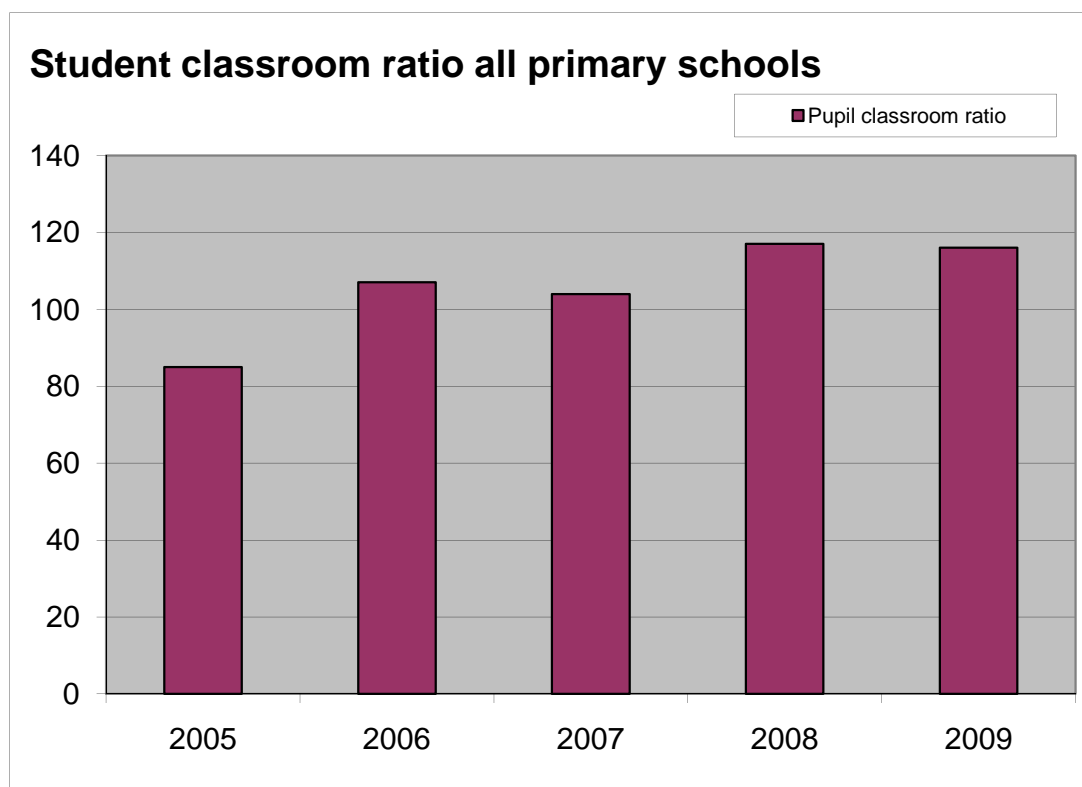

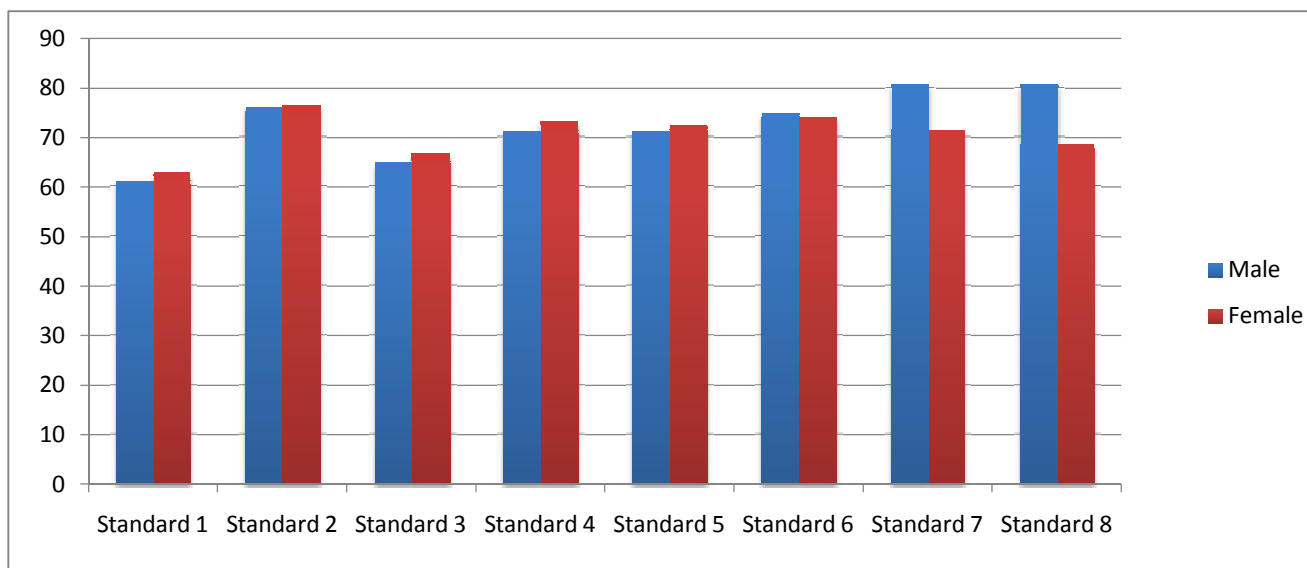

Promotion Rates by Standard and Sex

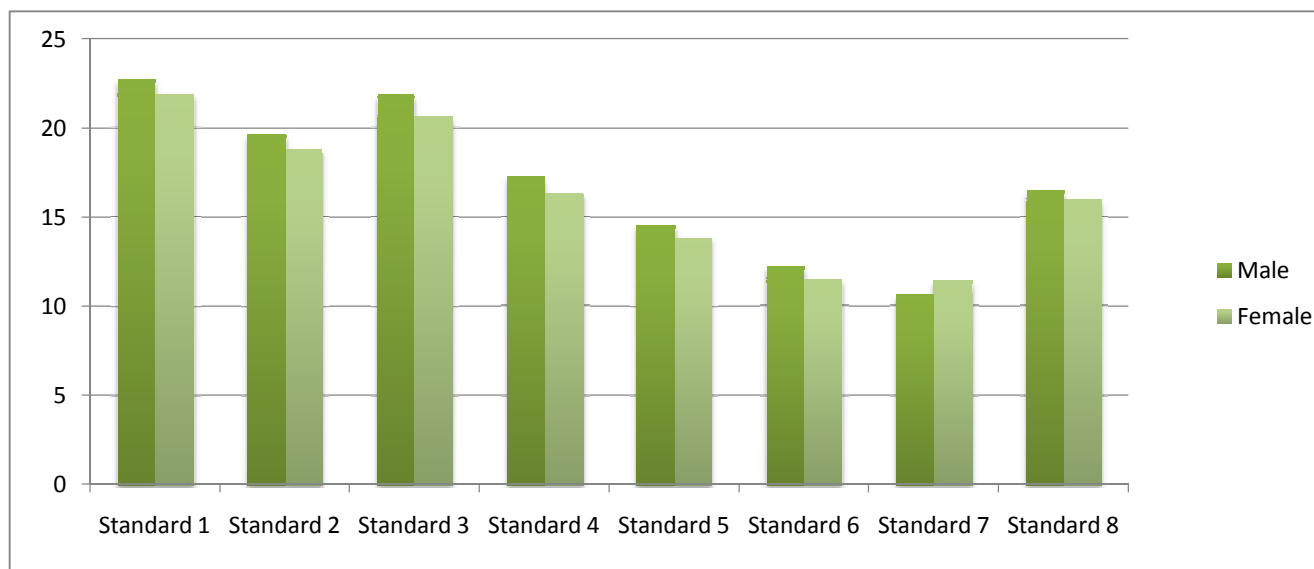

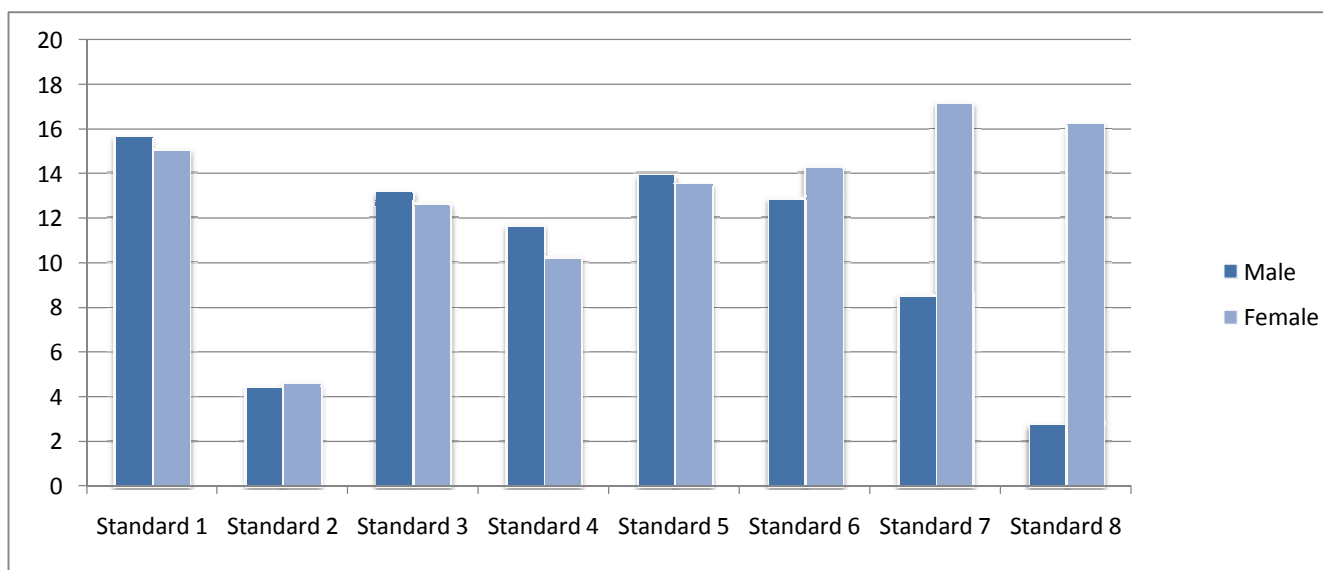
